TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and El Paso Chihuahuas (San Diego Padres affiliate) are set for the first of their six-game series at Dell Diamond on Tuesday afternoon. The Express scored their most runs of the season but fell to the Oklahoma City Comets, 12-11, in the series finale at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark on Sunday. Round Rock plated two runs in the top of the second, to which Oklahoma City responded with eight runs, their most in a single frame this year. The inning saw a grand slam from 3B Ryan Fitzgerald, followed by a solo homer off the bat of RF James Tibbs III. The Express stormed back with seven runs in the next two innings for a 9-8 edge. Fitzgerald tied it up with an RBI double in the bottom of the fourth. Both clubs traded homers in the seventh and eighth, including a two-run shot from Round Rock CF Michael Helman to tie it at 11 apiece. Oklahoma City CF Zach Ehrhard ultimately homered in the bottom of the eighth, lifting the Comets to a 12-11 victory and claiming the series, 4-2.

ONE-RUN PAIN

All four of Round Rock's losses to Oklahoma City last week came by a single run, bringing their season total to 1-7 in one-run games. They own a -15 run differential this year. Through 15 games in 2025, the Express held a 7-8 record with a -22 run differential.

START TO THE YEAR

Round Rock's 4-11 record is tied for their worst start in franchise history (4-11 in 2003, 2009, 2018). A loss today would match the worst 16-game record from 2018 and 2003 when the E-Train went 4-12.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST

After a season-high nine runs on Saturday, the Express topped it with 11 in Sunday's series finale. They also drew 11 walks, which were the most since 6/21/2025, from their last trip to Oklahoma City. Round Rock finished the week with 35 runs and 59 hits, which ranked third in the Pacific Coast League. They entered the series averaging 6.8 hits per game and now sit at 8.5.

LONE STAR CLASH

Round Rock is seeking its first series win over El Paso since 6/18/2023 when they took five out of six games here at Dell Diamond. Over 48 meetings in the past four seasons, the Chihuahuas hold a 25-23 advantage and a 3-1-5 series record, while outscoring the Express 364-329.

CAL CONTROL

RHP Cal Quantrill was tabbed the Pacific Coast League Pitcher of the Week for April 6-12, as announced by Minor League Baseball on Monday afternoon. The right-hander recorded Round Rock's longest outing of the season, spinning 7.0 innings on just 69 pitches against Oklahoma City on Friday night. Quantrill allowed one earned run and two hits while striking out six batters without a walk. Over his last two outings, Quantrill has not walked a batter across 12.0 innings, marking the longest active streak among all professional pitchers this season.

ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - SUNDAY, APRIL 14, 1968

On Easter Sunday 1968, the 21-year-old Ryan collected his first Major League win as he handed the Astros a 4-0 loss, their first of the season, and improved the Mets to 2-2. He pitched twice at the end of the 1966 season but did not earn a victory. After not pitching in 1967 due to a forearm injury and completing basic training in the Army Reserve, this marked his first outing of 1968 and the third of his career.

He tossed 6.2 innings of shutout ball, allowing three hits and two walks while striking out eight in the 4-0 Mets victory. Ryan held a no-hitter through 5.0 innings and struck out seven of the first 10 he faced. RHP Danny Frisella threw three scoreless innings out of the bullpen for the save.

The Houston Post read, "Ryan Is Post's Contribution to Major Leagues." "My father was the distributor for the Post in Alvin for ten years. I used to roll and throw 'em for him. I'd go down and roll 'em on the weekends when I was real young. Then when I was in junior high school, I threw them," he told reporters postgame.

He struck out the side to begin the game: CF Ron Davis, 24-year-old future Hall of Famer 2B Joe Morgan and C Hal King. LF Art Shamsky went 2-for-3 and drove in two runs to pace the Mets' offense. In his first big league at-bat, Ryan struck out against Larry Dierker. He finished 0-for-3 with three strikeouts.

- Seeking his MLB debut. Was recalled by Milwaukee August 31, 2020 but did not pitch and was optioned following the game. Was designated for assignment September 14.
- Made 26 starts between Frisco and Round Rock in 2025.
- Combined for a 10-5 mark, 3.85 ERA (55 ER/128.2 IP), and 131 SO/33 BB in 26 starts, split almost evenly between Frisco (14 GS) and Round Rock (12 GS).
