Today's Games

The Clippers will send RHP Rorik Maltrud to the mound today, needing a win to secure their first series win since 3/31-4/5 (have won five straight series closing games). Columbus is 22-11 (.667) versus right handers this year. Benschoter has pitched against the Clippes seven times in his career, going 2-1 with a 6.92ERA (13.0IP, 18H, 10R, 10ER, 5BB, 12K).

vs. the Bats

Columbus was 7-11 against Louisville last year, going 4-10 in the last 14G to lose the season series for the third straight year (4-0 from 2018-22). Individually, Kahlil Watson has gone 12x37 (.324) with 2HR and 5RBI against the Bats during his career (10G). George Valera has collected 6HR and 14RBI in 28G opposing Louisville, while Kody Huff owns 2HR and 12RBI in 16G.

Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G last Tuesday, but has scored in 11 of the last 14G (also scored in five of eight last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have 84 runs from the 8th inning on (13 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .976OPS (+135 points on 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 22 runs in the last 14G (more than nine teams have all season, including Louisville).

Watch Out for Watson

Kahlil Watson is hitting .297/.388/.610 with 18XBH in his last 31G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of 13G prior to last Friday (.453OBP, 4/23-5/13). Watson has 6HR and 17RBI in 12G since 5/10 (.275, 14x51); however, he has not drawn a walk in his last 12G (52PA, 18K), his longest walkless stretch since a 17G run from 5/21-6/17/22 (career long, 76PA; hit .189, 14x74).

Juan Gone

Juan Brito is hitless in his last 3G (11AB), batting just .179 (7x39) in 10G since a 9G hit streak to begin May (.316, 12x38 with 4HR and 13RBI). He owns just a pair of XBH on the cold spell, but has been putting the bat on the ball (3K in last 31PA). He has struggled from the left side of the plate all season (.218/.337/.322), continuing a Triple-A trend (.239/.355/.409 in career; .288/.406/.482 at lower levels).

Misleading Streaks

Nolan Jones has reached base in 17 consecutive games, posting a .342OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop 18 points over the course of the streak, while his batting average has dipped 25 points (.213, 13x61). George Valera owns a 14G on base streak since 5/5, but has recorded only a .361OBP on the streak (+42 points on his season line), while hitting .235 (12x51; lost 10 points on average).

Adjusting Fine

Ralph Velazquez was 2x4 with a double last night, his second double since joining the Clippers this week and his 11th between Akron and Columbus (.553SLG among both levels). Velazquez is still looking for his first RBI in Triple-A (0x3 with runners in scoring position), after driving in 19 in his last 19G with Akron. He is the fourth youngest player in the IL this year and will turn 21 on Thursday in Toledo.

Hot Huff

Kody Huff rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 12G this month (.476, 20x42, 14RBI). The hit streak, from 5/1-5/16, set a new career best, topping his streak in the first 10G of April, 4/1-4/12 (.316, 12x38; hit .220, 11x50, in last 13G of the month). Though Huff's hit streak ended on Tuesday, he rebounded with an RBI single on Wednesday (25RBI in last 28G).

POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), Milan Tolentino is hitting .173/.269/.256 with 1HR and 12RBI in 23G (16K in last 27PA). Last night's grand slam snapped an 83AB homerless streak for Tolentino and was his 28th homer off RHP as a Clipper (of 41 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of 2025, he is one of two that has not homered off LHP).

Back on Track

In the last 12G, the Columbus bullpen has cobbled together a 2.80ERA (45.0IP, 14ER), the 3rd best mark in the IL (3ER or fewer in all 12G, longest streak of the year). Clipper relievers had allowed 21ER in 10.1IP of the 2G prior to the hot streak, as the relief ERA rose to 6.08 (worst in the IL; currently at 5.39, 17th). They have allowed 3HR to 200BF in the last 12G (17HR to 775BF prior, 45.6PA/HR).

This Date in Clipper History

5/24/1997

Tied 8-8 in the top of the 9th at Ottawa, the Clippers called on backup infielder **Tim Barker** to pinch-hit with two runners on base. Barker delivered a 2-run triple to put the Clippers ahead 10-8. After the Clippers blew the save in the bottom of the 9th, Barker stepped to the plate with two men on again in the 11th inning, this time hitting a 3-run HR to send the Clippers to a 13-11 victory over the Lynx.

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,429 to 1,376).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 71-68 (.511) in pitch reviews, with batters going 42-46 (.477) and pitchers/catchers going 29-22 (.569). They have run out of challenges in 28G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 849, would rank as 4th most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 67 through the first 50G (on pace for 201SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 18CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (54) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 78 grand slams and 1,928RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.54 through the first 50G. Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 150HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 14th in the IL this year (.977), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 25G this season (15-10, .600), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Kody Huff bunted a run in, while moving another to scoring position in a 5/24 win vs. Louisville. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 87-23 (.791) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 4-2 mark this season (.667, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 412-430 (.489), 382-384 with Columbus (.499).
