**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 6-5, for their fourth consecutive defeat. Harrisburg took a 2-0 lead in the third with a two-run homer by Jacob Young. In the fourth, **Wade Meckler** hit an RBI single to close the gap to 2-1. Frankie Tostado hit RBI singles in the fifth and sixth innings and Trey Lipscomb added a two-run single in the sixth to extend the Senators' lead to 6-1. In the eighth, **Victor Bericoto** and **Vaun Brown** each hit two-run homers to close the score to 6-5.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a three-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals. This is the third series between the two teams this season and the second on City Island. The Senators won four-of-six in Harrisburg from April 11-16. The Flying Squirrels won five-of-six at The Diamond from June 20-25. The two teams will meet for a six-game series at The Diamond from August 15-20.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 14-6 in their last 20 games since June 18 but have dropped our straight. They went 14-2 from June 18-July 6, including taking five-of-six in series against Harrisburg and Reading, prior to losing their last four games. In their last 20 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting a league-best .253 (161-for-637) with 24 homers, 28 doubles and have score 103 runs. In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 3.07 ERA, second-best in the league, with 228 strikeouts. Over the last 25 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 2.94 ERA (29 ER/88.2 IP) and have allowed six home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.72 ERA is the second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 290.0 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 416.0 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.22 ERA, which is tied for second-lowest in Double-A and tied for the fifth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

**THE SENATORS** have lost five-of-seven. After opening the second half 3-0, they have gone 3-7 in their last 10 games. This year, the Senators are 10th in the Eastern League in batting average (.230) and have scored the fewest runs (347) in the circuit. Harrisburg's roster includes seven players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF James Wood (No. 1, No. 4 overall), OF Robert Hassell III (No. 2), RHP Cole Henry (No. 13), 3B Trey Lipscomb (No. 17), LHP Mitchell Parker (No. 24), LHP Dustin Saenz (No. 26) and OF Jacob Young (No. 27). MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects list includes Wood (No. 1), Hassell (No. 5), Henry (No. 12), Lipscomb (No. 18) and Parker (No. 22). Wood is rated as MLB.com's No. 5 prospect and Hassell is rated No. 95.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Carson Seymour** takes the mound for his 13th Double-A start and his third against the Senators. He last pitched on Sunday against the Baysox and surrendered a career-high-tying five runs over three innings in a loss. He started against Harrisburg on April 13 at FNB Field and allowed three runs in four innings in a loss. He faced the Senators on June 23 at The Diamond and worked four innings, allowing two runs. A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A St. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 12 Giants prospect and No. 17 by MLB.com. **For more on Seymour, see page two.**

**FOR HARRISBURG:** Right-hander Cole Henry makes his fourth Double-A start and his first of the season against the Flying Squirrels. Last time out, Henry threw two scoreless innings in a start on July 5 at Akron. He was selected in the second round (55th overall) by the Nationals in 2020 out of LSU. Last year, Henry was limited to nine starts between Double-A and Triple-A, going 1-0 with a 1.71 ERA, but missed most of the season after surgery for thoracic outlet syndrome. He has made one start against Richmond in his career, which was on May 12, 2022 in Harrisburg, allowing one run over four innings. Henry began his 2023 season in May with Low-A Fredericksburg, working seven scoreless innings over two starts. He joined High-A Wilmington on May 25 and started twice, allowing two runs over eight innings. Henry joined the Senators on June 6. He is currently rated by Baseball America as the No. 13 Nationals prospect and No. 12 by MLB.com.

**BERICOTO BOMBS:** **Victor Bericoto** hit his second Double-A home run on Friday night, a 428-foot, two-run shot to left-center field. It was his second straight game played with a home run, his first coming last Saturday at The Diamond. Bericoto started the season with High-A Eugene and homered 16 times in 71 games, which was tied for third-most in the Northwest League at the time of his promotion. His 18 total home runs this year are the most among all Giants minor leaguers. He has picked up a hit in each of his last three games.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** On Friday, **Wade Meckler** snapped a rare three-game hitless streak, going 2-for-4 with an RBI. He has picked up multiple hits nine times in his 28 Double-A games. He went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 200 PA) in batting average (.398) and is fifth in OBP (.464). He leads the Eastern League (min. 100 PA) in on-base percentage (.444) and is second in batting average (.355).

**VOUN GONE WILD:** **Vaun Brown** saw his 11-game hitting streak end on Saturday night, one game shy of matching **Carter Williams** (12 games) for the longest hit streak by a Richmond player this season. It was also the longest active hit streak in the Eastern League. In his last 14 games, Brown is batting .310 (18-for-58) with six homers, four doubles, 18 RBIs, 11 runs scored and one walk. Brown homered in back-to-back games on June 28 and 29 at Reading, totaling six RBIs in the two games. He homered twice last series against the Baysox and added a two-run homer in the series-opener at Harrisburg on Friday night.

**ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN:** **Shane Matheny** has reached base in 19 consecutive games dating back to June 18, which is tied for the longest active streak in the Eastern League. For that stretch, he is batting .273 (18-for-66) with six doubles, two homers and 11 RBIs, adding 10 walks with a .364 on-base percentage. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 105 walks, which is the fourth-most in franchise history, two behind **Jarrett Parker** (2013-14). His .360 career on-base percentage is fourth-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 600 PA).

**I LOVE LUCI:** In his last 15 games since June 23, **Marco Luciano** is batting .347 (17-for-49) with two homers, five doubles, seven RBIs and 11 runs scored. On June 24, he tied his career high in hits, going 4-for-4. On July 4, he hit his 11th Double-A homer, a solo shot in the eighth inning. In his last 24 games since June 10, Luciano is batting .326 (28-for-86) with six homers, six doubles, 17 RBIs, 18 walks, a .438 on-base percentage, .605 slugging percentage and 1.043 OPS.

**OLD FRIENDS:** Harrisburg's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels players. First baseman Frankie Tostado was selected by the Mariners in the minor-league phase of December's Rule 5 Draft and later traded to the Nationals. In 2021 and 2022, Tostado played 177 games for the Flying Squirrels, batting .264 with 104 RBIs. His 25 career homers with Richmond are tied for fifth-most in a career in franchise history. Reliever Patrick Ruotolo joined the Senators after being signed by the Nationals as a free agent on July 1. He spent parts of three seasons with Richmond (2018, 2021, 2022), going 4-2 with a 2.45 ERA and 16 saves in his 64 appearances. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Ruotolo worked the ninth in the Flying Squirrels' first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history. Other former Flying Squirrels playing in the Eastern League this year include outfielder Diego Rincones (2021-22) with Erie, pitcher Gray Fenter (2022) with Somerset and pitcher Matt Seelinger (2021) with Reading.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have nine players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including **Marco Luciano** (No. 2), LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Luciano as the best power hitter, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. Luciano is also ranked as Baseball America's No. 55-overall prospect. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes nine Richmond players, including Luciano (No. 2), Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29). Luciano is ranked by MLB.com as the No. 17 prospect in baseball.
