**Tonight:** The Lugnuts play the fifth game of a six-game series with the West Michigan Whitecaps, the 11th meeting of 24 between the archrivals this season. After splitting a six-game set in June, the two teams have now halved the first two games of the current series. Right-hander **Colin Peluse**, Baseball America's No. 26 Oakland Athletics prospect, takes on the man who puts the White in Whitecaps, right-hander **Brendan White**.

**Last Night:** Whitecaps 6, Lugnuts 5. The 'Caps used a five-run sixth inning, featuring six walks and a three-run triple by **Eric De La Rosa**, to hold off the Lugnuts on Friday night. In defeat, **Michael Guldberg** hit a two-run homer, his fifth career professional roundtripper.

**On Deck:** The Nuts play the Whitecaps through tomorrow before returning home July 27-August 1 against the Fort Wayne TinCaps.

**What's New in 2021:** Entering this season, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, Lansing moved up to the High-A Central and the ballclub accepted an invitation to affiliate with the A's, the Nuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Royals (1996-98), Cubs (1999-2004) and Blue Jays (2005-2020).

### LUG•NOTES: HEADLINES AND POINTS OF INTEREST

**No Place Like Close to Home:** The Lugnuts are in the midst of a period of easy travel. Between June 28 and August 1, the Nuts don't leave the state of Michigan, with their only road trips to Midland (Great Lakes) and Comstock Park (West Michigan).

**Pitching is an Art... and So is Sculpting:** **Blake McFarland**, who pitched for the 2012 Lansing Lugnuts, is now a professional sculptor. He competed on NBC's reality show "Making It," hosted by Nick Offerman and Amy Poehler, but was eliminated in the fifth episode, which aired Thursday night.

**Alumni Report:** **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who played for the 2017 Lugnuts, is fourth in the Majors in batting average (.325), second in home runs (32), tied for first in RBIs (79), first in on-base percentage (.426), second in slugging (.669), first in total bases (224), first in OPS (1.094) and tied for first in runs scored (75). 2019 Lugs outfielder **Griffin Conine**, playing for Beloit (MIA), leads the Minors with 23 homers.

**Going Deep:** Is it difficult to homer at LMCU Ballpark? Sure it is, but don't tell the Lugnuts. Lansing has hit three home runs in this series -- a two-run shot by **Cobie Vance** in the opener, a grand slam by **Austin Beck** two days ago, and a two-run tater from **Michael Guldberg** last night. In total, the Lugnuts have six home runs in 10 games at West Michigan. The Whitecaps, meanwhile, have hit four of their 11 home HRs against the Nuts.

**Countdown to 400:** We are ten meetings away from the 400th game between the Lugnuts and Whitecaps all-time, currently scheduled to take place on September 15th in Lansing. The two teams have split the prior 390 meetings, 195-195.

**Hoya Saxa:** Right-hander **Jack Cushing**, a product of Georgetown, has been brilliant since joining the Lugnuts from Low-A Stockton. Cushing's appearances: six innings, one run vs. Dayton; a seven-inning complete game, one run at Great Lakes; five shutout innings of relief vs. Lake County; and Thursday night's six innings, two runs at West Michigan. All told, Cushing has 25 strikeouts and five walks in 24 innings with a 1.50 ERA, allowing an OBA of .157.

**Trusted Relief:** This series involves the most heavily used relief pitchers in the High-A Central, with **Jared Tobey** (28 games, 1st in the league), **Dalton Sawyer** (27 games, 2nd), **Zack Hess** (26 games, 3rd), and **Charles Hall** and **Angel Reyes** (25 games, T-4th), (24 games, T-4th). All five have already appeared twice in this series.

**Whitecaps Killer:** Catcher **Drew Millas** drove in the Lugnuts' first two runs yesterday with an RBI single and a sacrifice fly and is now hitting 13-for-31 (.419) with six runs, one double, two homers and seven walks (.513 on-base percentage) in eight games against West Michigan this year. Millas enters today having hit safely in his last seven games. A hit tonight, and he'll tie the promoted **Jake Suddleson** for second longest hit streak this season.

## TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2015:** The Lugnuts mashed a team record 23 hits and equaled the most lopsided win in franchise history, beating Dayton 18-1.

