FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue a six-game road series on Saturday night against the Columbus Clingstones, the Atlanta Braves' Double-A affiliate. Rocket City is coming off a 1-5 series loss to Birmingham at Toyota Field from July 29 to August 3. This marks the second of three meetings between the two clubs this season. The Trash Pandas took two of three from Columbus in their first matchup at Toyota Field, July 18-20, which included a split doubleheader on the final day. The teams will meet one final time in Madison from August 26-31.

COLÁS' GRAND SLAM NOT ENOUGH IN LOSS TO COLUMBUS: Oscar Colás' seventh-inning grand slam wasn't enough as the Rocket City Trash Pandas fell 7-4 to the Columbus Clingstones on Friday, their fourth straight loss. Making his first start in 16 months after Tommy John surgery, Bryce Osmond struck out four in 2+ innings but allowed three runs. Columbus built a 7-0 lead with three homers and a big fifth inning before Colas' 10th homer cut the deficit. Rocket City stranded 10 runners, going 1-for-10 with runners in

GRAND SALAMI TIME: Oscar Colás' grand slam on Friday marked the Trash Pandas' second of the season and the 11th in franchise history. Since May 30, Colás has packed a punch, leading the Southern League with nine home runs

FARRIS WHEELING AND DEALING STRIKEOUTS: LHP Mitch Farris leads the Southern League with 119 strikeouts across 20 appearances (19 starts) in 2025. Farris is currently 3rd in team history in single-season strikeouts, trailing only Coleman Crow (128, 2022), and franchise record-holder Caden Dana, who struck out 147 batters in 2024.

WALBERT IS IN HIS UREÑA OF EXCELLENCE: RHP Walbert Urena has a 3.00 ERA (9 ER/27.0 IP) over his last five starts since July 9. Urena ranks among the league leaders in games started (T-1st, 21), innings pitched (2nd, 102.1), and complete games (T-1st, 1).

FEELING CALABREEZY IN ROCKET CITY: OF David Calabrese is back in his fourth stint in Rocket City since 2023, and is now 4th on the all-time list in games played for the Trash Pandas with 205. He sits behind **Orlando Martinez** (296), **Tucker Flint** (244), and **Bryce Teodosio** (230).

MURPHY MAKES HIS MARK: RHP Luke Murphy, back for his second stint in Rocket City in 2025, tossed a scoreless inning in Friday's game to extend his franchise-record 110 appearances from 2022-2025. The Vanderbilt product also ranks third in team history with 10 wins, is tied for first with 21 holds, and sits fifth with 153 strikeouts.

COSMIC SHAKEUP: 26 ROSTER MOVES SINCE SATURDAY: On Wednesday, RHP Luke Murphy and RHP Kenyon Yovan were transferred to Rocket City from Triple-A Salt Lake. OF David Calabrese rejoins the team from High-A Tri-City, RHP **Bryce Osmond** was reinstated from the 60-day Injured List, and C Yeremi Villahermosa was transferred from BCA and placed on the Development (ist. In corresponding moves, LHP AJ Block, RHP Endrys Briceno, INF Evan Edwards, and C Jaxx Groshans were uncondi-

On Saturday, the Angels announced 16 roster moves that impacted the Rocket City Trash Pandas on Saturday. Headlining the changes were the promotions of RHP **Brady Choban**, INF **Denzer Guzman**, and OF **Nelson Rada** to Triple-A Salt Lake. On the injury front, OF **Joe Redfield**, RHP **Jordan Holloway**, and INF Evan White were placed on the 60-day Injured List. The Angels gave an unconditional release to RHP Sean Poppen. Joining the Trash Pandas from Triple-A Salt Lake is 0F Korey Holland, while seven players were added from High-A Tri-City. INF Matt Coutney, RHP Max Gieg, INF Ryan Nicholson, RHP Roman Phansalkar, LHP Dylan Phillips, RHP Jake Smith, and INF Arol Vera.

DENZER GUZMAN NAMED SL PLAYER OF THE MONTH: On Wednesday, MilB named Denzer Guzman the Southern League Player of the Month for July, becoming just the sixth player in Trash Pandas history to earn the honor—and the first since Gustavo Campero in July 2024. Guzman was one of the league's most consistent and productive hitters throughout the month. He led the Southern League in OPS (1.020), slugging percentage (.580), extra-base hits (13), and total bases (47). He also finished second in batting average (.333), on-base percentage (.440), and doubles (9), while his 27 hits tied for fifth. Guzman was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake on August 2.

