NOTES AND NUGGETS

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

While the Storm Chasers do not lead the league in stolen bases, Omaha has one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

- Omaha has successfully stolen 116 bases this year, and only been caught 19 times ... 116 steals rank 5th in the International League and 6th in Triple-A.
- 116-for-135 in steal attempts is a 85.9% success rate, tied for the BEST stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and tied 3rd-best among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: New Hampshire Fisher Cats, 88.4%, 76-for-86).

I CAN'T TOUCH THIS

The Omaha Storm Chasers pitching staff sits near the top of the Triple-A level in strikeouts, with 778 strikeouts this season ... that is the 7th-most of any Triple-A club.

- Over 733.2 innings, Omaha pitchers are averaging 9.54 K/9, which ranks 6th in the International League and 7th at the Triple-A level.
- With 778 strikeouts through 85 games, an average of 9.54 strikeouts per game has the staff on pace for 1,367 strikeouts this season ... the franchise record is 1,282 strikeouts by the 2023 Storm Chasers.
- In the 1st half, Omaha's strikeout rate was 9.95 K/9 ... in the first 11 games of the 2nd half, the team's strikeout rate is 6.80 K/9 (71 K in 94.0 IP), the lowest at the Triple-A level and 7th-worst in the Minors since the start of last week.
- In the 5 games against the Cubs this week, Omaha has 25 walks and 27 strikeouts ... in the 2nd half of the season, the Chasers' 1.61 K/BB is the 5th-lowest in Triple-A.

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

- Outfielder **Dairon Blanco** is hitting .406 (13-for-32) since the 2nd half began on June 24 ... 8 of his 13 hits have gone for extra-bases, with 5 doubles and 3 home runs ... he is tied for the team lead in the 2nd half with 27 total bases.
- Infielder **Cam Devanney** is tied with Blanco for the 2nd half team lead with 27 total bases, also tied for the team lead with 9 RBI ... he is hitting .275 (11-for-40) with 8 of his 11 hits going for extra-bases, featuring 4 doubles and 4 homers.
- Catcher **Carter Jensen** joined Omaha for the second half and leads the club with 5 home runs since arriving, with all 8 of his hits going for extra-bases, for 26 total bases ... he's tied for the team lead with 9 runs batted in ... **Joey Wiemer** is just 6-for-44 (.136 average) since June 24, but his 9 RBI are tied for the team lead.

KICKSTART MY GAME

While Omaha's starting pitchers have combined for one of the highest ERA's at the Triple-A level (6.30 ERA), there have been many good outings this year from Storm Chaser starters, including recently.

- Thomas Hatch's** 6.0 scoreless innings last night marked the 15th scoreless start for an Omaha pitcher this year ... it was the 10th time in 2025 a Storm Chasers starting pitcher has thrown 5.0 scoreless innings or more ... it was Omaha's 3rd 7-inning start of the season, the 2nd from Hatch.
- When Omaha starters go at least 5.0 innings this year (39 times), the Storm Chasers are 16-8 ... in the 2nd half (11 games), Omaha has gotten 5 starts of at least 5.0 innings from their starting pitcher.

WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha's bullpen was one of the best at the Triple-A level in June, with a strong stretch from the relievers last week.

- Over 25 games in the month of June, Omaha's bullpen has a 3.73 ERA (45 ER in 108.2 IP) that ranked as the 3rd-best at the Triple-A level last month ... the relievers have a 2.44 strikeout-to-walk ratio that also ranks 3rd at the Triple-A level in June.
- Omaha's bullpen has 19 scoreless efforts this year, or once in every 4.2 games ... 10 of 19 scoreless games from the relievers have been 4.0 innings or more.

THE FUTURE IS HERE

Monday morning, it was announced that Storm Chasers catcher **Carter Jensen** will represent the Kansas City Royals on the American League roster at the 2025 All-Star Futures Game.

- Jensen will be one of two Royals prospects on the AL roster, joined by LHP **Frank Mozzicato**, who is currently with Double-A Northwest Arkansas.
- Since his first full season in 2022, Jensen's 278 walks rank 5th in Minor League Baseball ... in that window, he ranks 1st among Royals Minor Leaguers in PA (1875), 3rd in RBI (207), 3rd in HR (51), 4th in 2B (76), 4th in R (239) and 5th in H (378).
- Jensen began 2025 with NW Arkansas after being promoted to Double-A in July, 2024 and finishing last season with the Naturals ... at the time of his promotion to Triple-A on June 23, he led the Texas League in hits (80) and total bases (115), ranked 5th in runs batted in (37) and 6th in batting average (.292).

- Dunn is making his **2nd start with Omaha**, his **9th Triple-A start this year** and his **15th overall appearance this season** ... assigned to Omaha on Saturday, June 28th.
- Signed a Minor League contract with the Chicago White Sox in November 2024, began the year in the Charlotte Knights' (AAA) rotation, moved to the bullpen and was released on May 28 ... signed a Minor League deal with the Royals on June 5 and made 3 appearances in the Arizona Complex League before joining the Chasers.
- Playing his **9th professional season this year** ... Royals are Dunn's 5th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Mets, Mariners, Reds and White Sox ... has appeared in 32 Major League games (all starts) between 2019 and 2022, his last MLB outing was with Cincinnati on September 11, 2022 @ Milwaukee.

Made his 1st start with Omaha, his 4th in the Royals organization ... opened the game with 2.0 scoreless innings, working around a walk and single in the 1st, then pitching a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd ... a hit batter and walk opened the 3rd, then runs scored on a sac fly and wild pitch ... got a strikeout, then walked a batter to end his day in the 3rd.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- After signing with the Chicago White Sox on November 8, 2024, opened the season in the starting rotation for the Charlotte Knights (AAA) ... made 7 starts for the Knights before moving to the bullpen for 3 relief appearances.
- Struck out 17 batters across his first two starts, April 1 & 6 vs. Norfolk (BAL), across 8.1 innings (18.36 K/9).
- Made 1 quality start with Charlotte, on April 18 @ Nashville (MIL) ... threw 6.0 scoreless innings, with 4 strikeouts and a pair of 1-2-3 innings ... was the middle start in a 3-outing stretch between April 12 and 25, where he allowed 2 earned runs in 15.1 innings (1.17 ERA).

 - Was acquired by Cincinnati from Seattle on March 14 with OF Jake Fraley, LHP Brandon Williamson and a PTBNL (RHP Connor Phillips) in return for 3B Eugenio Suarez and OF Jesse Winker.

Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game since 2000. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