**2019:** An 82-minute eighth inning in West Michigan saw two separate delays due to light-tower failures, with the Lugnuts breaking a 1-1 tie with two runs, only to allow three runs and lose 4-3. The final, tie-breaking run came in on a controversial catcher's interference call against Hagen Danner – which was immediately followed by the second lights-out delay.

**Root, Root, Root for the Home Team:** July 4th's Lugnuts/Dragons series finale drew a season-high attendance of 10,109. That's a larger crowd than any of the Blue Jays' home games this season in Dunedin or Buffalo and it's higher than the average attendance in MLB for the Baltimore Orioles, Pittsburgh Pirates, Tampa Bay Rays, Oakland Athletics, Miami Marlins and Toronto/Buffalo/Dunedin Blue Jays. Only eight of the 119 other Minor League teams have drawn a larger crowd to a game this season: Albuquerque, Nashville, Charlotte, Fresno, Indianapolis, Round Rock, Durham and Las Vegas.

**Roster Index:** The newest Nut, **José Mora**, is the 845th Lugnut all-time and the 41st player used this year. The 2021 Lugnuts have surpassed the total number of players used in the 1996 (40), 1999 (38), 2001 (40) and 2009 (38) seasons. The franchise record for most players used in a single year is 54, set in 2017. Currently, 18.6% of all Lugnuts have reached the Major Leagues (157 of 845). If that percentage continues to hold true, at least seven of the 41 players to see time this year with the Nuts will reach MLB.

**Major League Lugnuts:** Three former Nuts have made their Major League debuts this season, bringing the total to 157 all-time - pitcher **Ty Tice** '18, outfielder **Josh Palacios** '16-'17, and pitcher **Taylor Saucedo** '16-'17. Tice and Palacios made their first MLB appearance in the same game for the Toronto Blue Jays on April 9th. It was the seventh time in team history that two Lugnuts made their MLB debut in the same game, with the first occurring on September 14, 1998: **Carlos Febles** and **Carlos Beltrán** for the Kansas City Royals. Saucedo most recently debuted, tossing a scoreless inning for the Blue Jays on June 17.

**Star of Stars:** The 2021 MLB All-Star Game MVP Award was won by 2017 Lugnut **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.**, who went 1-for-3 with two RBIs, including a 468-foot home run, in the American League's 5-2 victory. Fellow 2017 Lugnut **Bo Bichette** came off the bench for the A.L. as reserve shortstop.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, Stolen Bases:** On June 15, **Max Schuemann** broke **Samad Taylor's** franchise single-game record of four steals in a game (set July 1, 2018) with five stolen bases against the Great Lakes Loons.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, Home Runs Allowed:** On June 20, **Stevie Emanuels** broke the franchise single game record, tied many times before, of three homers served up in a game, giving up four HRs to the Loons - two apiece by Deacon Liput and Andy Pages.

**Record-Setting, Single Game, HBPs:** On July 14, Lansing Lugnuts pitchers hit seven Lake County Captains, breaking the franchise single game record, and the second-highest single game HBP total for a team plunked by one pitching staff behind the 1993 Gulf Coast League Braves, who were hit eight times on June 18, 1993.

**Representing His Country:** 1B/3B **Jordan Diaz** played for Colombia in Olympic Baseball Qualifying play, blasting a game-tying home run in the 9th against Venezuela, but Colombia lost all three games in opening pool play and was eliminated. Team USA won the tournament, punching a ticket to Japan.

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**Clubhouse of Higher Learning:** The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. First baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard University, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth College and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell University before grad-transferring to Wake Forest. Speaking of outstanding academic institutions, starter **Jack Cushing** spent four years at Georgetown University.

**International Appeal:** In addition to 16 different states (Arizona, California, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Minnesota, Nevada (Connor Hughes), North Carolina, Ohio (Scott Steinmann), Texas, Virginia, Washington) represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, seven nations are represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa (Anthony Phillips) and Venezuela (Javier Godard).

**Finally:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielder **Michael Guldborg** have all made their pro debut this season with the Lugnuts.

