#### FRISCO DOMINATES FINALE OVER MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders scored all their runs in two innings on Sunday night, including a Thomas Saggese home run, and defeated the Mid-Iand RockHounds 8-1 from Riders Field. By the sixth inning, all nine starters for Frisco (6-6, 37-43) had at least one base hit. Midland (8-4, 40-41) barely avoided a shutout by scrapping for a run in the eighth inning. Frisco scored three runs in the third inning, highlighted by a two-run double by **Scott Kapers**, and added five runs in the fifth that began with Saggese's leadoff home run. Saggese went 10-for-22 on the series with two home runs and four doubles. **Dane Acker** made his second start for the Riders and first in Frisco, holding Midland scoreless in three innings with three strikeouts. Justin Slaten (2-1) garnered the win by taking care of the next two innings without a run. David Leal (3-3) took the loss, going four innings with three earned runs. Reid Birlingmair continued the shutout bid in the sixth and seventh innings while making his RoughRiders and Double-A debut. Eudrys Manon allowed one run in the eighth but struck out three before Antoine Kelly closed out the ninth inning without a score. Luisangel Acuña went 1-for-4 on the day with his 12th single of the week, accounting for all 12 of his hits in 25 at-bats versus Midland. Kellen Strahm and Josh Hatcher both recorded a 2-for-4, with Hatcher earning an RBI in the sixth inning. Jax Biggers went 1-for-1 with a pair of sacrifice files. Frisco and Midland split the series at three games apiece and the RoughRiders head into the All-Star break with a .500 record in the second half. The RoughRiders have split five consecutive series, the longest streak in recorded franchise history.

#### WALK SIGN IS ON

The RoughRiders had a tough time with their command last series against Midland. On Saturday, the RoughRiders walked a franchise record 14 Midland batters and on the week, Frisco walked a Texas Leauge high 40 batters over the six games of the set while owning a 8.10 ERA. The RoughRiders' 2.04 WHIP over the last six games is the fourth-highest in Minor League Baseball among teams who have played six games.

#### WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

**Evan Carter** has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 17 games since his return, he has seven multi-hit games, batting .373 (25-for-67)/.434/.627/1.061 with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBIs and 13 runs scored. Carter is now seventh in the Texas League in batting average (.304) and seventh in OBP (.412).

### SPEAS, STEPHAN HONERED FOR JUNE:

SPEAS, STEPHAN HONERED FOR JUNE: The Texas Rangers announced on Thursday that **Alex Speas** had been named the Rangers Minor League Relief Pitcher of the Month for June as part of four awards for Rangers minor league players. Speas, who made eight appearances in June for the Frisco RoughRiders before getting called up to Round Rock (AAA) on June 30, was named the Relief Pitcher of the Month for the second consecutive time. The 25-year-old Speas did not allow an earned run in June in nine appearances, covering 14 innings. **Josh Stephan** won Starting Pitcher of the Month for posting a 2.16 ERA across 25 innings, all with High-A Hickory. Stephan was promoted to Frisco on July 4th to make his Double-A debut.

#### THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 29 games, he is hitting .381/.466/.717/1.183 with nine home runs and 26 RBIs. Saggese is currently on an nine-game hitting streak, batting .424 (14-for-33) during that stretch. The California native is currently fourth in the league in batting average (.316), third in RBIs (61), fifth in slugging percentage (.524), second in hits (99), third in doubles (20) and second in total bases (164).

#### AMBUSH FARLY AND OFTEN

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League with a .593 average (16-for-27) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.584 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .463 (25-for-54) on the initial offering while his 25 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 34 and is on pace for a career-best 61 swipes. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 107 bases in 128 attempts (83 percent).

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

#### ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder Luisangel Acuña has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect hit .300/.336/.460/.796 in June. Currently on an 13-game hitting streak, he is hitting .411/.441/.500/.941 during this stretch, including a four-hit game in game one of the doubleheader on Friday. He is fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.315), third in hits (98), sixth in doubles (19), third in runs (56) and first in steals (34). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (119).

#### WALK THIS WAY

On the season, Frisco's 384 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .355 team OBP is second in the Texas League. The Riders have three in the top 11 players in Texas League walk rate this season: **Trevor Hauver** (3rd, 15.9%), **Dustin Harris** (4th, 15.8%) and **Evan Carter** (11th, 14.2%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, Aaron Zavala is walking at a 17.3% rate so far this season.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

### 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five inning

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

### 2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

### 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

### **2019 SEASON**

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TI rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
