LAST OUTING: Patrick went just 3.0 innings against Gwinnett which is tied for his shortest start of the season. He allowed four earned runs but the offense bailed him out and got a no-decision.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Patrick's fourth start against Gwinnett. In addition to the series opener, he took a no-decision in his first start (5.2 IP, 4 H, 2 ER) in Nashville's 4-3 loss on June 15 before getting the win on August 1 (5.1 IP, 1 ER, 6 K).

- Held Omaha to a couple of hits and a run over six innings for first quality start of season on April 19
