Big Week on the Road

The Fightin Phils remain on the road for their penultimate road trip of the 2026 regular season. It will be a big matchup at the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, who Reading currently holds a 2.5-game lead over in the Northeast Division Standings. It is the 17th-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and 11th-of-12 at Hadlock Field in Portland. Entering play today, the Sea Dogs hold a 9-7 edge in the season series.

Two in a Row to Grow the Division Lead

The Reading Fightin Phils (27-21, 57-60) defeated the Portland Sea Dogs 5-2 on Friday night at Delta Dental Park, extending their Eastern League Northeast Division lead to 2.5 games with 20 games remaining. Gage Wood delivered a strong start, matching his season and career high with five innings while allowing just two hits and one unearned run and striking out five. Reading jumped ahead early as Bryan Rincon led off the game with his 19th home run of the season, and Luke Ritter added an RBI groundout in the second to make it 2-0. Portland cut the deficit in half in the fourth when Roman Anthony doubled and scored on a throwing error by Aroon Escobar. After Wood exited, Portland tied the game in the sixth when Anthony's sacrifice fly scored Justin Gonzalez, but Reading immediately answered. Raider Tello doubled home Carson DeMartini in the seventh before scoring on Ritter's sacrifice fly to restore a 4-2 lead. The Fightins added an insurance run in the eighth when DeMartini drove in Raylin Heredia with a groundout. Evan Gates earned the win with two innings of relief, while Daniel Harper and Jack Dallas each tossed a scoreless inning before Estibenzon Jimenez closed out the victory with his fourth save. Tello led Reading with two hits and a run scored, while Rincon's leadoff homer provided the early spark.

Destiny in Our Hands

The Fightin Phils next two series are against two of the teams chasing them in the Northeast Division standings. Currently up is Portland, who is 2.5 games back and then next week Binghamton comes to Reading, as the Rumble Ponies have roared their way all the way back to 2.5 games behind the R-Phils. Somerset is also mixed into a crowded playoff picture as well, sitting 2.5 games back of Reading, but those two teams don't match up again this season. This marks the latest in the season that the Fightin Phils have been in first place since they finished the 2019 second half with a 41-31 record, which clinched the second half division title that season.

Binelas Bashes

Alex Binelas, who played for Portland for parts of three seasons ('22-'24), enters play tonight with 25 home runs, which matches a career-high (2022) and has the most home runs in the Eastern League this season. His 25 home runs have all come with Reading and it made him the First Fightin Phil to hit the 25-home run mark since Mitch Walding in 2017. With 20 games remaining, Binelas is five home runs away from being the first R-Phil to hit over 30 long balls in a season since 2016, when Dylan Cozens (40) and Rhys Hoskins (38) both surpassed the mark.

Mr. Doubles

Raylin Heredia enters play tonight with a team-high and Eastern League-best 32 doubles this season. This is the second-straight season that a R-Phil had over 30 doubles, as Felix Reyes had 34 in 2025. The last time Reading had a player with over 30 doubles in back-to-back seasons was Brock Stassi (32) in 2015 and Dylan Cozens (38) in 2016. Heredia is the 24th R-Phil in franchise history to have over 30 doubles in a single-season and currently ranks as tied for the 17th most doubles in a single-season in team history. Greg Jacobs (2007) and David Doster (1995) hold the franchise record in single-season doubles with 39. Heredia now leads the Eastern League with 133 hits, which is the most hits in a season by a R-Phil since Carlos De La Cruz had 132 in 2023.

Rincon Rakes

Phillies No. 5 prospect Bryan Rincon continued his breakout 2026 season with four hits on Thursday night and his 19th home run of the season on Friday. Rincon also added three doubles. His four hits matched a season and career-high four the third time, as he also clubbed four hits on May 1 at Hartford and July 1 vs New Hampshire. Rincon's three doubles marked a new career high for him and it was the fourth multi-double game in his career. Rincon now has 23 doubles this season, along with 44 extra-base hits, all of which are career highs. He played in his 100th game last night, the first time in his career doing that.

One Year Turnaround

The Fightin Phils finished the 2025 season with a 55-81 record, which was the lowest win total under Al Pedrique (since 2023). Entering play tonight, Reading had surpassed its win total from last season through the first 115 games of the 2026 campaign. Reading won 59 games in 2024 and 2023, while 2019 (80-53 overall record) is the last time the Fightins eclipsed the 60-win mark.

This Day in Baseballtown History

August 22, 2014: At Reading, the Fightin Phils improve to 10-2 in extra-inning games by beating Erie, 4-3, in 12. Raywilly Gomez hits a 2-run homer, his only HR of the season, to tie the game in the 9th before Peter Lavin's RBI single wins it in the 12th.

Playing Portland

The Sea Dogs enter tonight with a 60-57 overall record and 25-24 mark in the second half, 2.5-games behind Reading for first place. Portland most recently dropped five-of-six games against Binghamton, and following this week, they begin a two-week road trip, first at Richmond. Portland's roster features eight of the Red Sox top-30 prospects: Justin Gonzales (2), Henry Godbout (6), Yoeilin Cespedes (14), Jack Winnay (23), Mason White (26), Hayden Mullins (27), Miguel Bleis (28) and Johanfran Garcia (29).

Portland Pitcher

Lefty Michael Sansone makes his 12th appearance and fifth start for Portland tonight. Sansone is 3-3, with a 5.89 ERA (29 ER, 44.1 IP), along with 39 strikeouts. He last pitched on Aug. 15 against Binghamton, taking the loss, allowing five runs over four innings, with six strikeouts. Sansone has also made nine appearances with Worcester (AAA) this season and split 2025 between Salem (A), Greenville (A+) and Portland. The 26-year old signed with Tampa as an undrafted free agent in 2022 and signed with Boston as a minor league free agent in 2024.
