José Tena hit a two-run homer for the Captains in the first inning and Lake County scored three runs in the seventh on a two-run single by Quentin Holmes and an RBI single by

PLAYOFF PICTURE: The Captains enter today one game behind the Great Lakes Loons for the second playoff spot in the High-A Central League (HAC). Lake County, Great Lakes, the Cedar Rapids Kernels and the Dayton Dragons are all separated by just 2.5 games. The Quad Cities River Bandits currently hold the top playoff spot and are 10 games ahead of Great Lakes. The top two teams in the HAC earn playoff bids (regardless of division).

MOVING UP: Three of the Captains' most impactful position players have been called up to Double-A Akron in the last week. INF Brayan Rocchio (#7 CLE Prospect - MLB.com) and C Bryan Lavastida (#24 CLE Prospect - MLB.com) were promoted last Friday. OF Will Brennan was called up yesterday. Rocchio departed as the team leader in homers with nine. Lavastida exited as the team leader in batting average at .303 and fresh off a 22-game on-base streak from June 24 to July 24, during which he hit .395/.479/.684. Brennan was sixth among qualified High-A Central League hitters in average at .290 and exits at second in the league with 22

LIMITING DAMAGE: Since July 1, the Captains have the second-best ERA (3.91) in the High-A Central League (HAC), despite allowing the second-most home runs (44).

GETTING ON: Since July 1, the Captains are third in the High-A Central League (HAC) in on-base percentage (.345) and have worked the second-most walks (136). From May through June, the Captains were last in the league in walks (167) and third from the

STARTERS ON A ROLL: Captains starters have a 3.20 ERA (18 ER, 50.2 IP) over the last nine games. No Captains starter has allowed more than three earned runs in an outing during that span.

VALERA RAKES AND TAKES: George Valera leads the Captains in homers (8), walks (28) and on-base percentage (.429) since July 1 and has more walks than strikeouts (26) in that span. His 22.2% BB% is up from 11.1% in May-June

ALL OR NOTHING: José Tena does not have a single one-hit game in his last 13 games. The Captains' shortstop has either delivered multiple hits or gone hitless since July 21. He is hitting .240/.321/.480 (.721 OPS) in that span. For the season, Tena has a team-best 22 multi-hit games. He has 23 one-hit games and 25 zero-hit games

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 22-11 at home, compared to 22-26 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.78 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.58 ERA on the road.

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year - OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

HIGH-A: The 2021 season marks the Captains' first as the High-A Affiliate of the Cleveland Indians. Lake County had been Cleveland's Low-A Affiliate for 17 seasons (2003-2019) and 18 years (2003-2020).

NEW SKIPPER: Greg DiCenzo was named the Captains' manager before the eventually-canceled 2020 season. DiCenzo spent the previous 12 seasons as the head baseball coach at the College of the Holy Cross in Worcester, MA. During his time at the helm, DiCenzo was twice named Patriot League Coach of the Year (2008 and 2013). Prior to his time at Holy Cross, DiCenzo was the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Northeastern University for five seasons. He also served as a coach for the Falmouth Commodores in the Cape Cod Baseball League and at his alma mater, St. Lawrence University. DiCenzo enters his second year and rst season as a coach in Cleveland's organization.

LAST TIME OUT: Espino recorded all 12 of his outs on strikeouts across four innings of work at Dayton last Friday. The right-hander allowed three runs and four hits, all of which came in the third inning. The Captains combined to strike out 20 Dragons hitters to set a team record for most K's in a nine-inning game. Lake County's record for most strikeouts in a game (regardless of game length) is 21, which came in a 15-inning game on July 13, 2012 against Wisconsin. The Captains beat Dayton last Friday, 8-5.

PROSPECTING: Espino ranks as Cleveland's #2 prospect according to *FanGraphs*, #3 by *Baseball America* and #6 by *MLB.com*.

TOP PICK: Cleveland drafted Espino with their first round pick (24th overall) in the 2019 MLB Draft. The right-hander earned a \$2.5 million signing bonus. He was committed to play at Louisiana State University before signing with Cleveland.

SCOUTING REPORT: "Espino works at 94-97 mph and can touch triple digits with his fastball, imparting running life on his four-seamer and heavy sink on his two-seamer. He backs up his heat with a pair of batmissing breaking balls, with his low-80s slider sharper and grading better than his high-70s curveball. His changeup is more of a work in progress that gets too firm at times but also features some promising sink." (Source: MLB.com)

SCOUTING GRADES: Fastball – 70; Slider – 60; Curveball – 55; Changeup – 50; Control – 50; Overall – 50 (Source: *MLB.com*)

PANAMA → GEORGIA: Espino was born and grew up in Panama, but moved to the United States when he was a sophomore in high school and pitched for Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, GA. As Mandy Bell wrote in her *MLB.com* article on Espino, Espino spent time in the U.S. for baseball when he was 10 and decided then that he wanted to move there. When Daniel was 15, he went to his parents and told them he needed to move to the United States to pursue his baseball dreams. When asked about his decision to move to the U.S., Espino said "My mom and dad wanted me to finish high school first and then worry about the next, but I love playing baseball. I had the opportunity to [visit America] when I was 10 years old and I loved it. Now, the sacrifice is paying off (Source: *The Record-Courier*).

PANAMANIAN ROLE MODEL: Espino idolized Panamanian star and Hall of Fame closer Mariano Rivera as a child.

FIRST SINCE FRANCISCO: When he advanced to Mahoning Valley in 2019, Espino became the first high schooler promoted by Cleveland to the Short Season level since Francisco Lindor in 2011.

2020: Pitched at Classic Park, which was Cleveland's alternate training site, before doing remote development prior to the fall instructional league. Espino did not pitch at instructs due to a minor shoulder injury (Source: FanGraphs).

2019: Made his professional debut in the Rookie Level Arizona League and posted a 1.98 ERA before being bumped up to Short Season Mahoning Valley. Espino posted a 6.30 ERA with the Scrappers over three starts. Though he made nine starts and did not make any relief appearances, Espino never pitched more than four innings in a single professional game during his debut season.
