RHP Andrew Quezada (0-2, 9.78) vs. RHP Bryce Jarvis (0-0, 5.94)

TODAY'S GAME: Reno holds a 3-1 series lead after the lsotopes won 8-2 last night, ending the club's four-game overall losing streak and a seven-game skid in Reno ... Andrew Quezada is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes while Bryce Jarvis is expected to start for the Aces.

MLB REHAB: Rockies infielder Thairo Estrada plaved his first rehab game with the Isotopes last night and went 2-for-4 with a strikeout. He played six innings at second base.

HITS: Albuquerque connected on 17 hits last night, the fourthmost in a contest this year. Second time the club has recorded at least 17 hits in Reno this season (also: 18, April 23).

XBH: The Isotopes tallied eight extra-base hits yesterday (five doubles and three homers), tied for the second-most in a contest this year (also: April 17 vs. El Paso). Five doubles tied a seasonhigh (thrice), two of which have come in Reno (also: April 22).

QUALITY: Anthony Molina spun 6.0 innings of two-run ball while fanning eight last night, the lsotopes' fourth quality start of the year. Three of the four quality starts have come on the road (also: April 23 at Reno, Tanner Gordon and May 9 at Oklahoma City, Carson Palmquist). He's the first Isotopes' hurler other than Carson Palmugist to strikeout seven-plus.

HITS ALLOWED: The Isotopes pitching staff tied a season-low in hits allowed last night (three, three times). All three instances have come on the road (also: April 9 at Sugar Land and May 9 at Oklahoma City).

RUNS ALLOWED: Albuquerque limited the Aces to two runs yesterday, ninth time this year permitting two runs or fewer and fourth in May. The last time the Isotopes held Reno to two runs or fewer at Greater Nevada Field was June 22, 2019, a 1-0 loss.

MARGIN OF VICTORY: Last night's win is just the second triumph on the road with a six-plus margin of victory (also: 15, April 23 at Reno, the biggest margin in a road victory in team history).

BIG INNING: The Isotopes plated five runs in the fifth frame yesterday, tied for the second-most tallies scored in an inning this season (six times).

RISP: Albuquerque went 2-for-15 with runners in scoring position Friday, have gone 8-for-46 over the first four games of the set.

HOMERS ALLOWED: Albuquerque has allowed a homer in 10-straight contests, the longest stretch since July 13-August 6, 2024, an 18-game streak.

RIT: Ryan Ritter went 1-for-6 with a double Friday, his sixth-straight game with a double, a franchise record. Has an extrabase hit in eight-straight games, tied for the longest streak in Isotopes history (other: Dallas McPherson, June 18-28, 2028). During that stretch, is slashing .459/.512/.946 with eight doubles, two triples, two homers and 10 RBI ... Has 14-game on base streak and nine-game hit streak.

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura has an nine-game hitting streak, tied for the fifth-longest active streak in PCL. During stretch is slashing .371/.463/.600 with five doubles, one homer and eight RBI ... Has eight RBI in his last six games.

-Hiura has a hit in 15 of 16 games played in May ... During the month, is slashing .355/.429/.613 with a triple, five doubles, three homers and 12 RBI after hitting .141 over first 24 games ... Has 16-game on-base streak, tied for fourth-longest active streak in PCĽ

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson belted two homers last night, the fifth multi-homer game for the Isotopes this season and Thompson's second career (other: July 4, 2024 ... Drove in a season-high four RBI on his two homers, the most RBI in a game since recording a career-high five on June 30, 2024.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard has reached base in 34 of 35 games started on the year ... Tied a career-high with four hits last night (fifth time; last: August 20, 2020). Has an extra-base hit in threestraight games.

YF: Yanquiel Fernandez collected a single yesterday to extend his hit streak to six games. During the stretch is slashing .417/.500/.542 with three doubles and two RBI.

MR. BRUIN: Sean Bouchard belted his first homer with the Isotopes this season yesterday, a three-run shot. Collected second multi-hit game with club (six games played). Has reached in 14 of 29 plate appearances.

WARMING UP: Warming Bernabel has a hit in seven of his last eigh contests. Is 12-for-33 with two doubles, one homer and five RBI during stretch.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Ryan Ritter is 4th in runs scored (35), T-4th in XBH (22), T-5th in total bases (87), 7th in OPS (324), T-8th in walks (30), 10th in OBP (.397) and slugging (.527) ... Sam Hilliard is T-1st in triples (5), 5th in slugging (.555) T-7th in COPP (.201) and Structure (.100). XBH (21) and 9th in OPS (.922) ... Warming Bernabel is T-9th in doubles (12).

NUCLEI NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

AARON MUNOZ: Takes over as Isotopes hitting coach after Jordan Pacheco was named one of two new hitting coaches for the Colorado Rockies on May 12 ... Began the 2025 season as the hitting coach for the ACL Rockies ... Spent nine seasons (2016-2024) as the Rockies bullpen catcher ... Was Isotopes bullpen catcher in 2015 ... Originally drafted by the Blue Jays in the 34th round of the MLB Draft ... Played parts of four seasons in the Minor Leagues (2011-14), making it to Double-A.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
