MILESTONE: The Omaha Storm Chasers defeated the Iowa Cubs, 7-1, on Saturday to snap a three-game losing streak and win their first game over the I-Cubs since May 24, 2019 at Werner Park. It was Omaha's first win over Iowa at Principal Park since May 14, 2019. **RHP Jackson Kowar** dazzled in his fourth start of the season, striking out a career-high 10 batters while allowing one run on four hits and one walk in 6.0 innings. It was the longest start by a Storm Chasers' starter this season and the first quality start for a Chasers starter. **C Sebastian Rivero** powered the offense, finishing the game 3-for-4 with a triple, home run, and three RBIs. It was his second consecutive game with a home run and Omaha's season-best fifth straight game with a homer. **OF Edward Olivares** also had a three-hit game, going 3-for-4 with two RBIs. **SS Adalberto Mondesi** went 1-for-5 with two stolen bases and **3B Hunter Dozier** went 1-for-5 with a double and an RBI in rehab assignments. **RHP Grant Gavin** and **LHP Gabe Speier** combined for three perfect innings of relief and helped Omaha record a season-high 16 strikeouts.

REUNION IN DES MOINES: Former Chasers **INF Adalberto Mondesi** and **INF Hunter Dozier** have joined Omaha for rehab assignments. Mondesi (right oblique strain) played his first game for Omaha since 2019 on Friday, going 1-for-4 with an opposite-field single and a strikeout. Dozier was placed on the 7-day Injured List on May 14 following a collision with Chicago (AL) first baseman José Abreu that resulted in Dozier leaving the game with a quad contusion and neck discomfort. Dozier last played for Omaha in 2018, playing 35 games and batting .254 with one home run before being recalled by Kansas City. Saturday marked the first time since May 8, 2018 (an 8-4 loss to Iowa at Werner Park) that both Mondesi and Dozier were in the lineup at the same time for Omaha.

OUTSTANDING OLIVARES: After an 0-for-5 game on Friday ended his 14-game on-base streak to begin the season, **OF Edward Olivares** began a new streak with a 3-for-4 performance on Saturday. Olivares began the season with a nine-game hitting streak and has hit safely in 13 of 16 games while also reaching safely in 15 of 16 games. The 25-year-old ranks in the top 15 in Triple-A East in batting average (.375, T-5th), on-base percentage (.467, 6th), slugging percentage (.641, 11th), hits (24, T-4th), runs scored (15, 2nd), home runs (4, T-10th), RBIs (14, T-7th), walks (10, T-10th), and stolen bases (5, T-5th). Olivares is also fifth in the league with a 196 wRC+.

PROSPECT-STUDDERED ROTATION: With the addition of **LHP Daniel Lynch** after he was optioned last weekend, each member of Omaha's starting rotation is one of the Kansas City Royals top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. Lynch, who makes his Omaha debut on Wednesday, is the No. 2 prospect in the Royals organization, while **RHP Jackson Kowar** is No. 4, **RHP Carlos Hernández** is No. 15, **RHP Ronald Bolaños** is No. 18, and **RHP Scott Blewett** is No. 25. Lynch (No. 21) and Kowar (No. 84) are also both top-100 prospects. Overall, the Storm Chasers roster boasts eight of the Royals' top 30 prospects with the inclusion of position players **OF Kyle Isbel** (6), **OF Edward Olivares** (19), and **INF Lucius Fox** (22).

FINALLY, 500: With last night's win, Omaha claimed its 500th all-time win over Iowa dating back to 1969, the first season for both franchises. Omaha had been stuck on 499 wins since May 24, 2019 and had lost seven straight games to Iowa until Saturday. Omaha now holds a 500-472 (.514) all-time record against Iowa.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Carlos Hernández** makes his fourth start of the season. Last time out, Hernández struck out a season-high seven batters while allowing three runs on four hits (including two home runs) with two walks in an 8-3 win over Columbus. The right-hander currently has 18 strikeouts and four walks in 14.0 innings and has completed 5.0 innings with three or fewer runs allowed in each of his last two starts after surrendering a career-high eight runs (six earned) in his first start on May 5 vs. St. Paul. Hernández is currently fifth in Triple-A East and first in the Midwest Division in Swinging Strike Percentage at 15.8%

FOR IOWA: **RHP Alec Mills** makes a rehab start for Iowa after he was placed on the 10-day Injured List with a lower back strain on May 14. He began the season with Chicago (NL), posting a 5.96 ERA in 12 games (one start) with 13 strikeouts and eight walks in 22.2 innings. A former Storm Chaser, Mills pitched for Omaha in 2016, recording a 4.19 ERA in 12 games (11 starts). He's faced Omaha three times, all in 2019 and most recently on June 26, 2019, in a 5-4 win for Iowa. In starts against Omaha, Mills has a 6.00 ERA (18.0 IP) with 18 strikeouts and three walks. The right-hander recorded a 4.88 ERA with 46 strikeouts and 19 walks for Chicago (NL) in 11 starts in 2020, including throwing a no-hitter—the 16th in Cubs' history—on Sept. 13, 2020 against Milwaukee.

COMING UP: Following this week's series against Iowa, Omaha returns to Werner Park for a 12-game homestand featuring a six-game series against the first-place Indianapolis Indians (PIT) and a six-game series against the Iowa Cubs. The Chasers are 4-2 at home this season after beginning the year with a series win over St. Paul.
