PITCHING CARRIES JACKSONVILLE TO SERIES WIN

Ryan Weathers tossed 5.0 shutout innings and the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp earned a series win with a 2-1 victory on Sunday over the Charlotte Knights at 121 Financial Ballpark. After three scoreless innings, Jacksonville struck for two runs against Charlotte (48-84, 13-44) reliever Garrett Davila. Troy Johnston led off with a single and scored on a double from Jorge Alfaro. Two batters later, Alfaro scored on a groundout by Dane Myers. The Knights tallied their lone run in the ninth but fell short 2-1

"NO OFFENSE, BUT..."

Jacksonville tallied just 11 total runs, including no more than three runs in each contest, over the entire series with Charlotte last week. The Jumbo Shrimp were just 29-for-155 (.187/.274/.258/.532) with only one home run in the series; each part of the club's slash line placed last or near the bottom in the 20-team International League during this stretch. Jacksonville registered at least five runs in 15 of their previous 23 games prior to this set. During that span, the Jumbo Shrimp ranked second in the IL in hits (229) while placing third in batting average (.286), fourth in OBP (.377), seventh in doubls (43) and eighth in both runs scored (133, 5.8 per game) and OPS (.818).

'PFN PALS

Over the last three-plus weeks, the Jumbo Shrimp have boasted a dominant bullpen. In the 23 games the club has played since August 8, Jacksonville relievers have combined to surrender only 27 runs, 21 earned, on 61 hits (7.2 H/9) in 76.1 innings for a 2.48 ERA. During this stretch, Shrimp relief pitchers have combined to strike out 99 batters (11.7 K/9) against 47 walks (5.5 BB/9). Jacksonville's bullpen has gone 24 consecutive innings without yielding an earned run.

MEN OF STEAL

While Jacksonville ranks just 11th in the 20-team International League in stolen bases with 115, the club has been exceptional in their efficiency at swiping bags. The Jumbo Shrimp have been successful on stealing a base at 83.3 percent of their attempts, a figure that ranks second in Triple-A. Over their last 17 games dating back to August 14, Jacksonville base runners have been successful on 16 of 18 stolen base attempts (88.8 percent).

THE AMAZING RACE

Somewhat remarkably, the top nine teams in the International League are separated by just 5.0 games entering play on Tuesday. Jacksonville checks in just 3.0 games out of first place, but the logjam means the Jumbo Shrimp are still only tied for sixth. Thus, with just 18 games remaining in the regular season, in order to win the IL's second-half championship and earn a playoff berth, Jacksonville would have to make up that 3.0-game deficit while also leapfrogging five other teams. If first-place Durham and Lehigh Valley even finish the season 10-9, because each club holds the tiebreaker over Jacksonville by virtue of head-to-head record, the Jumbo Shrimp would need to finish 14-5 (.737) while also hoping the five other teams ahead of them do not record a better record down the stretch

TROY MEETS WORLD

After struggling in Jacksonville to close the 2022 season, Troy Johnston has been scorching hot in his return to the Bold City this year. In 34 games with the Jumbo Shrimp this year, Johnston is 47-for-132 (.356/.423/.583/1.006) with 10 doubles, one triple, six home runs and 27 RBIs. Johnston has reached base at least once in each of his first 31 games, an on-basee streak that marked the longest by a Jacksonville hitter since at least 2010. Including his time with Double-A Pensacola, Johnston has driven in 110 runs in 116 games this season, which ranks second in MiLB.

JERARSSIC PARK

Jerar Encarnacion endured a terrible slump in the middle of the year. In 46 games from May 16-July 14, the Bayaguana. D.R., native went just 23-for-163 (.141/.258/.380/.638) at the plate with just one double, one triple, 12 home runs, 19 RBIs and 24 walks (12.6 BB%). Encarnacion struck out a remarkable 80 times, a rate of 42.1 percent over his 190 plate appearances. In his last 28 games, however, the 26-year-old is 24-for-89 (.270/.400/.483/.883) with four doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs and 20 walks (18.2 BB percent).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's 22 errors over the last 24 games are tied for the second-most in Triple-A over that span.
