SEA DOGS FALL IN EXTRAS Portland fell 4-2 in ten innings last night to Somerset. Rafael Flores blasted a two-run homer in the bottom of the sixth inning and the Patriots led, 2-0. Portland tied it in the top of the seventh inning courtesy of a two-run double by Mikey Romero. He drove home Drew Ehrhard and Caden Rose who reached on a pair of singles. Somerset walked it off in the bottom of the tenth inning with a two run homer by Dylan Jasso and the Sea Dogs fell, 4-2.

DALTON DOMINATES LHP Dalton Rogers made his Double-A debut last night for Portland and was tremendous. He tossed 5.0 shutout innings giving up just two hits. He recorded six strikeouts and issued on walk. Rogers went 2-1 with a 1.31 ERA in five appearances with the Greenville Drive.

JEREMY WU-YELLAND SILENCES SOMERSET Jeremy Wu-Yelland came in with a 2-2 tie in the eighth inning last night and allowed just one baserunner. After striking out the first four batters he faced, he issued a walk then struck out the next two batters without allowing that runner to score. He now has a 1.80 ERA in his two appearances for Portland.

RED HOT BLAZE Blaze Jordan recorded another multi-hit game last night for Portland. In his last five games, he is batting .400 (six-for-fifteen) with two RBI, two walks and just two strikeouts. In his last 10 games, he is hitting .379 (11-for-29) with two doubles, a home run, five RBI and seven runs. He has drawn eight walks compared to just four strikeouts.

OFF TO THE WOO RHP Tyler Uberstine was promoted to AAA Worcester on Thursday. At the time of his promotion, he led the Sea Dogs with 35 strikeouts. In six starts, he tossed 29.2 innings allowing 13 runs (12 earned) on 27 hits while walking four.

ON BRAND RHP Jonathan Brand has had a great start to the season for Portland. In seven appearances out of the bullpen, he is 1-0 with a 0.00 ERA. He has tossed 10.0 innings allowing five hits while walking six and striking out 16. Brand has also recorded two saves.

WHERE DO WE STAND With the loss last night, the Sea Dogs are now in second place of the Northeast Division of the Eastern League. They are just 0.5 game behind the first place Hartford Yard Goats. The Binghamton Rumble Ponies are in third place, 1.0 game behind Hartford and the Somerset Patriots are in fourth place, 5.0 games back.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY May 17, 2016 – Andrew Benintendi picked up his first Double-A hits, going 2-for-3, 2 RBI and a walk in Portland's 5-3 win over New Hampshire. Benintendi walked in his first at-bat, singled home a run in his second at-bat and nailed a run-scoring double in his third turn.

ON THE MOUND RHP David Sandlin will take the mound tonight for the Sea Dogs. He last pitched on May 11th against the Chesapeake Baysox and allowed three runs on five hits while striking out a season-high nine batters in 5.0 innings. He has faced the Patriots twice in his career and is 0-1 with a 7.88 ERA. In 8.0 innings, he has allowed seven runs on eight hits while walking three and striking out nine.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Manager - Chad Epperson

Manager Chad Epperson will lead the team in his fourth season in Portland. In 2024, he led the Sea Dogs to a 78-60 record, the best record in the Northeast Division of the Eastern League, and third best in the league. In his fourth season with the team, he is tied for the longest serving manager in Sea Dogs history with Arnie Beyeler who managed Portland for four seasons from 2007 to 2010. Before managing the Sea Dogs, Epperson spent 12 seasons as the Red Sox Catching Coordinator.

Pitching Coach - Sean Isaac

Sean Isaac will serve as Portland's pitching coach for a third season. Under his leadership, the Sea Dogs' pitching staff led Double-A in strikeouts (1,329) and were second in saves (40) in 2024. In 2022 he was the assistant pitching coach for the Nashville Sounds, the Triple-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Previously, Isaac served as the Director of Player Development at UC-Santa Barbara.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera will join Sean Isaac as a second pitching coach with Portland. Rivera spent the last three seasons as Salem Red Sox' pitching coach and led the pitching staff to a 3.61 ERA, fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, he has been in the Red Sox organization since 2022 as a Development Coach with Salem.

Hitting Coach - Chris Hess

Chris Hess returns to Portland for his second year as the Sea Dogs' hitting coach after serving as the Greenville Drive's hitting coach in 2023. Last season, Portland's hitters led Double-A in runs (711), doubles (285), RBI (658), slugging (.412) and OPS (.753). They ranked second in average (.257), hits (1,221), and OBP (.348). He was a coach for the Sea Dogs in 2022 and in Fort Myers during the 2021 season. This year will mark Hess' fifth year in the Red Sox organization.

Assistant Hitting Coach - Johnny Reina

Johnny Reina will serve as Assistant Hitting Coach after working as a Hitting Trainer at Driveline Baseball in Seattle, Washington. Driveline Baseball's mission is to develop the future of baseball training by finding industry-leading insights, all while publishing those insights back to the baseball community.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala will be on staff for his second season in Portland after previously working as the Associate Head Coach at Grove City College from 2016 – 2023. Sasala helped the 2023 Wolverines to a school-record 30 victories, along with a 16-4 conference record.

Athletic Trainer - Bobby Stachura

Stachura returns to Portland for his third season as the Sea Dogs' Athletic Trainer. Stachura has served as the Athletic Trainer for Single-A Greenville for the past four seasons. He started in the Red Sox organization in 2017 as the Athletic Trainer for the Lowell Spinners. He also spent four years as an athletic trainer at the University of Rhode Island. Stachura graduated with a B.S. in Athletic Training from Lasell College in 2013.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch joins the staff for his first season in Portland, but his second year in the Red Sox organization. He was previously an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach. In that role, he assisted in the strength and conditioning for players returning to the field.
