**TODAY'S GAME:** The Curve continue a six-game series with the Harrisburg Senators, the teams will meet a total of 24 times season.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Noe Toribio matched a career-high with 8 strikeouts in 5.0 scoreless innings of relief and Matt Gorski smacked a 3-run homer to lead Altoona to a 6-4 win in the series opener.

**THE BABE:** With a 3-run homer in his Double-A debut, Matt Gorski now stands alone as the minor league leader in home runs with 18 on the season.

**ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS:** The Curve set their franchise record with 19 runs in Sunday's win over Richmond. Seven players recorded multi-hit days led by Tucupita Marcano and Lolo Sanchez with 3 each. After falling behind 3-0 in the top of the first, Altoona scored a season-best 8 runs on 6 hits including back-to-back home runs by Aaron Shackelford and Andres Alvarez. The Curve scored a run in 6-of-8 innings at the plate. Marcano, Sanchez, Connor Scott and Shackelford combined for 12 runs batted in in the 6-7-8-9 spots in the order.

**LET'S HIT:** The Curve have picked up at least 10 hits in 6-of-their-9 last games. The Curve lead the Eastern League with a .253 team batting average. Altoona has also homered in 9 straight games, totaling 18 homers, taking aim at the franchise record of 10 straight games.

**THAT BLAKE SABOL, SO HOT RIGHT NOW:** Catcher Blake Sabol picked up a career-high 4 hits on Wednesday, May 18 and over his last 10 games (5/11 to Present) he's batting .375 (12-for-32) with 3 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 10 RBI and 9 BB.

**NICKY G IS FOR ME:** Infielder Nick Gonzales is beginning to heat up. Over his 8 game hit streak (5/11-5/21) he batted .467 (14-for-30) with 3 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI and 5 BB with 5 multi-hit games including 4 straight entering play on Friday.

**NO LEAD IS SAFE:** Altoona has held a lead after 5 innings in 25 of 40 games played this season and hold an 15-10 record in those games.

**A LOT OF DEBUTS:** 2021 Curve LHP Cam Alldred became the 177th alumni in franchise history to reach the major leagues and that has begun a parade of former Curve players to the major league roster in Pittsburgh. OF Cal Mitchell made his debut on May 24 against Colorado and became the 178th alum to reach MLB. RHP Yerry De Los Santos has also been called up and when he appears he'll be the 179th alum.

**HE'S HERE:** On Tuesday, May 10 the Curve added C Henry Davis to the active roster. Davis, selected No. 1 Overall in 2021 out of Louisville, is the first position player selected first overall to join the Curve. Previously, three players picked No. 1 overall played for Altoona: RHP Kris Benson (1996 / 2002 Rehab), RHP Bryan Bullington (2001 / 2004 with Curve), and RHP Gerrit Cole (2011 / 2012 with Curve). Davis and Gonzales (7th overall) account for Pittsburgh's last two first-round draft picks, marking the just the second time in franchise history that Altoona has had two players selected in the top-10 of the draft on the active roster at the same time, first time since RHP Jameson Taillon (2nd Overall) and RHP Gerrit Cole (1st overall) called Peoples Natural Gas Field home in the final weeks of the 2012 season.

Pirates General Manager Ben Cherington shared an update on Davis' status on his 93.7 The Fan Radio Show on Sunday, May 23 and stated that Davis has a small fracture in his left wrist and is not expected to be sidelined for very long. Davis played 2 games for the Curve where he went 1-for-5 with a HR and 2 RBI as well as 1 BB and 2 HBP before being placed on the IL on Wednesday, May 18.

**ALL HAIL PEGGY:** Entering Tuesday's game with Harrisburg, Liover Peguero has his name all over the Eastern League leaderboard. He is T-6th in BA (.317), 3rd in hits (46), T-2nd in XBH (19), T-1st in 3B (4) and 3rd in RBI (27).

**BURROWED:** Mike Burrows was been unscored upon in four of his starts this year and allowed 2 runs or fewer in 7-of-his-8 starts this season. Following play on Friday, May 20, he ranked all over the EL Leaderboards: 6th in ERA (2.27), 8th in WHIP (0.95), 6th in BAA (.178), T-7th in K's (46) and 9th in IP (35.2).

**TROUBLE WITH THE LONG BALL:** Altoona pitchers have surrendered 48 home runs on the season, tied for 16th-most by a pitching staff in minor league baseball and second-most in the Eastern League behind Hartford and Binghamton (52). The Curve have allowed a home run in 26 of 40 games.

**THE SENATORS:** Managed by Tripp Kiester, Harrisburg has hovered around the .500 mark through the first 39 games of the season. With an average age of 25.7, the Senators feature several Eastern League veterans including Mitch Longo (Akron), Franklin Kilome (Reading), Ronald Herrera (Trenton), Dakody Clemmer (Akron), Brian Gonzales (Bowie and Hartford) and Wilson Garcia (Akron).

**FILIBUSTERING FOR THE SENATORS:** Steven Fuentes makes his eighth start of the season this morning. After a rough first outing of the season, Fuentes has found his strike holding his opponent to 2 runs or fewer in 5-of-his-last-6 starts. The Panamanian native was originally signed as an international free agent in 2013 and re-signed with the Nationals in this past off-season.

## TODAY IN CURVE HISTORY

2003 - The Pirates 2001 first round pick and Pittsburgh's top prospect John VanBenschoten is called up from Lynchburg with a 6-0 record and 2.22 ERA. He made his AA debut vs. Binghamton and pitched four innings, allowed two runs on eight hits with five strikeouts as the Curve went on to win 5-4. Second Pirates first-rounder to debut at AA that season (Sean Burnett)

2015 - Dan Gamache becomes the first player to record a five-hit game in seven years when he went 5-for-5 at New Hampshire. Included a two-run homer in the seventh. Keon Broxton also had a perfect day at the plate by going 4-4 with a walk, homer, double.

**2022:** Was a non-roster invitee to Pirates Spring Training... Started on Opening Day against Harrisburg and was charged with the loss, matched a career-high five runs allowed... Walked a career-high five batters on 4/21 vs. New Hampshire... Was placed on IL on May 12 (shoulder, retroactive to 5/11), returned on 5/18 vs. Richmond...

**2021:** Made his professional debut with High-A Greensboro... Allowed one earned run or fewer in six of his first seven appearances... Struck out at least six batters in six straight outings from May 16 to June 26... Struck out a career-high nine batters on June 26 vs. Greenville, allowed one run on two hits and no walks in 6.0 innings pitched... Was placed on the IL on July 12 with a sore shoulder... Returned on August 14 and was held 2.1 innings or fewer in each of his final five regular season appearances for Greensboro to finish the regular season... After using a powerful sinking fastball at South Carolina, has adopted a more traditional four-seam fastball as a pro... Change has helped his fastball play better off of his cutter, slider and changeup... Was rated by MLB.com as the No. 21 prospect in the 2020 draft... Signed with the Pirates for \$2,050,000... Was ranked as the top prep player in the state of South Carolina in 2017 by Perfect Game... Grew up playing shortstop before beginning to pitch during his junior year at Hilton Head (SC) High School... Was the South Carolina 4A Player-of-the-Year in 2017 despite having his season cut short by a torn fingernail... Was a Baseball America Top 500 prospect for the 2017 MLB Draft... Plays the guitar and piano... Does not have any social media accounts and didn't have a cell phone until age 16... Brother, JJ, was named the 2020 Rookie of the Year for South Carolina's Club Baseball Team after going 2-0 with a 1.50 ERA in three starts during the pandemic-shortened season...