**So Many Starters:** The Lugnuts have used 14 different starting pitchers this season, namely **Brady Basso**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Jeff Criswell**, **Jack Cushing**, **David Leal**, **Stevie Emanuels**, **Richard Guasch**, **Rafael Kelly**, **Bryce Nightengale**, **Colin Peluse**, **Leudeny Pineda**, **Seth Shuman**, **Shohei Tomioka** and **Brock Whittlesey**.

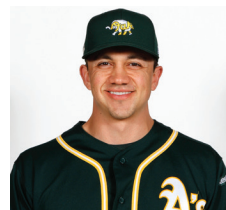

**Last Outing:** July 17 vs. Lake County... earned the victory, striking out five batters in five innings while allowing two runs (one earned) - one in the 1st inning and one in the 3rd inning... Lugnuts brought a 7-3 lead to the 9th and held on, 7-6.

- left-handed batters are hitting .194/.231/.316 w/ 3 HR, right-handers .360/.427/.581 w/ 3 HR.  
- 5 G / 4 GS at home: 1.90 ERA / .236 avg. in 23 2/3 IP... 5 G / 4 GS on the road: 7.04 ERA / .305 avg. in 23 IP.

- May 8 vs. Lake County: Relieved Jeff Criswell (2 IP) and Shohei Tomioka (3 IP)... worked with William Simoneit, a fellow Demon Deacon, to form an all-Wake Forest battery... picked Bryan Lavastida off 1st base in the 6th inning... opened the ninth with two walks and was taken out in favor of Aiden McIntyre, who sewed up the 2-0 win.  
- May 15 at Dayton: Relieved Seth Shuman (2 IP)... gave up a Brian Rey HR for only run... exited with 2-1 lead, but Michael Danielak gave up a two-run HR to Bren Spillane in the 8th.  
- May 22 at Fort Wayne: Made first start... allowed a Jonny Homza solo HR in the 3rd... departed in the 4th with one out, one run in and the bases loaded, and Bryce Nightengale allowed all three inherited runners to score.  
- May 29 vs. Great Lakes: gave up solo HR to Andy Pages in the 1st... exited after allowing first two batters to reach base in the 6th, one of whom scored against Bryce Nightengale.  
- June 5 vs. South Bend: Domination. 10 strikeouts in 5 2/3 innings... allowed only run in the 2nd inning on a Bryce Windham RBI single.  
- June 12 at West Michigan: Held Whitecaps scoreless for the first four innings... five hits and five runs in the 5th.  
- June 19 vs. Great Lakes: gave up a Deacon Liput two-run HR in the 4th... Lugnuts rallied from 2-0, 4-2, and 5-4 deficits to win 6-5 in 10 innings on Elvis Peralta, Jr.'s walk-off single.  
- June 26 at Cedar Rapids: exited with 3-2 lead, in line for the win, but Leudeny Pineda gave up two runs in the 7th... Lugnuts rallied for 5-4 victory in 11 innings.  
- July 11 at Great Lakes - served up home runs to the first two Loons batters, James Outman and Justin Yurchak, before blanking the Loons over the next 12 outs, with five strikeouts.

**Prospecting:** Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider"... MLB Pipeline's No. 28 A's prospect, grading his fastball at 55, slider at 55, change-up at 50 and control at 45, writing about Peluse, "A ninth-round pick in 2019, Peluse has put himself on the prospect radar for the A's after showing up to the instructional league that consistently hit 97-98. Now carrying a power fastball, Peluse also brings a strong slider that flashes plus, as well as a changeup that is still developing."

**Draft Day:** Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... highest of five Wake Forest players drafted in 2019... only one Demon Deacon was drafted in 2020, but it was Braves first-rounder Jared Shuster, taken 25th overall... one of nine Lugnuts drafted in 2019, including the 6th round (Seth Shuman), 7th round (Drew Millas), 10th round (Patrick McColl), 16th round (Brady Basso), 19th round (Jared McDonald), 21st round (Shane Selman), 26th round (Elvis Peralta, Jr.) and 33rd round (Charles Hall)... college teammates with 2019 Lugnuts third baseman Johnny Aiello.

**Life as a Pro:** Debuted with SS-A Vermont on June 28th, 2019... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.
