The Fightin Phils continue a six-game series tonight at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. It is the 20th-of-21 matchups between the teams this season and eighth-of-nine in Portland. Portland leads the season-series 13-6 over Reading, alreading clinching a victory in the season series.

Looking Back

The Fightin Phils fell 6-2 in the first game of the weekend three-game series with Portland on Friday night. The Sea Dogs put three runs up in the bottom of the first inning thanks to home runs from Marcelo Mayer and Blaze Jordan. Reading got one back in the third when Erick Brito doubled and scored on a Marus Lee Sang sacrifice fly. Portland then jumped its lead to 5-1 in the third after back-to-back walks issued by Noah Skirrow came around to score. Justin Crawford walked in the fifth inning and mnoved to second on a passed ball, then swiped third. Crawford would then score on a RBI groundout from Caleb Ricketts, making it 5-2 at the time, with Portland still on top. The Sea Dogs then tacked on their final insurance tally in bottom of the seventh when Mayer scored.

Crawford's Dazzling Debut

Phillies No. 3 Prospect Justin Crawford showcased all of his tools in a stellar debut on Friday night. He had three hits, which included two doubles into the gaps and an infield single, where he showcased his elite speed. He additionally manufactured pretty much all by himself. After walking, he moved to second on a passed ball and then stole third, and ultimately came around to score on a ground out. Additionally, Crawford showcased elite defense with two diving catches and multiple other impressive catches in center field.

Bombs Away

Since June 1, the Fightin Phils lead the Eastern League in home runs hit at 51. That recent surge has propelled the Fightin Phils to second in the Eastern League in home runs with 93. They trail Somerset by three and are ahead of third-place Erie by 12. That stretch featured a team-best home runs in 13-straight games from June 13-28, which tied a mark set by the 2016 Fightin Phils. With no homers last night, Reading snapped a 10-game home run streak, from July 3-14. It was the R-Phils' second-longest home run streak of the season.

Strong Weeks Againt the Ducks

Otto Kemp finished last week's series at Akron on a high note with a home run, as he had two long balls on the week. Over five games last week, Carson Taylor slashed .375/.474/.625, with a 1.099 OPS. He's added three runs, a double, home run and three RBI. He's also walked three times and not struck out once.

The Phillies announced a lot of roster moves to the Reading roster prior to this weekend's series in Portland. Justin Crawford, Leandro Pineda, Erick Brito, Eiberson Castellano and Andrew Walling were all called up from High-A Jersey Shore. Additioanlly, Gabriel Rincones Jr. was activated off the 60-day IL and will make his return to the Reading lineup on Saturday night.

Strong Start for the New Guys

Justin Crawford, Erick Brito and Leandro Pineda all made their Reading debuts on Friday night at Portland, and all recorded at least one hit. The trio combined to go six-for-12, with three doubles and two runs scored.

This Day in Baseballtown History

July 20, 2012: At Trenton, Cody Asche's 2-run homer in the 1st inning snaps the R-Phils' streak of 29 consecutive scoreless innings and propels Reading to an 8-3 victory over the Thunder. Reading had endured three straight shutout defeats at Portland.

Portland enters tonight after finishing in third place in the Eastern League's Northeast Division for the first half with a 36-33 record. They are second in the Northeast Division with an 11-6 record in the second half of the season. Portland most recently took three-of-six on the road at Hartford. Following this week, Portland heads to Somerset. Portland's roster features nine players ranked amongst the Boston Red Sox top-30 prospects: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25), Angel Bastardo (26) and Kristian Campbell (30).

Portland Pitcher

Righty Jacob Webb gets the start tonight for the Sea Dogs. This is Webb's 25th appearance, and just sixth start. Overall in 2024, Webb is 6-1, with a 3.58 ERA. He's pitched 50.1 innings, allowed 48 hits, walked 15 and struck out 47 hitters. Webb last pitched July 11 at Hartford in a start, going three innings and allowing one-unearned run on one hit. He struck out two and walked one. This is Webb's fifth-straight start and sixth in his last seven appearances, after coming out of the bullpen for his first 18 appearances of the season. Webb spent all of last season with Portland, going 8-3, with a 5.03 ERA over 41 appearances, all out of the bullpen. This is his first time starting this season, with his first-career start coming June 15 at Reading. He was drafted in 14th round in 2021 out of Miami (OH)
