

The Fightin Phils remain home and finish a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. It is the sixth-of-18 matchups this season between the teams, and last-of-six at FirstEnergy Stadium. Hartford won the 2024 season-series over Reading 10-8. Following this week, the Fightin Phils go to Hartford from July 29-August 3 and Sept. 2-7. Hartford leads the season-series 3-2.

Game 66 Recap

It was a nearly spotless night on both sides of the ball as the Fightin Phils toppled the Yard Goats 12-2 in the penultimate game of the first half of the season. Chuck King set the tone with six innings of work, allowing two runs and striking out three, while picking up his third win. Daniel Harper (1.2 IP) and Tommy McCollum (1.1 IP) each had scoreless appearances out of the bullpen. Reading clubbed 17 hits on the night, which included eight doubles and 10 extra-base hits in total. Aidan Miller, Alex Binelas, Paul McIntosh, Robert Moore and Luis Verdugo had two hits each, while Felix Reyes had three hits, including a double and home run. Miller tripled as well in his first game back in nine days. Binelas, Moore and Verdugo all had two doubles as well in the win.

More on Last Night

On Saturday night, Reading set season highs in: hits (17), doubles (8) and extra-base hits (10). They tied season-highs in runs (12), hits in an inning (5) and margin of victory (10). Reading's 17 hits were its most in a game since having 17 base knocks in back-to-back games on May 5-6, 2023, at Hartford. All nine member of the starting lineup had a hit on Saturday, which was the first time that's happened since July 24, 2024, at New Hampshire. The last time the R-Phils had eight doubles in a game was June 29, 2018, and it was just the fourth time they've have eight-plus doubles in a game since 2005. Additionally, Reading's last time with 10-plus extra-base hits in a game was July 8, 2016.

Hendry Making History

It is believed that Hendry Mendez hit for the first cycle in R-Phils history on Friday night. Mendez had four hits, three runs and three RBI. He hit a triple in his first at bat, then singled his next time up. Mendez then launched his fifth home run of the season in the sixth inning. Then, Mendez stepped up in the bottom of the eighth a double shy of the cycle, and he lined a 3-1 pitch to right-center field and stopped at second base to complete the historic feat. Dating back to 2005 (as far back as MLB's research tool keeps MiLB stats), no R-Phil has hit a cycle. Records prior to 2005 show no prior cycles were ever hit by an R-Phil, but data is incomplete. But, it is beleived that Mendez now holds the distinction of the first cycle in R-Phils history, dating back to 1967.

End of the First Half

Sunday's game against Hartford will mark the conclusion of the first half of the 2025 season. Following Monday's off day, the Fightin Phils open the second half of the season at Richmond on Tuesday. It marks the second time in three years that Reading will open the second half against the Flying Squirrels, as Richmond came to FirstEnergy Stadium in late-June of 2023.

Hammering Homers

The Fightin Phils have launched 23 home runs since the start of June. That is a mark that is most in the Eastern League, and three ahead of second place Somerset, who has 20. Reading ranks tied for third in the league in home runs this season with 56.

Trip Trip Triples

Since the start of June, the Fightin Phils have hit seven triples, a mark that is tied for first in the Eastern League over that stretch. Since the start of June, Hendry Mendez has hit three triples, a mark tied for first in the Eastern League over that stretch with Binghamton's Jett Williams and Somerset's Dylan Jasso.

Hartford enters tonight with a 35-33 record, 10-games back of Northeast Division first half champion Binghamton. The Yard Goats dropped four-of-six against Akron last week, including losing the final three games. After this week, Hartford returns home to face New Hampshire. Hartford's roster features eight of Colorado's top-30 prosepcts: Cole Carrigg (2), Seam Sullivan (8), Benny Montgomery (13), Kyle Karros (18), Wlinton Herrera (20), Jack Mahoney (24), Dylan Jorge (27) and Connor Staine (30).

Goat on the Bump

Righty, and Rockies' No. 30 prospect, Connor Staine starts tonight for Hartford. Staine's 1-5, with a 4.56 ERA (24 ER, 47.1 IP) over 12 starts. Staine suffered the loss Tuesday at Reading, allowing five runs over 3.2 IP, with four strikeouts. Last season with Spokane (A+), Staine went 4-6, with a 4.48 ERA over 20 appearances. The Rockies drafted the 24-year old in the fifth round of the 2022 draft out of UCF.
