Series: Game 3 of 3 (season series tied 1-1 of 27)

Last Game Recap...Brendan Jones hit a 3-run double in the bottom of the ninth inning off Ethan Chenault to give Hudson Valley a come-from-behind 8-7 win over Jersey Shore on Saturday night at Heritage Financial Park...The BlueClaws had taken the lead in the eighth on an RBI single from Luke Davis...Luke Russo gave up one run in four innings for Jersey Shore while Bryan Rincon had three hits.

Here's Carson (DeMartini)...Carson DeMartini has already drawn five walks in the first two games of the season and added three stolen bases without being caught...He is the lone member of the Phillies 2024 draft class to open the season with the BlueClaws (4th round pick, Virginia Tech)...DeMartini hit the game winning home run in the Spring Breakout game against the Pirates on March 14th...He hit .315 in 24 games with Clearwater last year, adding two home runs...DeMartini...He had 46 home runs at Virginia Tech including 24 as a junior last year...This is the third straight year only one member of the previous year's draft class opened the season with the BlueClaws (2024 – 3B Zach Arnold, 11th round, 2023; 2023 – OF Troy Schreffler, 15th round, 2022).

Starting Strong...Bryan Rincon had three hits and two stolen bases on Saturday...It was his first 3-hit game as a BlueClaw since 8/26/23 at Wilmington...Rincon is the #14 prospect in the system per MLB Pipeline...The 21 year old hit .202 in 33 games with the BlueClaws last year.

Run, Run BlueClaws...The BlueClaws already have 10 stolen bases in the first two games of the season, including three by Carson DeMartini, and two each by Eduardo Lopez, Bryan Rincon, and Devin Saltiban...Only Ranco Cucamonga (Low-A, Dodgers) has more (11) among A, A+, and AA teams.

BlueClaws On Opening Day...The BlueClaws are now 10-13 all-time in season openers (since 2001) and 3-2 as the Jersey Shore BlueClaws (since 2001)...They have won back to back openers, winning last year when Emaarion Boyd scored on a wild pitch to walk-off Aberdeen 3-2...The BlueClaws are 7-16 all time in home openers, 2-2 as the Jersey Shore BlueClaws...The home opener is Tuesday against Aberdeen.

Lopez Cooks in Opener...Eduardo Lopez, playing in his first game in the Phillies organization, had two hits and an RBI on Friday night...Lopez, a 22 year old from the Dominican Republic, was acquired from the Red Sox in the Minor League Rule-5 Draft in December...He played in Greenville the last two years, winning the league title in 2023.

Campbell Debuts With Claws...OF Dylan Campbell had an RBI double in the opener in his Phillies organization debut...Acquired from the Dodgers in January, he spent last year with Great Lakes in the Midwest League (High-A) and hit .251 in 115 games with 10 home runs, 53 RBIs and 42 stolen bases in 49 attempts (six of his 10 home runs were hit in August)...Campbell was a 4th round pick of the Dodgers in 2023 from the University of Texas.

Going For Five...The BlueClaws enter 2025 with four straight winning halves, both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the 2011 season.

From Hawaii, With Pop...Devin Saltiban, the Phillies 3rd round pick in 2023 and #9 prospect per MLB Pipeline, hit 18 home runs last year (17 with Clearwater and one with the FCL Phillies), the most by any BlueClaws player...He added 22 stolen bases while only being caught twice...An outfielder in high school, he played exclusively second base last year...He played his high school baseball at Hilo High School in Hawaii and is one of eight players from Hilo HS to play Minor League Baseball (one, LHP Onan Masaoka, played in the big leagues – 1999-2000 with the Dodgers).

New to the Phillies...The BlueClaws roster includes four players that were acquired by the Phillies in the off-season: RHP Augusto Calderon (Minor League Rule-5 from the Cardinals), RHP Aaron Combs (from the White Sox for LHP Tyler Gilbert), OF Dylan Campbell (from the Dodgers for international bonus pool money), and OF Eduardo Lopez (Minor League Rule-5 from the Red Sox)...C Luis Caicuto was a Minor League Rule-5 pick from the Diamondbacks in December of 2023...The Phillies were the only team to use six picks in the 2024 Minor League Rule-5 Draft.

Super-Utility...Bryson Ware has played 1B, 2B, 3B, SS, LF, and RF with the BlueClaws, and played those six positions and CF with Clearwater before joining the BlueClaws last August...In August last season, he played 1B, 2B, 3B, and SS in four straight games, becoming only the third High-A BlueClaw (Nick Ward in 2023, McCarthy Tatum in 2022) to play those four in consecutive games.

Power Index...Jordan Dissin returns after leading the BlueClaws with nine home runs last year...Devin Saltiban led all current BlueClaws with 18 home runs in 2024 (17 with Clearwater)...Jordan Viars had 14 last year, 12 with Clearwater and two (both in the final series of the season) with Jersey Shore...Dylan Campbell hit 10 with Great Lakes in the Dodgers system.

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws had three walk-off wins in 2024 – most recently July 23rd vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen...It was the first BlueClaws walk-off home run since Ben Pelletier hit one on August 15, 2019 against Delmarva.

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold).

Just Grand...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 – one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...125 players have now gone *From the Shore, to the Show* including two last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerker (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Just Win Baby...The BlueClaws are the only team in the South Atlantic League and High-A to win more than 70 games in both 2023 (73-58) and 2024 (74-58).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken,

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching with Lehigh Valley...Buchter went to Highland Regional High Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach BlueClaws as the Bench Coach...2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.

Starting Strong – The BlueClaws' Starting Pitcher Notebook

Strikeout Marks - Jean Cabrera struck out 14 Wilmington Blue Rocks on 6/12/24, the second-most in a game by a BlueClaws pitcher, behind Jose Taveras' 15 strikeout game on 6/25/16 at Greenville.

10-Strikeout Games – Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, they have had 21 games in which a pitcher struck out at least 10 hitters. The following players did so multiple times: Ben Brown (4, 2022), Sam Aldegheri (3, 2024), Jean Cabrera (3, 2024), Griff McGarry (3, 2022), Eiberson Castellano (2, 2024).

- 10 Strikeout Games in 2025:

Going Deep – Since the BlueClaws became a High-A affiliate in 2021, they have had 20 starts in which their starting pitcher threw at least seven innings. The following players did so multiple times: Matt Osterberg (3, 2023), Jean Cabrera (2, 2022), Ben Brown (2, 2022), Andrew Painter (2, 2022).

- Cabrera (4/30 and 5/7/24) and Painter (8/6 and 8/13/22) are the only ones to do it in back to back starts.

100+ Pitches: It's a 'Claws Thing – In 2024, the BlueClaws had nine games in which their starter threw at least 100 pitches, something that happened just 50 times in all of High-A last year. Sam Aldegheri and Jean Cabrera each did it three times while Mitch Neunborn, Casey Steward, and Braeden Fausnaught each did it once. Aldegheri (6/7 and 6/13) and Cabrera (6/12 and 6/19) each did it in back to back starts (Mick Abel in 2022 was the last BlueClaw to throw 100+ pitches in back to back starts).
