LAST OUTING: Patrick took the win with five innings of one-run baseball against Charlotte in game two of a doubleheader last Thursday at First Horizon Park. He became the first Sounds pitcher to have 12 strikeouts in a game since Josh Lindblom on August 20, 2021 at Memphis (6.2 IP) and the first to have 12 Ks in five innings since Eric Lauer on May 20, 2021 at Gwinnett. The Knights scored their lone run in the first inning on Carlos Perez's double. Patrick's first eight outs were via strikeout. He also struck out five straight between the second and third innings.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's first start against Charlotte.
