### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox saw their four-game winning streak come to a close in a 7-2 loss to Binghamton on Friday night. The only runs for the Baysox came in the sixth inning on a **Samuel Basallo** mammoth two-run homer to right center. Bowie was held to just four additional hits apart from Basallo's homer. Binghamton's Jaylen Palmer hit two homers on the night and the Rumble Ponies pulled away from Bowie with three runs in the eighth inning.

### BASALLO IS HOT

Over his last 15 games, C **Samuel Basallo** is batting .375 (21-for-56) with five homers, three doubles, 16 RBI and an OPS of 1.149. With his two-run homer last night, Basallo extended his season-long on-base streak to 15 consecutive games, matching him with **Dylan Beavers** for the longest on-base streak on the team this season. Basallo has collected a hit now in six consecutive games. The Orioles No. 2 prospect has the fourth-most hits (55) and the fourth-most homers (10) in the league.

### TEENAGE DREAM

With his two-run shot last night, **Samuel Basallo** became just the ninth teenager to reach 10 home runs in a season at the Double-A level since the year 2005. Basallo is the first teen in the Eastern League to reach the mark since Vladimir Guerrero Jr did so with the New Hampshire Fisher Cats in 2018. Basallo's 55 games to reach 10 Double-A home runs makes him the third-fastest teenager to do so since 2005. Only Guerrero (44 GP in 2018) and Giancarlo Stanton (41 GP in 2009) reached 10 HR in fewer games.

### ON-BASE BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 39 of 45 games started in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect leads the team in OBP (.369) and leads the team in walks (29), the sixth-most in the Eastern League. Beavers is tied with **Samuel Basallo** for the team's longest on-base streak this season at 15 games.

### HUSHING THE PONIES

In 10 games against Binghamton this year, Bowie's pitching staff has recorded a 2.25 ERA in 88 innings, the lowest by any Eastern League team against the Rumble Ponies this season. After **Trace Bright**'s four innings last night, Baysox starters have combined to give up just nine earned runs over 39.2 innings thrown (2.04 ERA). The Rumble Ponies are batting just .183 against Baysox arms.

### BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (260.2) and strikeouts (308). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.21 WHIP, which is good for fifth-lowest in Double-A.

### BRNO ON THE BUMP

RHP **Kyle Brnovich** makes his sixth start of the season for the Baysox. The 26-year-old is coming off two strong starts at Somerset last week where he threw a total of 11 innings and gave up just one earned run. In his most recent start on Sunday, Brnovich twirled six shutout, no hit innings to pick up the win.

### SADDLING UP THE PONIES

Entering this week, the Binghamton Rumble Ponies are third in the Northeast Division at 26-23. The Double-A affiliate of the Mets most recently split their six game series against Harrisburg at home. The last time Bowie and Binghamton met was from May 14 - May 19 and Bowie won four of six at Mirabito Stadium. Seven of the Mets' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline, are on the active roster- OF/1B Ryan Clifford (No. 4), C Kevin Parada (No. 9), RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 13), OF Alex Ramirez (No. 16), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 18), RHP Nolan McLean (No. 19), RHP Joander Suarez (No. 28).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Cameron Foster gets the nod tonight for Binghamton. The 25-year-old is in his second Minor League season and first at the Double-A level. Tonight will be his sixth start of the season and 11th appearance for the Rumble Ponies. Foster has allowed four runs (one earned) in four innings against the Baysox this season, including a scoreless inning on Tuesday. Foster was a 14th round pick of the Mets in 2022 out of McNeese State.



## QUICK HITS

**Arsenal:** 4-Seam FB (91-95), Changeup (82-85), Curveball (81-85), Slider (82-86)  
**Acquired from LAA in Dylan Bundy deal, which included BAL RHP Kyle Bradish and BOW RHP Zach Peek Returns for his third stint with Baysox. First full healthy season since 2021.**

**2024:** Most recently made two starts @ SOM and allowed just 1 ER over 11 IP. Threw longest start by a Baysox pitcher this season with 6.0 shutout, no-hit innings with 6 K on Sun. 6/2 @ SOM. Before starts @ SOM, was used as a long reliever for five straight outings. Began season in rotation for three starts before being bumped into long relief role. Holds a 1.50 ERA as a starter in five starts this season. Owns a 3.74 ERA at home in five home outings. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster.

**2023:** Began season with FCL Orioles on a rehab assignment after recovering from Tommy John surgery. Made four rehab appearances between FCL Orioles, Single-A Delmarva and High-A Aberdeen before being sent to Double-A Bowie on July 25. Made four appearances (two starts) with Baysox and posted a 7.71 ERA in 14 innings, struck out 19 and gave up five homers.

**2022:** Began season with Triple-A Norfolk. Made two four-inning starts in April before suffering a right elbow injury. Underwent successful Tommy John surgery in May and missed rest of the season.

**2021:** Began first full season in Orioles system after trade. Started year in High-A Aberdeen and struck out 48 batters over 34.1 innings to an ERA of 2.36. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on June 22. Went five innings in six of his 11 starts and finished season with 75 K over 60.2 IP and an ERA of 3.86.

**2019:** Did not pitch a game while in LAA organization. Traded to BAL on Dec. 4, 2019, along with RHP Kyle Bradish, RHP Zach Peek, and RHP Isaac Mattson for RHP Dylan Bundy.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 8th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Los Angeles Angels out of Elon University. Pitched three seasons at Elon and was named a Consensus All-American in 2018. Struck out 360 batters in 281 career collegiate innings.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
