TODAY'S GAME / OPPOSING STARTER: Altoona meets Harrisburg for their final series of the season this week.

Jarlin Susana, a key piece in the Juan Soto/Josh Bell trade from Washington to San Diego in 2022 takes the ball today. Susana makes his 6th start of the season. He was limited this season with a torn lat muscle and needed surgery, today is his third Double-A start of the season. On Tuesday he allowed 3 runs on 4 hits in 2.2 innings and struck out 6. 18 different pitchers have started a game this season (including Jared Jones 2x) for the Curve, last year the Curve used 19 different starters.

ANOTHER 'PEN DAY: Altoona has had to rely on their bullpen for 25 games this season, the most since 2020. 9 different bullpen arms have started a game this year while the team has only had eight pitchers (Stumbo, Ager, Oliver, Wietgreffe, Curtis, Robinson, Perachi and Dombkowski) work as starters this season.

GRAY ZONE: Infielder **Murf Gray** has reached base safely in 37-of-39 games with the Curve. Gray is hitting .310 with 3 2B, 3 HR and 10 RBI in his last 11 games, totaling a .987 OPS.

Gray is 2nd in hits (136), T-1st in HR (31), 2nd in RBI (94) and T-2nd in 2B (25) across 120 games among Pirates minor leaguers. Gray is the fourth Pirates prospect since 2005 (Greensboro's Jhonny Severino is the fifth) to reach 30 HR in a season, joining Mason Martin (35, 2019), Andrew Lambo (32, 2013), and Steve Pearce (31, 2007). Lambo and Pearce each played with Altoona during their 30+ HR seasons.

FEELING SHORT: Back in Curve, PA, righty **Aaron Shortridge** has taken to the relief role in 2026. In his last 3 outings he's picked up his first career save and combined to throw 5.0 scoreless frames (15 straight hitters retired). He's been unscored upon in 5-of-7 outings since returning to Altoona and has struck out 16 batters in 11.0 innings.

EASTON BATS ON SALE IN CURVE, PA: Catcher **Easton Carmichael** ranks 3rd among Pirates Minor Leaguers in hits with 122. Among MiLB catchers, Carmichael ranks 3rd in hits (122), 14th in HR (20), and 3rd in RBI (87). Carmichael recorded multiple RBI in back-to-back games against Erie last week, batting .353 (6-for-17) with 3 2B and 6 RBI (.984 OPS) last week.

RECORD WATCH: With 8 games to go, Altoona has several franchise records that are being challenged in 2026.

- Both home run records (most hit (143) and allowed, (140) in a season) are in striking distance. Altoona has allowed a franchise record 149 home runs this year and have hit 136 in 130 games.
- Most walks in a season (532, 534 set on Sept. 1)
- Lowest win percentage in a season (.429, set in 2014) and most losses (81).
- Most strikeouts in a season at the plate (1,268, 2024).
- The Curve have allowed 10 or more runs in a game 16 times this season, surpassing the previous record set in 2000.
- Altoona has also yet to have a pitcher record a complete game this season on the mound, which would mark the third instance (last in 2022).

LONNIE LONGBALLS: Outfielder **Lonnie White Jr.** has emerged as one of the top hitters in Double-A baseball since the All-Star Break. White Jr. is third among Pirates minor leaguers in homers this season with 25 and has set his career-high with 65 RBI this season. White Jr. is third in the Eastern League in OPS (.891) and second in slugging percentage (.516) this year.

MOSS IS BOSS: 1B **Callan Moss** ranks 5th in the Eastern League in hits (118) and 7th in doubles (24) entering play on Sept. 4.

PUPPIES: Among the 23 position players that have suited up for the Curve, 12 have made their Double-A debut this season. Only 6 pitchers (25 total) who have thrown for the team this year have made their level debut. **Altoona's average batter age (per BB-Ref) of 23.0 is the youngest for the team in a single season in franchise history (23.5 in 2022 was previous low, average 24.1).**

ITS OUTTA HERE: The Curve have 29 games this season in which they've hit at least two home runs. The Curve have hit 136 home runs in 130 games, they're on pace to hit 146 homers which threatens the franchise record of 143 homers set in 2022. Eastern League clubs surpassed the league total of 1,223 home runs in 2025 on July 19 this season. Over the last 25 games, the Curve have allowed 39 home runs - the most by a Double-A club.

2011 - Starling Marte goes 1-for-3 on final day of the season to secure EL batting title with .332 average; The contest vs. Richmond is completed early due to rain with Richmond winning 2-1 on a "walk-off" solo homer by Wes Hodges in the top of the eighth. The umpires called for the tarp before the next batter came up and an 89-minute delay ultimately led to calling the rest of the game. Due to last game of the season and could not be resumed later so leader was the winner. Believed the only walk-off hit by away team in baseball history.
