Today marks game #76 of the 2022 season, the 1st game of a six-game roadtrip, and the 1st game of a six-game series against the Dayton Dragons. These two teams play 24 games against one another the season, and played 18 times during the regular season in 2021, with the Dragons winning the season series 10-8. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 28th season in professional baseball, while Dayton is in their 22nd year of professional baseball affiliation with the nearby Cincinnati Reds.

UP NEXT: The 'Caps return home to host the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers on July 12-17 at LMCU Ballpark before embarking on the 2022 Midwest League All-Star Break and a three-game series at Dow Diamond against the Great Lakes Loons.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

LAST TIME OUT: Outfielder Bryant Packard blasted his first professional grand slam, and pitcher Keider Montero enjoyed a solid start as the West Michigan Whitecaps rolled to a 13-4 victory over the Fort Wayne TinCaps in front of 6,548 fans Sunday evening at LMCU Ballpark. The Whitecaps pounded out two home runs, accounting for seven RBIs, as all-but-one batter notched a base hit while finishing 6-for-14 with runners in scoring position. Meanwhile, Keider Montero matched his single-game high in strikeouts, punching out six batters through five innings in the victory. Fort Wayne scored first as Lucas Dunn plated Max Ferguson on an RBI single in the first inning, putting the TinCaps in front 1-0. The 'Caps responded with two runs in the bottom of the first, as Jake Holton and Austin Murr added RBI singles to forge in front 2-1. Packard followed with his grand slam in the second inning before Ferguson responded with a solo homer in the third, 6-2. The Whitecaps exploded for six runs in the third frame - highlighted by a three-run home run from Josh Crouch - taking a commanding 12-2 lead. Cruz added an insurance tally in the sixth inning, plating Carlos Mendoza on a sacrifice fly before Brandon Valenzuela lifted a sacrifice fly in the eighth, trimming the lead to 13-3. Kelvin Melean scored on a bases-loaded balk in the ninth inning, but 'Caps reliever Dario Gardea recorded the final out, securing the 'Caps 13-4 victory. Montero (4-4) secures his fourth win as Ryan Bergert (0-6) suffers his sixth loss, allowing nine runs on 11 hits through 2.1 innings pitched. Packard enjoyed a career-high five RBIs in the win as Holton extended his hitting streak to 10 games. In addition, Malgeri has reached base in eight out of his last ten at-bats. The Whitecaps improve to 37-38 with a first-place 6-3 second-half record as the TinCaps fall to 29-46 and a 2-7 second-half record.

MADDEN '22: Pitcher Ty Madden was named Midwest League Player of the Week on June 27 after tossing 10 scoreless innings while only giving up three hits and striking out nine batters. Madden ranks as the Tigers No. 5 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

HISTORY FOR HOLTON: Infielder Jake Holton collected seven RBI, including two homers -- one of which served as the game-winning home run as part of a June 14 8-7 win over the Peoria Chiefs at Dozer Park - a performance last replicated by 2012 infielder Aaron Westlake on June 3 at Great Lakes. Only one player in franchise history has collected more RBI in a single game - Jeramy Laster - who drove in eight runs in a game played on 8-8-08, at Alliant Energy Field at Clinton. The performance led to his being named the Midwest League Player of the Week on June 19.

2,000 SECURED: The West Michigan Whitecaps opened the 2022 regular season with a 5-1 victory over the Great Lakes Loons for their 2,000th win in club history at Dow Diamond on April 8. The Whitecaps finished the 2021 season one victory short of the franchise milestone, but wasted no time hitting the mark in 2022. West Michigan recorded their 1,000th win when they beat the Clinton LumberKings 5-0 in Comstock Park on April 14, 2007.

A Top-30 Prospect in the Detroit Tigers farm system, the 23-year-old makes his high-A debut after posting 57 strikeouts through 42.1 innings in low-A Lakeland with a 2.98 ERA. Hurter played three seasons with the Georgia Tech Yellowjackets, compiling a career 12-10 record with 197 punchouts through 187.1 innings. He was ranked as high as the No. 2 left-handed pitcher and the No. 16 overall prospect in the high school class of 2017 out of Georgia (Perfect Game).

LAST START: Hurter was unable to finish the five innings he needed for his first West Michigan win, going just 3.2 frames and allowing three runs on five hits as the Whitecaps topped the Fort Wayne TinCaps by a score of 14-4 on June 29 at LMCU Ballpark.

2021 (Senior): Went 5-4 with a 3.90 ERA through 15 starts in a standout senior season at Georgia Tech University. Had a walk-to-strikeout ratio of 19:83 through 85.1 innings on the mound.

2020 (Junior): Sat out the shortened campaign recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

MORE: Athletics runs in the Hurter family, with his father, Brian, playing baseball at Wake Forrest (1988-92) and his mother, Stacey (Brogg), playing basketball at Wake Forrest (1990-92). A two-sport athlete at Woodstock High School, Hurter was also a three-time letterwinner on the basketball team and is an avid fan of "The Office"
