How the Locos' Name was Chosen: Ever since the Lugnuts first arrived in Lansing in 1996, Lansing fans have chanted "Let's Go Nuts!" A Spanish translation: ¡Vamos Locos! The Locos' logo depicts a potoo bird, the most loco animal the team brass could find.

Last Game: Chiefs 3, Lugnuts 2 (10). Nathan Church singled home Victor Scott II to break a tenth-inning tie, and Roy Garcia set down the top three batters in the Lugnuts lineup to preserve a series-opening win. Euribiel Ángeles delivered both Lugnuts runs with a third-inning RBI groundout and an eighth-inning home run.

Lug•Notes

Thievery: The Peoria Chiefs have the league's top base stealer, Victor Scott II, who swiped his 45th bag yesterday. But while Peoria stole two bases in three attempts, giving them 86 steals this year, the Lugnuts stole four bases in five attempts, including two by the just-arrived **Drew Swift**.

Pitcher's Best Friend: The Lugnuts have turned nine double plays in their last three games, two more yesterday, and lead the Midwest League with 53 for the year.

Moving Up by Traveling South: Yesterday, Lugnuts pitcher Jack Perkins and infielder Sahid Valenzuela were promoted to Double-A Midland (Texas). The A's 2022 fifth-round selection from Indiana, the 23-year-old Perkins finished his time in Lansing with seven shutout innings on Saturday night at South Bend, his third consecutive quality start. He leads the Midwest League with a 0.97 WHIP and ranks second with a 2.52 ERA and third with a .182 batting average allowed. This is his first trip to Double-A. The 25-year-old Valenzuela previously spent 25 games in Midland in 2022. A 13th-rounder in 2019 from Cal State Fullerton, he batted .262 with three doubles in 30 games with the Lugnuts.

Welcome, and Welcome Back: Perkins' and Valenzuela's spots on the roster have been filled by pitcher Jose Dicochea, promoted from Single-A Stockton, and infielder Drew Swift, activated from the Injured List. Dicochea is one of the top rising pitching prospects in the Athletics' organization. Drafted from Sahuarita High School (Sahuarita, Ariz.) in the eighth round in 2019, the 22-year-old had been limited to 16 appearances in the last two years, but emerged this year with 47 strikeouts in 39 1/3 innings for the Ports, posting a 3.20 ERA in nine games, seven starts. Hea is slated to start for the Lugnuts on Thursday at 7:05 p.m. against the Chiefs. Swift, 24, opened 2023 on the Lugnuts' Injured List. Drafted in eighth round in 2021 from Arizona State, Swift spent 32 games in Lansing in 2021 before returning for an injury-shortened 59-game run in 2022, distinguishing himself with a .352 OBP and 21 steals in 23 attempts. He will start tonight in the home opener of a six-game series against Peoria, batting sixth and playing second base.

Among the MWL Leaders: Closer Tyler Baum is tied for third with six saves; outfielder Jonny Butler is second in the Midwest League with five triples; catcher Daniel Susac is fifth with 55 hits; and outfielder Junior Pérez is eighth with 15 steals.

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C **Tyler Soderstrom**.

Today in Lugnuts History

2012: RF Chris Hawkins threw out two Fort Wayne TinCaps at home plate and 1B Kevin Patterson hit a go-ahead two-out three-run homer in the top of the 8th for a 5-4 Lugnuts win. (Patterson then homered twice more the next day at Great Lakes.)

2014: 30-year-old knuckleballer Frank Viola III tossed 6 2/3 scoreless innings, scattering eight hits and two walks and striking out one in a 3-0 win at Great Lakes.

2019: In the bottom of the eighth inning, the Lugnuts rallied for two runs on a DJ Neal RBI double and a Gabriel Moreno sacrifice fly to beat Bowling Green, 3-2. The Lugnuts' win, as it turned out, denied the third-place Hot Rods from making the playoffs in the first half. Bowling Green then clinched a second-half playoff berth, denying the Lugnuts from making the post-season. The winning pitcher was 19-year-old lefty Naswell Paulino, who pitched a scoreless eighth in his only appearance of the year with the Lugnuts.

The King: First name is pronounced "yo-elvis," with the emphasis on the middle syllable... one other Joelvis played professional baseball, Joelvis Gonzalez, a Twins prospect from Venezuela in 2006-07 who hit .270 in 79 games but never made it higher than rookie ball... making his fourth consecutive relief appearance.

Lugnuts Lineage: Del Rosario tossed 4 2/3 scoreless innings as the Opening Day starter, April 7 at Great Lakes... he joined such other Opening Day Lugnuts starters as: Blaine Mull (1996), Steve Hueston (1997), Justin Pederson (1998), Mike Wuertz (1999), Matt Bruback (2000), Wilton Chavez (2001), Angel Guzman (2002), Andrew Sisco (2003), Sean Marshall (2004), Casey Janssen (2005), Chi-Hung Cheng (2006), Zach Dials (2007), Trystan Magnuson (2008), Henderson Alvarez (2009), Ryan Shopshire (2010), Misaul Diaz (2011), Noah Syndergaard (2012), Javier Avendano (2013), Jairo Labourt (2014), Chase De Jong (2015), Jon Harris (2016), Justin Maese (2017), Yennsy Diaz (2018), Josh Winckowski (2019), Seth Shuman (2021) and Grant Holman (2022).

Path Through the Pros: After signing at age 16, Del Rosario debuted as a reliever in 2018 in the Dominican Summer League before converting to a starter in the DSL in 2019, tossing 5 2/3 innings at most... made United States debut in 2021 in Florida Complex League; twirled five hitless innings in second start, July 5, striking out seven Orioles and walking one... made full-season debut with Bradenton in 2022, posting three six-inning starts in a four-start span in June; allowed .248 avg. to right-handers compared to .299 to lefties; runners stole six bases in 10 attempts; outstanding in the first inning, limiting opposition to .191/.295/.353 splits; far better on the road (2.95 ERA in 55 IP) than at home (4.74 in 38 IP).

Joining the Athletics: Del Rosario was the first overall selection of the 2022 MiLB portion of the Rule 5 Draft... in the Major League portion, the A's had selected 2018 Lugnut Ryan Noda from the Dodgers with the second overall pick; Noda debuted in the Majors on his birthday on March 30th and has already launched his first MLB home run... Del Rosario was one of a staggering 11 Pittsburgh Pirates prospects to be selected in the Rule 5 MiLB portion after two Pirates prospects, Jose Hernandez and Blake Sabol, were taken consecutively (3rd and 4th) in the MLB portion.

A Taste of the Cactus League: Del Rosario appeared in one Spring Training game for the A's, pitching well initially before bowing out having allowed four runs on four hits and three walks in 2 2/3 innings, striking out four, hitting one and tossing a wild pitch.