THE ELEPHANT IN THE ROOM: The Trash Pandas are currently 35-70 on the season, and the 70 losses are the most in all of Minor League Baseball this season.

PUTTING IN THE WORK: Three Trash Pandas hurlers rank among the top nine in the Southern League in innings pitched with **Walbert Urena** ranking 2nd with 102.1 innings pitched, followed by **Mitch Farris** (T-6th, 98.1 IP), and **Sam Aldegheri** (9th, 96.2 IP).

KLASSEN AND ALDEGHERI DEALT IN JULY: LHP Sam Aldegheri and RHP George Klassen were two of the Southern League's best starters in July. Aldegheri led the league with a 0.78 ERA. In four starts, the left-hander went 3-0, allowing just four earned runs over 23.0 innings while recording 19 strikeouts and 10 walks. Klassen finished T-1st in the league with 26 strikeouts over four starts, finishing with a 3.32 ERA, striking out 26 and walking seven across 21.2 innings.

PITCHING STAFF PACKED A PUNCH IN JULY: The Rocket City pitching staff racked up 213 strikeouts over 24 games in July—an average of 8.9 strikeouts per game—ranking 3rd in the Southern League and 9th across all of Double-A.

SAM BROWN TRADED TO NATS: On Wednesday, the Angels traded Trash Pandas first baseman Sam **Brown** to the Washington Nationals as part of a four-player deal. A 2023 12th-round pick out of Washington State, Brown hit .244 with 12 doubles, five homers, and 40 RBI in 92 games for Rocket City this season.

