


RHP Zach Haake vs RHP Blade Tidwell

The Finale

Reading finishes its season this afternoon at Binghamton. The R-Phils look to split this week's series, and Binghamton has a 13-4 season-series edge.

Reading was shutout for the fifth time this season in a 6-0 loss to Binghamton. The R-Phils were held to a season-low two hits and walked four times. Adam Leverett opened for Reading and went a season-high 3.2 innings and threw a season-high 75 pitches. Rodolfo Sanchez didn't allow a run over 1.1 innings in his Reading debut. Benito Garcia went 4.1 scoreless frames for Binghamton, and the bullpen 4.2 scoreless innings.

Leading the League

With one game to go, a few R-Phils have themselves in the spot to take home the league crown in various statistical categories. Oliver Dunn is poised to finish 2023 atop the league in OBP, OPS, extra-base hits and walks. He ranks second in average, RBI and SLG. Carlos De La Cruz will be the 2023 Eastern League hit leader, as he is 14 hits up on second place Nick Yorke, as well as total bases. De La Cruz is second in runs scored, extra-base hits, and third in home runs, two behind the leader. Keylan Killgore will finish 2023 with the most appearences in the Eastern League. Mick Abel also qualifies for the league lead in opponents batting average and David Parkinson is fourth in ERA.

Going Going Gone

Reading hitters have compiled 159 home runs this season, which will finish third in the league. This comes after finishing last in the league in homers with 119 last season. Carlos De La Cruz leads the way with 24 and Oliver Dunn has 21. No R-Phil had more than 20 home runs in 2022. In total, five R-Phils had double-digit home runs this season: De La Cruz (24), Dunn (21), Ethan Wilson (17), Nick Podkul (12) and Baron Radcliff (11).

Second Half Success

After gooing 28-40 in the first half and finishing last in the Northeast Division, Reading has compiled a 31-36 second-half record, which is fourth in the division. Improved pitching has driven that success. The R-Phils have a 4.00 ERA in the second half, which ranks sixth in the Eastern League. Their first-half ERA was 5.18, which was 11th across the league. But, offensively has been a different story. After leading the league with a .267 average in the first half, Reading ranks last in the league with a .212 average in the second half.

Around the Organization

The Phillies beat the Cardinals 6-1 last night as Kyle Schwarber hit his 44th home run of the season. They'll go for the sweep over St. Louis this afternoon. Lehigh Valley beat Rochesters 6-5 in ten innings last night as Drew Ellis had two hits. The IronPigs remain two-games back of Durham with seven games to play. Clearwater plays game one of the Flordia State League Championship tonight at six at Jupiter.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 17, 2015: At Bowie, Jake Thompson allows just 1 run on 4 hits and strikes out 5 in 7.0 innings to stake Reading to a 2-1 championship series lead. The Fightin Phils blow the game open with a 5-run 6th and coast to a 9-3 win. Nick Williams goes 2-for-6 with 2 RBI and 2 runs and homers for the 3rd time in the playoffs.

Playoff Bound Ponies

Binghamton enters tonight with a 38-27 record in the second half and 73-61 overall this season. The Rumble Ponies clinched the second-half title last Sunday and will match up with Somerset next week in the playoffs. Last week, Binghamton went 4-2 on the road at Hartford. The Ponies have the following Mets prospects ranked within their top 30: Luisangel Acuna (1), Drew Gilbert (2), Jett Williams (3), Kevin Parada (5), Blake Tidwell (10), Christian Scott (12), Dom Hamel (16), Tyler Stuart (17), Jeremiah Jackson (22), Matt Rudick (27) and Coleman Crow (29).

Blade Tidwell makes his seventh start for Binghamton tonight. He is 3-3 with a 4.24 ERA over seven starts (34 IP, 30 H, 15 BB, 40 SO). Tidwell last pitched on Tuesday against Reading and earned the win. He went five innings, three hits, no runs, no walks and nine strikeouts. Tidwell began the season with High-A Brooklyn and went 8-3 with a 3.09 ERA over 17 starts and was called up to Binghamton on July 31. Tidwell split 2022 between the FCL Mets and Single-A St. Lucie and went 0-1 with a 1.93 ERA over five starts. The Mets drafted Tidwell in the second round of the 2022 draft out of Tennessee, where he collected various accolades over his career.
