The Fightin Phils remain home and welcome the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets, to FirstEnergy Stadium for a six-game series. Thursday night is the third-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and third-of-12 games at America's Classic Ballpark. The Rumble Ponies won the 2024 series 11-7 and Reading leads the 2025 series 2-0.

R-Phils.

The Fightin Phils won their season-best third-straight game, with a 7-4 victory over Binghamton on Wednesday night. Jean Cabrera started and went five innings, allowing one run on four hits, with seven strikeouts. It was Cabrera's best start of the season and it marked the first time a R-Phils' starting pitcher earned a win this season. Andrew Walling closed the door in the ninth with a four-out save, his second save of the season. Aidan Miller posted his best game of the season offensively, knocking three hits, including a double, scoring twice and reaching base four times. Robert Moore stayed hot with a double and two RBI and Keaton Anthony knocked his fifth double of the season. Elio Prado drove in a run in his third-straight game, with two hits and two RBI in the win.

Phillies No. 2 Prospect Aidan Miller turned in his best game of the season on Wednesday night. Miller had three hits, two runs, a double and reached base four times in the win. The three hits marked a season-high for Miller as well. So far this week, Miller is 4-8 (.500), with three runs, a double, home run and two RBI.

Robert Moore turned in one of his best games as a pro in Tuesday night's win againt Binghamton. He had three hits, three runs, two home runs and five RBI in the victory. The two home runs and five RBI matched career highs, that he set June 1 of last season at Hartford. His three runs scored also tied a career high for Moore. He homered in back-to-back at bats in the fifth and seventh innings, becoming the first Fightin Phils to homer in consecutive at bats since himself on June 1, 2024, at Hartford. After another strong night on Wednesday, Moore is 4-6 (.667), with four runs, a double, two home runs, seven RBI and walk. Entering play today, Moore is tied for fourth in the Eastern League in RBI with nine.

After hitting just two home runs over the first eight games of the season, the Fightin Phils hit six long balls on Sunday and Tuesday. Over those two games, the Fighitn Phils have hit the most home runs in the Eastern League. After the recent surge of homers, Reading ranks tied for third in the league in home runs with

Relievers Rolling
The Fightin Phils bullpen has combined to go: 10.2 IP, 10 H, 0 ER, 14 SO so far this week. Reading's bullpen currently owns a 4.50 ERA through 11 games, but when you factor out opening night (13 ER, 4.1 IP), that number drops to 2.51 (13 ER, 46.2 IP).

Two-of-the-three Fightin Phils wins in Somerset last week were of the comeback variety; with those wins occuring on Tuesday and Sunday. Reading came back from down 4-1 on Tuesday night and from down 6-5 on Sunday afternoon. In 2024, the Fightin Phils won just one game when trailing after eight innings and they have already done it twice this season.

Fightin Phils skipper Al Pedrique is now at 123 wins through his two-plus seasons in Reading so far. The third-year manager is seven wins from matching and eight from surpassing Al LeBeouf (130 wins) for 14th all-time in Reading managerial wins. Pedrique joined Reading pior to the 2023 season when he was hired by the Phillies that offseason. He prevously worked with Miami as the Marlins' third-base coach in 2022 and managed Triple-A Jacksonville in 2021. Pedrique had previously managed with Trenton in the Eastern League when he worked with the New York Yankees.

This Day in Baseballtown History
April 17, 2012: At Richmond, the R-Phils rock the Flying Squirrels for 22 hits in a 19-6 pounding at the Diamond. Ten of Reading's runs come in the 6th inning. Among the hitting stars are Cesar Hernandez (5-for-6, 5 runs, RBI), Leandro Castro (3-for-5, 2 doubles, 6 RBI, run) and Darin Ruf (5-for-5, HR, 2B, 4 R, 2 RBI). Ruf's homer would be the first of his record-breaking 38 that season for the R-Phils.

Ponies Rumbling Into Baseballtown

Binghamton enters this week with a 3-6 record, sitting at sixth place in the Eastern League, trailing Reading by one game. The Rumble Ponies went 2-3 last week against Hartford in a series that saw two games postponed, and one set to be made up later in the season. After this season, the Rumble Ponies reutrn home to host New Hampshire. Binghamton the 2024 season witha 69-67 record, the fourth-best mark in the Eastern League Northeast Divsion and missing out on the playoffs. Binghamton's roster features seven of the Mets' top-30 prospects: Jett Williams (2), Ryan Clifford (4), Nolan McLean (5), Jonah Tong (6), Nick Morabito (18), Jonathan Pintaro (24) and Jack Wenninger (29).