- ROCKET CITY LIVED UP TO ITS NAME IN JULY: In July, the Trash Pandas launched 19 home runs over 24 games, 3rd in the Southern League and ranking T-10th in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch included a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. The surge was fueled by Oscar Colás and Ben Gobbel, who combined for 10 of the 19 homers. Colás led the league in that span with six, while Gobbel was T-4th.
- SOUND THE BLANKENHORN: OF Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 32 of 41 games since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder is tied for the league with eight home runs, and ranks 9th in the Southern League with an .752 OPS with six doubles, a triple, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 19 walks over that span.
- COLÁS BROUGHT THE BOOM IN JULY: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás finished July, 4th in all of Double-A with six home runs, plus he has three doubles, 15 RBIs, and 11 runs scored. On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings. That marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being Orlando Martinez's performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanoona.
- TRASH PANDAS BASEBALL HITTING THE WEST COAST: The Trash Pandas are heading to the West Coast airwaves! FanDuel Sports Network West will televise and stream four Trash Pandas games during the second half of the 2025 season: July 31 vs. Birmingham, August 14 vs. Knoxville, August 28 vs. Columbus, and September 10 vs. Chattanooga. All broadcasts—produced in-house by the Trash Pandas—will feature veteran voices Josh Caray and Chris Harris. Fans in the Angels' local TV market can catch the action and experience Toyota Field like never before by tuning in on the FanDuel and or network.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: INF Jeremiah Jackson became the 44th Rocket City Trash Pandas alumnus to reach the Major Leagues, and eighth this season, when he made his MLB debut on August 1, 2025, with the Baltimore Orioles. Over his time in Madison, Jackson appeared in 169 games between 2022 and 2023, earning recognition for his power and versatility before being traded to the Mets and later landing with Baltimore
- RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, moved to Triple-A on August 2 after being the youngest player in the Southern League the past two seasons, He ranked 3rd in the league and 5th in all of Double-A with 34 stolen bases at the time of his promotion on August 2—19 of which came in a blistering month of May. His 34 steals ranked 3rd in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and Kyren Parris' franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in stolen bases (3rd, 34), OBP (5th, 380), batting average (12th, 277), and hits (T-9th, 91). Rada had a team-best 26 multi-hit games, including five three-hit games.
- GUZMAN BLAZED THROUGH JULY. The San Pedro de Macorís native, also moved to Triple-A on August 2, was named the Trash Pandas Player of the Month, and was one of the hottest hitters in Double-A last month, leading the Southern League—and was 5th in all of Double-A—with a 1.020 OPS, 47 total bases, and 13 extra-base hits. He ranked 2nd in the league with a .333 batting average and is also was tops in slugging (.580) and 2nd in on-base percentage (.440). His nine doubles rank 2nd in the league, and his 27 hits were T-5th. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second five-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and four RBIs. He ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in several categories, including doubles (2nd, 23), extra-base hits (T-1st, 35), RBIs (6th, 53), total bases (T-6th, 139), home runs (T-7th, 11), and slugging (7th, .415), and OPS (12th, .749). Guzman led the team with 16 multi-RBI games.
- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 OPS and seven extra-base hits, along with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best .444 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 OPS—also the highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following Tucker Flint (Aug. 12-18) and Christian Moore (Aug. 5-11) in 2023.
- BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana (24), 0F Kyren Paris (23), C Edgar Quero (23), RHP Ky Bush (22), and LHP Reid Detmers (21).
- **KEEPIN' IT QUALITY:** Starter **Joel Hurtado**, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks third in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks fifth in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: On July 3, INF Chad Stevens made his MLB debut for the Angels, becoming the seventh this season, and 43rd all-time Trash Panda to make their MLB debut. In 17 games for Rocket City in 2024, he hit. 316 with two homers, 10 RBIs, and two stolen bases over 17 games. He joins former Pandas, Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 11), who all debuted this year.
- THE STREAK IS OVER!!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the "Thiyie Association"
- PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 11 prospects and eight of the top 20 in MLB Pipeline's newest prospect rankings released on July 22; included in the top 11 are RHP George Klassen (3), OF Nelson Rada (6), LHP Sam Aldegheri (8), and INF Denzer Guzman (11). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP Samy Natera Jr. (16), RHP Walbert Ureña (17), RHP Joel Hurtado (19), and RHP Camden Minacci (20).
- **THE YOUNG GUNS:** The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF **Nelson Rada** is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.9 years old (8/24/05), the only player in the league born in 2005. INF **Denzer Guzman** is the eighth-youngest at 21 years old (2/8/04), and RHP **Walbert Urena** is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04, 21 years old (1/25/04).
- **DELAYING THE LAUNCH:** From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.
- MAY WAS A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA: Over 26 games in May, Sam Brown finished 4th in the league in batting at .301 (28-for-93), with eight extra-base hits, and 14 RBIs, and Nelson Rada finished 2nd in batting at .325 (27-for-83), and 2nd in OBP (.467). Rada led all of Double-A and was 3rd in MiLB with 19 stolen bases.

In that outing, Aldegheri delivered 2.1 innings, allowing two unearned runs in relief, allowing just one hit and one walk while striking out two. He was optioned back to the minors shortly after ... Recalled again on 7/8, and allowed five runs on five hits, walking four, striking out in 2.0 innings vs. Texas.

Great Month of July: Over four starts in July, finished 3-0 with a league best 0.78 ERA (4 ER/23.0 IP), 10 walks, 19 strikeouts. His three wins were tied for the league lead as well.

2024 in Review: Sam Aldegheri went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA and 10 strikeouts over three starts for the Angels after making his Major League debut on Aug. 30 vs. Seattle. He earned his first MLB win in his second start, Sept. 6 at Texas, becoming the first Italian-born player to record a big league win since 1949 and the first pitcher born and raised in Italy to reach the Majors. He is the eighth Italian-born player in MLB history and the first for the Angels franchise.

Aldegheri was acquired from the Phillies on July 27 in the Carlos Estévez trade, after posting a 6-9 record and 3.59 ERA with 134 strikeouts in 19 starts between High-A Jersey Shore, Double-A Reading, and Rocket City. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, he led the South Atlantic League with 95 strikeouts and paced all High-A pitchers (min. 60 IP) with 12.57 K/9. He was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for June 10–16 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts against Wilmington.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS: Was rated as having the best pitch control in the Phillies system by Baseball America following the 2023 season ... Started a combined no-hitter for High-A Clearwater against the Bradenton Marauders on April 8, 2023.

PERSONAL: Began professional career pitching for Parmaclima Baseball Club in the Italian Serie A1 ... Pitched alongside his older brother Mattia Aldegheri for Parmaclima from 2019-2020 ...
