### FROM THE CROW'S NEST

**STREAK SNAPPED:** Sunday's loss in Fort Myers ended the Marauders' streak of five consecutive series wins, a streak that began with a six-game sweep of Palm Beach from May 25-30. Bradenton's only series loss came against Lakeland in the previous series, May 18-23, while the team's only previous series split came in the season-opening series against the Mighty Mussels (May 4-9).

**THE BE-ALL, END-ALL:** Endy Rodriguez is currently on a seven-game hitting streak, matching his longest of the season. He is batting .344 during the streak, and .409 over his last five games. Rodriguez leads the team with 15 multi-hit games, including Wednesday's three-hit performance, which matched his season-high.

**EXCELLENCE FOR ESCOTTO:** Maikol Escotto has reached base safely in 16 consecutive games, his second-longest on-base streak of the season (19 games, May 5-June 1). He is batting .317 with a .417 on-base percentage during the streak, and ranks second on the team with 40 hits despite missing two weeks while on the injured list in the first half of June.

**AMONG THE BEST:** The Marauders rank second in the Low-A Southeast in runs (327), home runs (50), and slugging percentage (.389). Bradenton's pitching staff also owns Minor League Baseball's sixth-highest strikeout total (624), behind only San Jose, Modesto, Fort Myers, Somerset, and Hudson Valley.

**GO WITH THE FLO:** Tonight's Game 1 starter, **Santiago Florez**, has turned in quality starts in four of his last five outings, including his last two in a row. He currently leads the Low-A Southeast in ERA (1.32), opponents' average (.166), and WHIP (0.84), and ranks third in strikeouts (63).

**THE OPPONENT:** The Marauders and Threshers are facing off for their first head-to-head series this season, and are in town for their first of two visits to LECOM Park in 2021 (Clearwater will visit Bradenton again August 17-22). The Threshers have won each of their last two series (4-games-to-2 at home against both Daytona and St. Lucie) and own the Low-A Southeast's closest run differential (-1).

**TOP PROSPECTS:** The Marauders roster currently includes eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the Pirates organization: **Hudson Head** (#5), **Eddy Yean** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#16), **Sammy Siani** (#18), **Nick Garcia** (#20), **Endy Rodriguez** (#25), **Alexander Mojica** (#28), and **Daniel Lopez** (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

**UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT:** New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

**MISCELLANEOUS:** The Marauders own the Low-A Southeast's second-best run differential at +67 (Tampa is third in all of MiLB at +139)... Five Marauders players rank within the league's top five in home runs: **Jase Bowen** is second in the league with 8; **Hudson Head**, **Endy Rodriguez**, and **Sammy Siani** are tied for third with 6 HR each, and **Alexander Mojica**'s 5 HR is tied for fifth... **Eli Wilson** is in the league's top 10 in batting average (.351, 6th), OBP (.495, 4th), and OPS (1.022, 7th).

**2021:** Is averaging 7.3 strikeouts per start (includes May 26 piggyback)... Tossed four scoreless innings in first start of season May 6 vs Fort Myers, retiring 11 of the 13 batters he faced... Has allowed more than two hits in a start just twice (May 12, June 9)... June 2 at Dunedin, struck out career-high 10 batters over 6 scoreless innings (also matched career-high in innings pitched)... Threw complete-game shutout June 9 vs Daytona (first CG shutout of any length by a Marauders pitcher since Oddy Nunez, 6/24/18, a rain-shortened, 8-inning no-hitter)... Two weeks ago vs Jupiter, matched season-highs in runs allowed (3) and walks (3), but still turned in team-leading third quality start of the season...
