- 3-for-Springfield struck starter Anthony Veneziano for five runs across the first two innings, through Veneziano struck out two across 1.2 innings of work. The closest Northwest Arkansas got to coming back came in the fourth, as Massey singled and was tripled home by Seuly Matias, who then scored on a Nate Eaton sac fly.
- The Cardinals responded with a run in the fourth and four in the sixth, but the Naturals responded with three more in the seventh inning. Maikel Garcia doubled in Jake Means, then John Rave scored on a Nick Loftin sac fly. Garcia came around for the final run of the night for Northwest Arkansas, on Massey's third hit of the game.
- After Veneziano could not pitch out of the second, Zack Phillips followed with 3.1 innings of relief, only allowing one run while striking out four. Patrick Smith and Jonah Dipoto combined for an inning before **Walter Pennington** pitched two scoreless innings to finish the night, facing five batters but recording six outs on 17 pitches.

This Day in Naturals History

The Naturals are 6-3 all-time when playing on May 4 On May 4, 2009, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals played a doubleheader with the Arkansas Travelers at Arvest Ballpark, with a 5-4 loss in Game 1 and 5-4 win in 13 innings in Game 2. A combined 29 hits for the Naturals between the two games still stands as the most hits across two games of a doubleheader in club history. The Naturals outhit the Travelers 13-12 in Game 1, including a three-hit night from Jordan Parraz. In Game 2, the Naturals outhit the Travs 16-6, stranding 15 runners on. The second game remained tied at 5-5 after the 5th inning until the 13th, when Corey Smith singled in Jose Duarte to walk-off for the win in a game that took 4 hours and ended at 12:03 am.

THE CHAMPS ARE HERE!

Of the 28-man roster the Naturals rolled out for the Double-A Central Championship Series in 2021, six players are on the Naturals' 2022 active roster, with a total of 9 returning players with the Naturals this season.

- Pitchers Holden Capps, Yefri Del Rosario, Drew Parrish, Stephen Woods Jr. and Ángel Zerpa were all a part of the championship celebration last year, as was outfielder Seuly Matias.
- Additionally, catcher/infielder Gavin Stupienski and pitcher Alec Marsh both played for the Naturals in 2021, as did catcher **Tyler Cropley**, who is currently on the Injured List.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in Advanced Rookie Burlington (2019) and High-A Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 19 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 11 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Michael Massey, Jake Means, Drew Parrish, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave, 💌 Patrick Smith and Ángel Zerpa.

TOOLSY TEAM

Six active Naturals players were listed in Baseball America's 2022 Best Tools Survey of the Kansas City Royals' organization.

- CF Nick Loftin is rated as having the "Best Strike-Zone Discipline" in the system.
- C Sebastian Rivero is rated as being the <u>"Best Defensive Catcher"</u> in the . system.
- SS Maikel Garcia is rated as having the "Best Infield Arm" in the system.
- RF Seuly Matias is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm" in the system.
- LHP Asa Lacy is rated as having the <u>"Best Slider"</u> in the system. .
- LHP **Ángel Zerpa** is rated as having the <u>"Best Control"</u> in the system.

MJ MELENDEZ IS A BIG LEGUER!

In last night's 7-1 win for the Kansas City Royals, 2021 Natural MJ Melendez hit seventh and served as the Royals' DH, becoming the 113th player to debut in the Majors after spending time in Northwest Arkansas, the fourth in the 2022 MLB Season.

- Melendez went 1-for-3 with a walk, collecting his first MLB hit in the bottom of the sixth inning, an opposite field single.
- In the bottom of the second inning, third baseman Bobby Witt Jr. finally drilled his first big league homer, a solo shot to left field, moments before Melendez took his first at-bat.
- Bobby Witt Jr. was Naturals alum 110 to reach the Majors, debuting on April 7 ... Collin Snider was the 111th on April 9 ... Yunior Marté became the 112th Naturals alum to reach the Majors, debuting with the San Fransisco Giants on April 12.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring five runs or less, the Naturals are just 1-11, while 9-1 when scoring six runs or more.
- The Naturals are 3-10 when recording nine hits or less, but 7-2 when recording 10 hits or more.
- The Naturals are 10-2 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 0-10 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 8-4, whereas 2-8 when the opponent scores first.

YO, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

NOTES

Through 22 games, the Naturals have stolen 34 bases in 39 attempts (average 1.55 steals/game) and *pulled off a double steal 6 times*.

- 32 steals ranks second in the Texas League and tied for 21st in the Minors. while a 87.18% success rate on steals ranks fourth among MiLB teams with at least 30 successful steals.
- Maikel Garcia's 9 steals (in 11 attempts) ranks tied for fifth in the Texas League and tied for ninth in all of Double-A.

NATE IS GREAT

Utility man Nate Eaton made a strong case last week to be the next Texas League player of the week and recently putting together a ridiculous eightgame stretch dating back to two weeks ago in Frisco.

- Eaton entered last night's game on a eight-game hitting streak, the longest on the team this season though the streak was snapped last night with an 0-for-4 day at the plate ... between April 23 and May 1, Eaton hit 15-for-31 (.484 average) with two homers, six runs batted in, four steals and a 1.285 OPS.
- Last week, Eaton hit .417 against Amarillo, 20-for-24 at the plate with four runs batted in, three steals and a 1.087 OPS.
- With 12 starts (105.0 innings) at third base, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in left field, 3 starts (27.0 innings) in right field and one start at shortstop (9.0 innings), the VMI product is the only Naturals player who has spent time at more than three positions in the field.

G'DAY ROBBIE!

Australian infielder **Robbie Glendinning** was a February free agent signing by the Kansas City Royals and has proven himself to be one of the best players on the 2022 Naturals.

- Entering Saturday, the native of Perth, Western Australia had reached base in all 15 games he'd played started the season, but struck out while pinchhitting in the ninth inning to snap that streak ... his 15-game on-base streak is the longest on the team this year and is tied for fifth-longest in the Texas League.
- 38 12 14 34 2 45 55 19 Among 10 qualified Naturals hitters, Glendinning is the Naturals' team leader in on-base percentage (.438), slugging percentage (.586) and OPS (1.024), while ranking second on the team with 15 runs batted in, second in walks (14), tied third in runs scored (15) and tied third in batting average (.293).
- Robbie's .438 OBP ranks ninth in the Texas League, while his 1.024 OPS ranks eight in the league ... 14 walks is tied for eighth as well.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop Maikel Garcia drew 10 walks through the season's first five games, and now has 19 on the season, which is tied for second in the Texas League and tied for fourth in Double-A.

- In 101 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 43 times, for a .426 on-base percentage (24 hits + 19 walks) ... he has reached at least once in 19 of the 21 games he's appeared in this season.
- Garcia ranks among the Texas League leaders, ranking tied second in walks (19) and tied for fifth in steals (9).
- Despite his on-base prowess, Garcia endured a five-game hitless streak from April 19 to 27, where he went 0-for-23 with five four walks, a span in which his batting average has dropped over 100 points, entering 4/1 batting .406, but was at .241 after April 26.
- Garcia drew at least one walk in each of the first five games he played while walking twice or more on four occasions. He collected his first three walk game on 4/13 in the Naturals' 8-5 win over Wichita.


