IT STARTS AT THE TOP: With a 2-for-4 day on Tuesday, 1B Luke Adams helped the Shuckers improve to 9-0 when he bats first or second... When occupying either of the top 2 spots in the lineup, Adams is 10-for-29 (.345) with 4 doubles, a home run, 7 walks and a 1.086 OPS.

HEY NOW, YOU'RE A BROCK-STAR: Entering today, 3B Brock Wilken is among the Southern Earliest to 10 Hr by Team Games (BLX) League leaders in home runs (1st, 9), extra-base hits (T-1st, 16), OPS (2nd, .968), on-base Joey Wiemer (2022) percentage (3rd, .427), slugging percentage (3rd, .541) and RBI (T-4th, 20)... Over 11 games Lake Reetz (2022) in May, Wilken owns a .368/.468/.921 slash line with a 1.389 OPS, 3 doubles, 6 home runs lake Gatewood (2018) and 13 RBI... Wilken's 6 home runs in May are tied for the most in Minor League Baseball Trent Grisham (2019)

The fastest player in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015) to 10 home runs in a season is OF Joey Wiemer, who reached the mark in the Shuckers' 36th game during the 2022 season... Only 2 players in franchise history have reached the mark less than 40 games into the season.

WARREN'S CHASING HISTORY: INF/OF Zavier Warren recorded his 33rd career home run wit the Shuckers in game one of Saturday's doubleheader... Warren enters today with the 4th most career home runs in franchise history (since 2015)... The franchise record is 36, set b INF Jake Gatewood between 2017-19... Warren is 1 of 5 players in franchise history to recor at least 30 career home runs.

LET THE KIDS PLAY: OF Luis Lara extended his on-base streak to 14 consecutive games and his hit streak to 6 with a 1-for-2 day with 3 walks on Tuesday... Over the 14-game on-base streak, Lara is hitting .280 (11-for-50) with a .429 on-base percentage and a .829 OPS... During his current 6-game hit streak, Lara is 6-for-19 (.474) with 4 doubles.

FANNING THE FLAMES: After 3.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday, RHP Nate Peterson lowered his ERA to 1.69 across 5 relief appearances this season... Since moving to the bullpen on April 18, Peterson has 22 strikeouts and has allowed 3 runs over 16.0 innings.

NOW THAT'S A TURNAROUND: After a 1-7 start, the Shuckers have won 20 of their last 26 games and enter today at 21-13, the best record in the Southern League... Over their last 26 games, the Shuckers have outscored opponents 153-86, a +67 run differential... Over that span, the Shuckers have averaged 5.9 runs per game... The Shuckers have scored at least 5 runs in 19 of 26 games, including 17 times in their last 21 games.
