TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves start a 12-game homestand with a six-game series against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos at Trustmark Park. This is the fourth of five series between the two clubs (12 at Trustmark Park, 18 at Blue Wahoos Stadium). The M-Braves have two 12-game homestands this season, with another from August 29-September 10.

HOW THE GRINCH STOLE CHRISTMAS...IN JULY: The M-Braves salvaged the series finale but lost five of six to Tennessee, wrapping up a lowly 2-7 road trip. The M-Braves struggled in tight games against the Smokies, dropping a three-run, a two-run, and two one-run games in the series.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BLUE WAHOOS: The M-Braves won four of six on the road against Pensacola. The club blasted 17 home runs. The M-Braves had their first ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell), with Bunnell hitting the slam off MLB rehaber RHP Johnny Cueto.

A DIFFICULT GOODBYE: On Monday, Atlanta announced a trade with the Colorado Rockies for RHP Pierce Johnson that sent two of Atlanta's top prospects in Double-A, RHP Victor Vodnik (No. 10) and RHP Tanner Gordon (No. 26), to the Rockies organization.

Vodnik is 3-1 with a 3.10 ERA and four saves in 40 2/3 innings over 30 relief appearances. In 11 starts for the M-Braves, Gordon is 4-5 with a 4.61 ERA in 56 2/3 innings. In the first Triple-A action of his career, Gordon made six appearances and five starts for Gwinnett. The right-hander went 1-4 with an 8.28 ERA in 29.1 innings for Gwinnett.

TOP PITCHING STAFF: The M-Braves lead the Southern League, and rank 5th in Double-A, with a 4.01 ERA. The pitching staff has given up just 69 home runs, the fewest in Double-A. The M-Braves bullpen is 3rd in Double-A with a 3.50 ERA.

GRAND SALAMI TIME: The M-Braves have a club record six grand slams, including the first-ever multi-grand slam game on June 16 at Pensacola (Cade Bunnell, Luke Waddell). Waddell hit grand slams on June 16 at Pensacola and July 1 at Biloxi.

RETURN OF THE PEARL CITY BOMBERS: The M-Braves rank 3rd in the league and 8th in Double-A with 105 homers in 88 games - 77 on the road, while their opponents have just 69 total home runs. 16 Mississippi players have at least one homer, with Landon Stephens leading the way with 18, which is T-1st in the Southern League.

M-Braves opponents have just 15 home runs at Trustmark Park this season.

ANOTHER WINNING MONTH: After an 8-13 April, the M-Braves posted a 13-12 record in May and June. Over the month of June, the M-Braves ranked 2nd in the league with a .250 batting average, 37 home runs, and a 4.17 ERA.

WELCOME BACK MILLY: OF Cody Milligan returned from the IL on Friday after being shut down on April 25 after suffering a wrist injury. The Binger, OK native came back on a tear, racking up six hits and two doubles in three games against Chattanooga from July 14-16.

WADDYDY: Luke Waddell is second in the league with a .302 batting average, and ranks among the league leaders in OBP (.410, 3rd), and OPS (.865, 9th). Over his last 38 games since June 4, Luke Waddell is batting .324 with a league-most 48 hits, 27 runs, plus 30 RBI, six homers, two grand slams, 14 extra-base hits, 11 stolen bases, and .914 OPS.

RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Luginbaur hit his 101st minor league home run on Wednesday at Tennessee, which was his 60th in three seasons for the M-Braves. Luginbaur returned Wednesday from his second IL stint. He is currently on a 14-game hitting streak since the start of June, batting .465 with 5 2B, 4 HR, 11 RBI, 8 BB, .558 OBP, and 1.418 OPS. It's the club's longest hitting streak this season and the longest current streak in the league.

On May 23, Luginbaur cranked a 117-mile-per-hour home run, ranking 5th among MLB players for hardest-hit balls.

The M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader slugged his 50th career M-Braves home run on April 30 at Biloxi. Luginbaur has a club record, and Double-A franchise record 60 home runs over parts of three seasons. Luginbaur also has a club-record 173 RBI. He hit 18 homers in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022.

DE AVILA DELIVERS: Luis De Avila has delivered 11 hitless innings in his last two starts, earning SL Pitcher of the Week. The lefty delivered five solid starts in June, going 3-0 with a 1.61 ERA in 28.0 innings. After a team-most 16 starts, De Avila ranks among the league leaders in ERA (3.28, 3rd), opponent average (.222, 4th) and WHIP (1.32, 7th).

EVEN STEPHENS: Landon Stephens leads the Southern League, is T-2nd in Double-A, and T-4th in MiLB with 12 home runs since June 1. He homered in three straight games from June 16-18 and has homered in two-straight, on four different occasions.

Stephens leads the Southern League with 21 extra-base hits since June 1, and overall this season is T-1st in home runs with 18. He ranks among the league leaders in OPS (.856, 10th), slugging (.502, 7th), extra-base hits (31, 9th), and RBI (51, 8th).

DEAN RUNNIN' WILD: Justin Dean set a club record with four steals on July 1 at Biloxi. Dean had seven steals over two games, June 30-July 2, finished the series with eight stolen bases, and has a team-leading 22 on the year, which ranks 7th in the Southern League, despite him playing 27 games in Triple-A.
