RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (10-7)

AT

Inland Empire 66ers (6-11)



RHP Sean Paul Linan (1-1, 1.15 ERA) vs. LHP Francis Texido (0-0, 7.36 ERA)

TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue a six-game road trip to San Bernardino, taking on the Inland Empire 66ers (Angels) in the third game of a six-game series at San Manuel Stadium.

VS THE 66ERS: Today's game is the third of 24 between these two teams in 2025 and the third of 12 here at San Manuel Stadium. Last year, the Quakes went 10-2 here in San Bernardino, 17-7 overall.

LAST GAME: Rancho broke open a close game late, dropping the Inland Empire 66ers on Wednesday afternoon by a final of 12-3 at San Manuel Stadium. Four different players had two RBIs each, while three players had two hits each, as the Quakes finished with a total of 11 hits. Victor Rodrigues (1) smashed his first homer of the year, while Samuel Munoz extended his personal hitting streak to eight straight games. Rancho starter Aidan Foeller started and set a new career-high with 12 strikeouts. Reliever Alex Makarewich (2-0) pitched two scoreless innings and picked up the win.

TURNING THE CORNER ON THE ROAD?: The Quakes have a great home record at 7-2, but are just 3-5 on the road, after going 2-4 in Stockton and 1-1 so far here in Inland Empire. They've won two of their last three games though, scoring double-digit runs in both wins. They've also added three home runs in the first two games this series.

ROSTER MOVES: On Wednesday, the Quakes added RHP Nicolas Cruz from the Arizona Complex League. The Quakes activated Niko Perez on Tuesday, after hitting the Injured List with a hamstring injury during the team's first road trip in Stockton. In addition, Rancho received LHP Octavio Becerra and RHP Connor Godwin from the Arizona Complex League. RHP Domingo Geronimo was sent to the ACL.

STILL WEARING THE SAME SHOE: The Quakes have welcomed back Manager John Shoemaker, who returns to Rancho to guide the Quakes for a fifth straight year, a franchise record. The club is 271-243 in four seasons under "Shoe", having made the playoffs twice, including one appearance in the Championship Series (2023). The Quakes have only one returning coach to this year's club, as pitching coach Ramon Troncoso returns to Rancho, joining Shoemaker for his fifth year as well. New members of the coaching staff include hitting coach Johermyn Chavez, pitching coach Brandon Bailey, Bench Coach Dunior Zepa, Bullpen Coach and former Quake Marco Hernandez, Athletic Trainer Alfredo Casillas, Performance Coach Jake Taylor and Video Associate Max Delorme.

PROSPECT HEAVY: According to MLB Pipeline's rankings the Dodgers have stocked the Quakes with seven of their top-30 prospects. In order, they are: INF Kellon Lindsey (#8), OF Eduardo Quintero (#9), INF Joendry Vargas (#12), RHP Hyun-Seok Jang (#17), OF Mike Sirota (#21), OF Jaron Elkins and RHP Samuel Sanchez (#28). Of the 29 active players on the Rancho roster, 15 of them saw time in a Quakes' uniform in 2024.

SEAN PAUL LINAN: Right-hander Sean Paul Linan makes his fourth appearance and third start of the year, his first against the 66ers. In his last outing, he dominated over 5.2 innings in a no-decision against Stockton on April 18th, striking out 10 batters while allowing just one hit and one walk. Linan was named Cal League Pitcher of the Week for his performance. Linan opened the 2024 season with the ACL Dodgers, going 3-0 with a 2.08 ERA over six games (one start) before joining the Quakes, where he'd go 6-2 with a 4.89 ERA over 13 games (four starts). Linan signed with the Dodgers in January of 2022 out of Cartagena, Columbia.

FRANCIS TEXIDO: Francis Texido makes his fourth start and his first against the Quakes. In his last outing, he allowed six runs on four hits with five walks over 3.1 innings in a no-decision at Modesto on April 18th. Last year, Texido made 25 appearances (24 starts), going 4-7 with a 6.77 ERA for Inland Empire. Texido signed with the Angels in March of 2023 out of Havana, Cuba.
