LAST OUTING: Hall went 4.0 innings with one earbed run allowed versus Charlotte on July 26. It was his deepest he has went in a game since April 6.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Hall has faced Gwinnett seven times in his career (five with Norfolk & two with Nashville). In 2022, he made two outings and pitched 4.0 scoreless in both.In 2023, he was charged with the loss with three earned runs acrosss 3.0 innings. His other two outings in 2023 were no-decisions with one earned run allowed each in 4.1 and 3.0 innings respectively. He made two starts at Gwinnett on June 13/16 and allowed two earned runs in 2.2 innings total.
