#### **JUMBO SHRIMP FALL 4-1 TO STRIPERS**

Jonathan Davis and Jhonny Pereda each reached base three times on Saturday, but Jacksonville dropped a 4-1 contest to Gwinnett. Davis led off the game by reaching third base on a single and two-base error. He scored on Jacob Amaya's RBI ground out. The Jumbo Shrimp, though, failed to score for the remainder of the contest. The Stripers were held hitless through the first five inning but burst through with a three-run sixth to take the lead. They added a run in the ninth inning to set the final margin at 4-1.

#### SHRIMP ON THE POND

Through two games in 2024, Jacksonville has mustered only six runs, in large part due to the club's struggles with runners in scoring position. After going leaving nine runners on and going just 3-for-15 with runners in scoring position on Friday, the Jumbo Shrimp stranded eight runners and went 0-for-8 with runners in scoring position on Saturday. In 2023, Jacksonville hit just .247/.336/.400/.736 with runners in scoring position, figures that respectively ranked 27th, 29th, 27th and 29th in Triple-A.

#### WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU?

Daren Brown returns in 2024 as Jacksonville's manager for the third straight season. A native of Holdenville, Okla., Brown holds a 1,282-1,270 (.502) record as a minor league manager. In 2022, Brown's first season with Jacksonville, he piloted the Jumbo Shrimp to an 80-69 (.537) record, placing third in the IL East. Brown also juggled a franchise-record 79 players in 2022, including a Jacksonville high for starting pitchers (25). The Jumbo Shrimp followed that up with a 70-79 (.470) record in 2023, with Brown utilizing a franchise-record 44 different pitchers throughout the campaign.

#### MOVIN' OUT (ANTHONY'S SONG)

Along with Jeff Lindgren, Devin Smeltzer and Eli Villalobos, Anthony Maldonado is returning to the Jumbo Shrimp roster in 2024. The Wellington, Fla., native is coming off a dominate 2023 campaign. Among the 247 pitchers who logged at least 40.0 IP in the International League in 2023, Maldonado ranked first in ERA (1.76), K% (39.4%), K-BB% (27.8%) and SwStr% (21.4%), fourth in xFIP (3.53) and ninth in FIP (3.40). Overall, Maldonado was 7-3 with a 1.76 ERA across 34 games (46.0 IP, 23 H, 21 BB, 71 K).

#### TROY MEETS WORLD

Jumbo Shrimp first baseman **Troy Johnston** is coming off an extraordinary season that saw him earn Marlins Minor League Player of the Year. Johnston finished the season leading all of Minor League Baseball in RBIs (116) while ranking fourth in extra-base hits (67), ninth in hits (157), tied for 10th in runs (102), 13th in OPS (.948), tied for 15th in doubles (36) and 17th in slugging percentage (.549). Over 134 games between Jacksonville and Double-Pensacola, Johnston slashed .307/.399/.549/.948 with 26 home runs and 24 stolen bases, becoming the first Marlins minor leaguer since 2008 to post a season with at least 20 homers and 20 steals.

#### DANE TIME

Originally selected by the Detroit Tigers as a pitcher back in 2017, **Dane Myers** converted to a full-time position player in 2021. The Katy, Texas native batted .292/.371/.442/.813 in 45 games in 2021 and then .267/.315/.489/.804 between Double-A Erie and Triple-A Toledo in 2022 before the Marlins selected him in the minor league phase of that winter's Rule 5 draft. In 2023, Myers unlocked a new level, hitting .316/.406/.489/.895 between Jacksonville and Double-A Pensacola while also making his major league debut with Miami. In Spring Training entering this season, Myers hit .412/.474/.735/1.209 with two doubles, three home runs, five RBIs, four stolen bases and seven runs scored in 17 games.

#### **BACK TO WINNING PLEASE?**

Thanks to a 75-55 (.577) record in 2021 and an 80-69 (.537) mark in 2022, Jacksonville collected back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since 2013-14. In 2023, though, the Jumbo Shrimp finished just 70-79 (.470) to snap their run of winning records. Jacksonville finished the first half of the season with the International League's worst record at 32-42 (-51 run differential) before rebounding with a 38-37 (.507) in the season's second half (-23 run differential).

#### SHRIMP BITES

**Edward Cabrera** will make a rehab start on Sunday against Gwinnett. The right-hander has been sidelined since March 10 due to a right shoulder impingement he suffered while warming up for a Grapefruit League game.

#### ABOUT EDWARD

-Cabrera made his major league debut for the Marlins on August 25, 2021 against the Washington Nationals from loanDepot park. He yielded three runs on four hits in 6.1 innings.

-Once ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the Marlins' organization by MLB.com, Cabrera signed with Miami for \$100,000 on July 2, 2015 as an international free agent. He was also a consensus Top-100 prospect in 2022, ranked 33rd by Keith Law of The Athletic, 34th by MLB Pipeline and No. 69 by both Baseball Prospectus and Baseball America.

-The Marlins were fairly aggressive with Cabrera in the minor leagues, starting his professional career in the Gulf Coast League rather than the Dominican Summer Legaue. After just 82.2 innings in 24 games, including 13 starts, with the GCL Marlins and Short Season Class A Batavia, Cabrera found himself in full season ball with Low-A Greensboro in 2018 at the age of 19.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Assisgned to Jacksonville on March 30 on a rehab assignment.

#### 2023 SEASON

-Posted a 2.91 ERA in seven home MLB starts, going 5-0 while going 0-6 in 10 road starts with a 6.28 ERA.

-Cabrera was optioned to Jacksonville on August 1.

-Named the International League Pitcher of the Week for the week of August 7-13 after tossing  $6.0\,\mathrm{shutout}$  innings of one-hit ball with  $10\,\mathrm{strikeouts}$  on August  $12\,\mathrm{against}$  Norfolk.

#### 2022 SEASON

-In 14 starts with Miami, posted a  $1.49\ \mathrm{ERA}$  in seven road starts versus a  $4.58\ \mathrm{ERA}$  in seven starts at home.

#### 2021 SEASON

-Cabrera made two rehab starts with Low-A Jupiter on June 6 and June 12, throwing 6.0 scoreless innings with 11 strikeouts and no walks. His rehab assignment ended on June 15, when he was assigned to Double-A Pensacola. After five starts with the Blue Wahoos, he was promoted to Jacksonville on July 15.

#### 2020 SEASON

-Cabrera was a member of the Marlins' Alternate Training Site.

#### 2019 SEASON

-Cabrera was assigned to Jacksonville on June 23 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the right-hander ranked second in the Florida State League out of 60 pitchers with at least 40.0 innings pitched in FIP (2.28), third in strikeout percentage (32.2 percent), fourth in K-BB% (24.3 percent), fifth in xFIP (2.64) and ninth in ERA (2.02). He also tallied the circuit's sixth-highest swinging strike percentage (14.5 percent).

-The Santiago, Dominican Republic native surrendered four runs to the first five batters he faced on the season on April 5 at Palm Beach. However, he did not cede another tally until the sixth inning of his start on May 23, a span of 28 consecutive scoreless innings.
