TODAY'S GAME: The Fayetteville Woodpeckers (Low-A Houston Astros) continue a six-game road series against the Myrtle Beach Pelicans (Single-A Chicago Cubs) today at Pelicans Ballpark. This is the fifth of six games in the overall season series as well between the two clubs. The series is currently even 2-2 after a 2-0 loss for the Woodpeckers on Friday night. Tonight, the Woodpeckers will start RHP Carlos Calderon and Myrtle Beach will counter with RHP Porter Hodge.

THE OPPONENT: The Myrtle Beach Pelicans were founded in 1999 and have been a member of the Carolina league since their founding. They have held affiliations under three different major league team including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), the Texas Rangers (2011-2014) and the Chicago Cubs (2015 - Pres). The Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in their history (1999, 2000, 2015, 2016). This season, the Pelicans won the Carolina League South Division with a 47-19 overall record, the best in all of MiLB over the stretch. During the 2021 season, the Woodpeckers went 4-2 against Myrtle Beach in one six-game series at Segra Stadium. The Woodpeckers lead the all-time series over Myrtle Beach 18-10.

CERNY NAMED ASTROS POTM: The Houston Astros recently announced that Woodpeckers OF Logan Cerny has been named the organizational Minor League Player of the Month for June. During June, the 22-year-old Cerny batted .337 (29-for-86) with seven doubles, 5 HR's, 27 RBI and a 1.011 OPS (.418 OBP/.593 SLG) in 23 games. This is the second award that Cerny has received this season, also being named the Carolina League Player of the Week back on June 13th.

THE PROSPECTS: The Woodpeckers are currently carrying three of the Astros Top-30 Prospects on their active roster. RHP Alex Santos is the highest of the trio, sitting at #9. Outfielder Tyler Whitaker sits right behind him at #10 after dropping down a couple of spots. After a red-hot start to the month of June, outfielder Logan Cerny has surged up the rankings, coming in at #24 in the most recent rankings from MLB.com. Fayetteville has also graduated nine players to higher levels in the Astros organization, two position players and seven pitchers.

A HALLMARK MOMENT: In the seventh inning of Wednesday night's game, Jaxon Hallmark hit a solo home run over the left field wall that gave the Woodpeckers a 3-1 lead. The blast was the first in Hallmark's professional career since signing with the Astros as an undrafted free agent in 2021 out of the University of Nebraska where he was a first-team All-Big Ten player during the 2021 season. Hallmark is the first player this season to hit his first professional home run with the Woodpeckers. He also homered on Thursday night, making it consecutive games with a homer after going without one over his first 47 games played.

RUNNING WILD: The new pitch clock and pick-off rules have led to a huge uptick in stolen bases across the league this season and multiple Woodpeckers are on-pace to steal close to 40 bases this year. With a pair of steals on Wednesday night against the Down East Wood Ducks, Logan Cerny (28) passed Ronaldo Urdaneta (2021) for the most steals in Woodpeckers franchise history since 2018. Joey Loperfido (23) and Cody Orr (22) are also on pace to shatter the current record. Myles Straw remains the all-time franchise record holder, swiping 36 bases for the Buies Creek Astros in 2017.

SOUTHPAWS BEWARE: Left-handed pitchers have struggled this season facing the Woodpeckers' offense. Fayetteville leads the league in batting average vs. LHP (.261) and also has the highest slugging percentage (.430) and OPS (.769) against lefties. In addition, the Woodpeckers have hit a league-high 17 homers off of lefties in 2022. Joey Loperfido has led the way for the Woodpeckers with a .347 average versus southpaws, the third-highest in the Carolina League. Only Salem's Marcelo Mayer (.385), the #10 prospect in Major League Baseball, and Kannapolis's Wilfred Veras (.349) have higher averages versus left-handers.

START ME UP: One of the strong points in this weeks series at Myrtle Beach has been the starting pitching. Over the first four games of the series, starting pitchers have combined to throw 18.0 innings while allowing just 6 ER along with a combined total of 8 walks and 16 strikeouts

Recap: Both starting pitchers dominated the first five innings of the game. Edinson Batista worked five scoreless before allowing a pair of runs with two outs in the sixth inning on an RBI single to Kevin Alcantara and an RBI double to Eziquel Pagan. The Woodpeckers offense couldn't solve Tyler Santana who worked 5.1 scoreless innings. Felix Scalzo Jr. went 2.2 scoreless and Angel Hernandez closed down the 2-0 game in the ninth for the save. The Woodpeckers left a total of six runners on base, five of which were in scoring position.

15 Joe Thon

Manager

Thon makes his return to Fayetteville and begins his first season as Woodpeckers manager after serving as a development coach in 2021. As the development coach, Thon helped coach Woodpeckers hitters and fielders, as well as assist with lineup planning and creating reports on individual athletes on the team.

Prior to joining the Astros as a full-time coach, Thon served as a summer intern with the organization during the 2019 summer. He helped analyze and balance revenue summaries, verified accounts for reconciling payments and processed and organized invoices for the Astros and Astros Foundation.

Following his internship, Thon broke into the coaching ranks by joining the University of Houston Baseball program in August 2019 as a student assistant coach before becoming the volunteer assistant prior to the 2020 season. After one season with UofH, Thon returned to the Astros in a full-time coaching role.

The former Minor League infielder enjoyed a seven-year minor league playing career. Thon was drafted in the 5th round (pick 156) by the Toronto Blue Jays in 2010 out of Academia Perpetuo Socorro in San Juan, Puerto Rico. He played in the Blue Jays organization until 2016 when he signed to join the St. Louis Cardinals. Thon played in the Cardinals farm system through 2017, reaching as high as Double-A with the Springfield Cardinals. His playing career concluded in 2017 in the Independent Atlanta League with the Sugar Land Skeeters, now the Triple-A Affiliate of the Astros. In total, Thon appeared in over 500 games across his MiLB career, posting a .243/.356/.318 slash line with 79 doubles, 17 triples, 27 home-runs and 178 RBI. Thon also played for Liga de Beisbol Profesional Roberto Clemente in Puerto Rico from 2010 through December 2016.

Thon comes from a deep baseball background. He is the son of former Astros shortstop Dickie Thon, a 1983 All-Star with Houston who enjoyed a 15-year MLB career with the California Angels, Astros, Padres, Phillies, Rangers and Brewers. Joe and his fiancé Erika spend their offseason living in Houston with their dogs.

23 Jose Puentes

Hitting Coach

Joining the Woodpeckers for his first season with the franchise and third season in the Astros organization is hitting coach Jose Puentes.

Puentes started his career with the Astros as a hitting coach in the Dominican Summer League and most recently served as hitting coach with the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.

He has coached at the high school level at MacArthur High School, Johnson High School, Steele High School and Wagner High School. From 2006-2007, he was the head baseball coach at St. Anthony Catholic High School. Puentes has owned and operated two hitting academies, Gap to Gap Academy and Cardinals Select Baseball Academy.

He earned his bachelor's degree in Spanish and Master's degree in teaching from University of Incarnate Word along with a Master's degree in education from the University of Texas at San Antonio.

16 John Kovalik

Pitching Coach

John Kovalik takes over as the third pitching coach in Woodpeckers history, bringing three years of coaching experience to the Woodpeckers staff. The 30-year-old enters his fourth season in the Astros organization after serving as the pitching coach for the Tri-City Valley Cats in 2019, along with the pitching coach for the Florida Complex League Astros in 2021.
