TODAY'S GAME: The Curve wrap up a six-game series with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats, the final meeting of the season between them.

LAST TIME OUT: New Hampshire picked up their second walk-off win of the series, rallying from a 5-3 deficit after 7 innings to pick up the win. Brendt Citta hammered a 3-run homer and Henry Davis added a second straight multi-hit game in the defeat.

A GREAT START: Matt Fraizer knocked Altoona's second lead-off homer of the season on Thursday, June 23 at New Hampshire. Previously, Nick Gonzales homered on the game's first pitch on April 29 at Akron. It marked the 33rd time in franchise history that Altoona has hit a lead-off homer. Jonah Davis knocked a pair of them in 2021 for the Curve.

THAT'S ODD: With Saturday's walk-off loss at New Hampshire, Altoona has lost 6 games in walk-off fashion this season. RHP J.C. Flowers has been on the mound in three of them: May 28 at Harrisburg, June 9 at Reading and June 22 at New Hampshire.

BIG LEAGUE CURVE: With 2019-21 Curve OF Bligh Madris became the 194th alumni head to the majors after their time in Curve, PA with his major league debut on Monday, June 20 against the Chicago Cubs. Madris became the 11th alumni to debut this season, joining Diego Castillo, Beau Sulser, Jack Suwinski, Cam Alldred, Cal Mitchell, Yerry De Los Santos, Canaan Smith-Njigba, Jason Delay, Liover Peguero and Somerset Cam Vieaux. In 2016 and 2018 the Curve had 14 players make their debut, a figure that could easily fall by the time the 2022 season wraps up. New Hamp.

Curve INF Liover Peguero became the third player to be recalled directly to the major league roster on Friday, June 17 when INF Tucupita Marcano went on the COVID IL on short notice. Peguero arrived in Pittsburgh in time for first pitch and made his major league debut on Satur day against San Francisco going 1-for-3 with a walk. He became the first Pirate born in the 21st century to suit up for Pittsburgh.

SHACKDADDY: Curve INF Aaron Shackelford picked up his first career multi-homer game on Friday, June 17 against Erie. Shackelford's two-run homer in the fifth inning traveled approximately 462 feet. It was the second time this season that the Curve had a multi-homer game (Sabol, May 17 vs Richmond) and the 115th in franchise history. The 2021 Curve had six multi-homer games with three of them coming from Mason Martin

ACE OUT, ACE IN: Prior to Thursday's game against Erie, the Curve announced the promotion of RHP Mike Burrows to Triple-A Indianapolis. Ranked as the No. 11 prospect in the Pirates Minor League System by MLB.com, Burrows was unscored upon in six of his starts this year and allowed 2 runs or fewer in 9-of-his-12 starts. At the time of his promotion he ranked: 5th in ERA (2.94), 6th in K (69), 5th in BAA (.199), 9th in WHIP (1.10), T-1st in GS (12) and was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 30.

In his place, Altoona activated RHP Quinn Priester from the IL, ranked as the No. 4 prospect in the Pirates system by MLB.com. With Priester's activation, the Curve have the 2019 and 2021 Pirates first round selections on the active roster. Priester made his team debut on Sunday June 19 against Erie with 3.0 scoreless innings.

ALVY'S BIG START: Andres Alvarez picked up a career-high 5 RBI in Altoona's 13-12 win over Bowie on Thursday, June 2. After an RBI single and an RBI triple in the second inning, Alvarez smashed a go-ahead 3-run homer in the 8th inning to lead the Curve to a win. Through 44 games Alvarez has set a new career-high with a team-best 10 home runs and 27 RBI. His .523 slugging percentage ranks 8th in the Eastern

LET'S HIT: The Curve have picked up at least 10 hits in 15-of-their-36 last games. Altoona has had 10 or more hits in a game 22 times this season, most in the Eastern League. The Curve lead the Eastern League in team batting average (.251) and total hits (569); they hold a 27-hit lead over the next highest team in the league (Bowie).

NO LEAD IS SAFE: Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 34 of 68 games played this season and hold an 23-11 record in those games. Since May 17, the Curve are 12-2 when they hold a lead after 5 innings.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL: Altoona pitchers have surrendered 72 home runs on the season, tied for 24th-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and fourth-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford (92). The Curve have allowed a home run in 42 of 68 games.

THE 'FISHER KITTIES: Managed by Cesar Martin in his second season, the Fisher Cats have one member of the Blue Jays 40-man roster in RHP Hagen Danner. Top prospects in Manchester include INF Orelvis Martinez (#2), RHP Adam Kloffenstein (#11), RHP Hagen Danner (#17), RHP Trent Palmer (#23), RHP Joey Murray (#24), OF Sebastian Espino (#25), RHP Hayden Juenger (#26) and INF Spencer Horwitz (#30).

THE FIRST TOSSER: Hayden Juenger makes his second start of the series this afternoon. Juenger allowed 1 run in 2.0 innings on Tuesday. Drafted in the sixth round in 2021 out of Missouri State, Juenger pitched 20.0 innings and allowed 6 runs (2.70 ERA) in 11 appearances at High-A Vancouver in his pro debut. Juenger hails from O'Fallon, Illinois is ranked as the #26 prospect in the Blue Jays system according to

2004 - Curve play game against Erie at PNC Park, lost 2-0. Ian Snell pitched seven one-run frames with seven strikeouts but took the loss.

2005 - Tom Gorzelanny throws a three-hit complete game shutout vs. new Britain, 7-0 win; walked one struck out seven.

2018 - Taylor Hearn blanks Harrisburg on four hits during the first game of a doubleheader, earning a complete-game shutout over seven innings, seven strikeouts. The Curve won both games of the doubleheader 1-0, the first time the club has ever pitched back-to-back 1-0 shutouts.
