TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and El Paso will start a six-game series tonight at 7:05 p.m. from Dell Diamond. Express RHP A.J. Alexy is slated to start up against Chihuahuas RHP Jesse Scholtens.

BROADCAST INFORMATION

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone or on 91.1 FM from inside Dell Diamond. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone.heart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Fans can also watch the game with a valid MLB.tv login. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties while former Express INF Matt Kata handles color commentary.

LET'S RECAP

Round Rock dropped the series finale by a final score of 20-3 in Oklahoma City. CF J.P. Martinez hit a solo homer in the first frame to make it 1-0 E-Train. Dodgers 2B Michael Busch singled to start the second frame and RF Jason Martin belted a two-run homer. In the third, after CF Drew Avans walked and stole second base, Busch singled to left field and the Dodgers led 3-1. Oklahoma City scratched across five runs in the fifth and took a commanding 8-1 lead. Three walks and three hits fueled the frame. SS Jacob Amaya batted with two outs in the sixth and provided a timely hit on a two-RBI single that increased the Dodgers lead to 10-1. After RF Josh Sale ripped a two-out double in the home-half, DH Diosbel Arias singled to cut the Dodgers lead to 10-2. Round Rock tacked on another run in the eighth and closed the gap to 10-3. 3B Josh Jung was hit by a pitch and 2B Mark Mathias roped a double to score Jung. The Dodgers scored 10 runs in the eighth inning thanks to two walks, four hit batsmen, two singles and three doubles as they ran away with a 20-3 victory.

ALEXY BACK AS A STARTER

Express RHP A.J. Alexy is slated to start Tuesday night in the series opener. He is 6-5 with a 6.50 ERA (59 ER/81.2 IP) in 24 games and 14 starts. The righty has issued 46 walks and collected 81 strikeouts. His last start came on June 26 at Oklahoma City.

STANDINGS UPDATE

Round Rock sits just 5.0 games back of first-place Oklahoma City in the Pacific Coast League East Division. The E-Train have 39 games remaining with 12 of those coming against second-place El Paso and six against the Dodgers.

FACING SOME BIG LEAGUERS

The E-Train finished their 12-game road trip with a 5-7 record. After going 1-5 in Sugar Land, Round Rock went 4-2 while facing Oklahoma City. During the trip, the Express faced Houston Astros rehabber, RHP Lance McCullers Jr., and Los Angeles Dodgers rehabber, RHP Dustin May. Both pitchers made two starts each against the Express. Round Rock also dealt with RHP Brusdar Graterol and RHP Blake Treinen who were on rehab assignments for Los Angeles and came out of the bullpen in Oklahoma City.

KOHEI TO START IN TEXAS

RHP Kohei Arihara is scheduled to start for the Texas Rangers on Tuesday night against the Oakland Athletics at Globe Life Field. Arihara will make his 2022 debut for the Rangers after making 10 starts for Texas in 2021. In 18 games and 14 starts for Round Rock this year he had a 4.88 ERA (39 ER/72.0 IP). In his last five starts, Arihara posted a 3.46 ERA (10 ER/26.0 IP).

MARTINEZ BACK ON TRACK

E-Train CF J.P. Martinez started August 6-for-39. He hit four home runs in his first seven games with the Express, but hadn't gone deep since July 31. He changed that with a solo home run in the first inning on Sunday. Martinez finished the night 1-for-4 with a RBI, a run scored and two strikeouts.

TODAY'S TRANSACTIONS

The Texas Rangers selected the contract of RHP Kohei Arihara and recalled INF Mark Mathias on Tuesday afternoon. RHP Yerry Rodriguez was optioned to Round Rock while RHP Spencer Patton was released. RHP Kyle Cody was reinstated from the 7-day Injured List and RHP Tyler Duffey signed a minor league contract with the Texas Rangers and was assigned to Round Rock.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Fifteen players have made their Triple-A debut as part of the Round Rock Express so far during the 2022 season. RHP Daniel Robert, INF Josh Smith and OF Bubba Thompson all played their first game at the Triple-A level on Opening Day, April 5, 2022, while RHP Hever Bueno made his debut during the April 6 contest. Others who have made their Triple-A debuts this year are INF Diosbel Arias, INF Frainyer Chavez, INF Ezequiel Duran, RHP Chase Lee, OF J.P. Martinez, RHP Seth Nordlin, C Konner Pionto, LHP Cole Ragans, OF Josh Sale, RHP Tyree Thompson and C Matt Whatley. Members of the Express that have made their Major League debuts in 2022 include INF Ezequiel Duran, OF Elier Hernandez, LHP Cole Ragans, INF Josh Smith, OF Bubba Thompson and OF Steele Walker.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players hail from 14 different states, including Alabama, Arizona, California, Colorado, Florida, Illinois, Michigan, Mississippi, North Carolina, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Texas and Washington. EXPRESS MANAGER MATT HAGEN

The 2022 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Matt Hagen's Triple-A coaching debut. A resident of Austin, Hagen spent the last two seasons as the Texas Rangers' Minor League Field Coordinator. He is entering his seventh season in the Rangers organization after previously managing the Low-A Hickory Crawdads in 2018 and 2019 as well as the Short-Season Spokane Indians in 2017. In his three seasons as a manager, Hagen has compiled a .550 winning percentage, combining to post a 192-157 overall record, including capturing the South Atlantic League Championship with Hickory in 2019. He originally joined the Texas organization in 2016 as a coach for the Crawdads.

Prior to joining the Rangers, Hagen spent three years as the head coach at Four Points Baseball in Austin. Upon the conclusion of his playing career in 2012, Hagen returned to his alma mater, Liberty University, as an assistant coach. He also had a stint on the Liberty staff in 2007 and spent three off-seasons as a strength coach for the Flames' baseball, men's soccer and football programs.

An infielder in his playing days, Hagen was selected by the Seattle Mariners in the 12th round of the 2002 MLB Draft and spent time in both the Seattle and San Diego Padres organizations, reaching Double-A Mobile in 2006. Hagen continued his playing career in the independent Frontier and Atlantic Leagues from 2007-2012, earning Atlantic League All-Star honors three times. Hagen was a first team All-Big South selection at Liberty University, leading the conference in home runs and RBI as a junior, and was a member of Liberty's 2000 Big South Championship team that advanced to the NCAA Tournament. Hagen graduated from Liberty in 2012 with a degree in Sport Management.
