Dom Hamel twirled a gem, in one of his best starts of the season in the first game and Matt Rudick hit a go-ahead three-run homer in extra innings. Jose Peroza had a three-hit, four-RBI game in the second game.

Peroza Plays: Infielder **Jose Peroza** drove in four runs in the second game of the doubleheader last night, marking his second game of the season with at least four RBIs. Over his last 10 games, Peroza is batting .325 with a .625 SLG and 1.011 OPS. He has 13 hits, three doubles, three homers, nine RBIs and nine runs scored in his past 10 games.

Nuke Ritter: Infielder **Luke Ritter** has been on a rampage over this entire road trip. Ritter has 11 home runs for Binghamton this season and six have come in this road trip. He had two multi-homer games in Altoona, in the series opener and finale, smashing four homers in the series and homered again on Tuesday and Thursday at Reading. Here are his stats over his past 15 games: .293 AVG, .793 SLG, 1.152 OPS, 17 H, 3 2B, 1 3B, 8 HR, 18 RBI, 17 R, 6 BB. Ritter has 10 hits and four homers in his last seven games. The Ponies have moved him into the three-hole in the order this week

Jordan's Brand: Outfielder/infielder Rowdey Jordan has heated up on this road trip. In his 10 games on this road trip, Jordan is hitting .282 with a .487 SLG and .891 OPS. Jordan has 11 hits with two doubles and two homers, six RBIs, and seven runs scored in that span. He has walked eight times, which is second on the team over that span. He has upped his season batting average to .225 and now has a careerhigh five homers, after hitting four across two levels last season.

Rudickulous: Outfielder **Matt Rudick** sits in the top 10 in the Eastern League in seven offensive categories. He ranks 1st in OBP (.447), 1st in R (43), 3rd in OPS (.973), T-4th in BB (39), 6th in AVG (.304), 7th in SLG (.526), and T-9th in XBH (20). Rudick is leading the team or tied for the team lead in eight major offensive categories. He crushed the go-ahead three-run homer in the eighth inning in game one of yesterday's doubleheader.

Reid Brignac - Manager - 2nd season with Binghamton - 4th year in the Mets organization.

In 2022, Brignac led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, Jose Butto, Nate Fisher, and Bryce Montes de Oca), tied for the second-most in franchise history. This past fall, Brignac was one of two Mets staff members selected to be a part of the Arizona Fall League coaching staff, serving as the manager of the Peoria Javelinas. Following his retirement as an active player in 2018, Brignac was the manager of the St. Lucie Mets (Low-A) in 2021 before coming to Binghamton last year. As a player, Brignac appeared in parts of nine seasons in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft.

AJ Sager - Pitching Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 2nd year in the Mets organization. Sager served in the same role for the Brooklyn Cyclones (High-A) last season. Sager previously spent twenty seasons with the Detroit Tigers organization, including six seasons as the pitching coach with Triple-A Toledo. He pitched for parts of five seasons in the major leagues, playing for the San Diego Padres, Colorado Rockies, and Detroit Tigers as part of a 12-year professional career. In 123 major league appearances, the right-hander was 12-15, with five career saves and a 5.36 ERA.

Darin Everson- Hitting Coach - 1st season with Binghamton - 1st year in the Mets organization. Everson spent the previous five seasons as the Colorado Rockies Hitting Coordinator and 10 years in the Rockies organization.
