Norfolk Tides RHP Justin Armbruster (1-2, 8.80) vs Worcester Red Sox RHP Josh Winckowski (0-1, 3.86)

Six More Gets Us to Twelve – The Worcester Red Sox – coming off a successful first half of their 12-game homestand when they took 4 of 6 games from the 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders last week/weekend – begin the second half of their season-long homestand tonight at Polar Park when they play the opener of a 6-game series against the defending Triple-A Champion Norfolk Tides (AAA-Baltimore) at 6:05 pm. The game will be shown on tape delay on NESN+ at 9:30 pm tonight and can be heard live on NASH 98.9 FM, The Pike 100.1 FM, and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. The WooSox and Tides – who are 1-game ahead of the Sox - play tonight & tomorrow at 6:05 pm, Thursday at 12:15 pm, Friday at 6:05 pm, Saturday at 4:05 pm, and Sunday at 1:05 pm.

Last Series – As mentioned, the WooSox took 4 of 6 from the RailRiders last week/weekend to become only the second team to win a series over Scranton/WB and become the first team all year to win four games during a series vs. SWB. The RailRiders only other series loss came when they dropped 3 of 5 in an abbreviated set vs. Syracuse all the way back from April 4-7.

Taking on the Champs – The homestand certainly doesn't get any easier for the WooSox as they now host the Norfolk Tides who are led by top prospects INF Jackson Holliday, OF Heston Kierstad, and INF Colby Mayo (who is currently on the injured list). Old friends reliever Kaleb Ort and former WooSox assistant hitting coach and current Norfolk hitting coach also come back to Worcester as members of the Tides. Last season, Norfolk won the first half of the International League schedule with their 48-26 record and took on Durham (second half champs) in the International League Playoffs last September 26-28. The Tides lost the opener but then won the final two games to capture the Governors' Cup Championship. Two nights later in Las Vegas, Norfolk defeated Pacific Coast League Champion Oklahoma City (AAA-Dodgers), 7-6 to win the Triple-A National Championship Game.

Worcester vs. Norfolk – The WooSox were 5-7 vs. Norfolk last season, but went just 1-5 here at Polar Park compared to 4-2 in Norfolk. The clubs met last June 13-18 in Virginia with the Sox taking 4 of 6 including the final three games in a row to become the first team in 2023 to win a series vs. Norfolk. Norfolk came to Worcester a little more than two months later from August 29 – September 3 and the Tides won 5 of 6 although the WooSox did win the finale, 5-4. Worcester also played in Norfolk, VA during the 2022 season splitting a 6-game set from July 12-17, 2022. So, Worcester is now 8-10 all-time vs. the Tides.

A Dozen or More – Worcester has played two extended homestands twice during each of their first three years of existence. This current 12-game homestand is the only double figure homestand of this season. The WooSox do play a 9-game homestand from July 4-12 that includes 3-games vs. Syracuse, interrupted by consecutive off-days, followed by 6-games vs. Rochester. The six previous "long" homestands in WooSox history...

Two for Ones – Worcester was the only team without a 1-run victory this season – until Thursday night (and then Friday night as well). The WooSox were 0-7 in 1-run games this year until Thursday's dramatic, 13-12 win followed by Friday's 9-8 triumph. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 4-5 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

Chance to Get Even – The WooSox (now 22-23 on the year) can once again return to the .500 level with a victory tonight. They had climbed back to the .500 mark after their May 5th victory (at 16-16) for the first time in a month since they were 3-3 on April 5. They have not been over .500 since they were 2-1 on March 31.

Chasing the Tides – The WooSox are currently in 6th-place in the IL East and 7½ games behind front running Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. They faced a season-high 9½ game deficit on May 12 & 15. Norfolk is tied for 4th-place but only 1-game ahead of the WooSox.

What Have You Done for me Lately – Worcester is 9-7 in their last 16 games and they have won 12 of their last 20 games since April 28. They have also not lost more than two in a row since their season-high 4-game losing streak from April 10-14.

HomeGoods - The WooSox – who have won 10 of their last 13 home games at Polar Park – have begun their longest homestand of the season at 4-2.

Home Getting Sweeter & Sweeter - Worcester has also won 13 of their last 17 home games dating back to April 16. As a result, the WooSox are 14-9 at home and a season-high 5-games over the .500 mark at Polar Park. Worcester went 43-33 at home last year.

Daydream Believers – Worcester has had more success this season in day games (14-11) than at night (8-12).

Four of a Kind – The WooSox had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a season-long 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – Sox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 35 times this season.

Rankings – Worcester is 14th in the IL in team batting with a .244 average while Norfolk is 5th at .262. On the pitching side, the Sox are 15th in team ERA (5.11) while the Tides are 7th with a 4.67 ERA.

Comeback Kids – Worcester has 12 CFB victories this season including 4 wins in their last at-bat of the game and one walk-off.

Series Math – Worcester is 4-4-0 in their first eight series of 2024 (4 wins, 4 losses, and no splits). They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5th-place and 7 games back. They were in 8th-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

May So Far – Worcester is 10-8 in May. Sox pitchers have a 4.77 ERA (79 ER in 149 IP) with 14 HRA while Sox batters are hitting .250 this month (138-for-551) with 22 HR.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (20-17) open an 8-game series at home vs. the Hartford Yard Goats that begins with a make-up doubleheader tonight. The teams also play another twin bill during the series that lasts through Sunday.

Portland LHP Zach Penrod was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Week for the week of May 13th-19th. The 26-year-old made one start during the week, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth inning while tying a career-high with ten strikeouts in a 2-1 win on May 18th against the Somerset Patriots (Yankees).

Penrod is 3-0 in six starts this season with a 2.10 ERA and has struck out 44 in 30.0 innings. He ranks among the league leaders in several categories including third in batting average against (.173), fourth in strikeouts (44) and WHIP (1.00), and fifth in ERA (2.10).

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – None today as of early afternoon.

Worcester has already used 48 players this season (21 position players and 27 pitchers) and that does not include LHP Joely Rodriguez who joined the WooSox last week but did not pitch and was placed on the injured list on Sunday with right hip inflammation.

The WooSox have sent 10 players to Boston in the 7 weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder, INF Vaughn Grissom, and RHP Nick Pivetta who were all injury rehab recalls from Worcester to Boston. Dalbec, Uwasawa, and Heineman are all back with the WooSox, while Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona. The rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.

- Won a silver medal at the 2014 Winter Olympics in Speed Skating (5000m relay) ... Chose skating over baseball after hitting .303 for Salt Lake CC in 2011, dealt with chronic knee pain that hampered skating career from 2011-13 before becoming the first Cuban-American male speed skater to make a U.S. Olympic team ... Returned to baseball in 2014
- Has participated in winter Olympics (speed skating) and summer Olympics (baseball), was a flag bearer in 2021 Olympics along with Sue Bird ... Became the sixth person and third American to medal in both Games (and the first male athlete from any country since 1936) .. Also the first nonbaseball Olympian to play in Majors since Jim Thorpe ... Weighed 150 pounds in Sochi in 2014
- Has the Olympic rings tattooed in his lefticeps ... "Besides turning left, I don't think there's much similarity"
