NOTES AND NUGGETS

GOOD TIMES, BAD TIMES

- 2026 has been a roller coaster ride for Omaha, with up and down stretches.
- Of 14 series played this season, Omaha has won 5, lost 6 and split 3 ... the Storm Chasers have a 7-6 record over their last 13 games, having split their last 2 series.
 - Omaha went 13-12 in April ... with a 13-14 record in May and 10-15 in June, the Chasers had back-to-back losing months for the first time since June/July 2025.

COMEBACK KIDS

- The Chasers have 22 comeback wins and have blown a lead in 24 losses this year.
- 22 comeback wins are tied for the 5th-most in the International League, tied 7th in Triple-A ... 24 blown leads are the 4th-most in the league, 6th in Triple-A.
 - The Storm Chasers have led at some point in 12 of their last 20 losses, including 4 games where the team led for at least half the game and 2 losses where Omaha had a 6+ run lead at some point in the game.
 - In the last 47 games (since May 9), Omaha is 22-25 ... the Chasers have trailed at some point in 15 of 22 wins and led at some point in 14 of 25 losses, meaning 29 of Omaha's last 47 games (62%) have been a comeback win for one of the teams ... in this stretch, 33 of 47 games (70%) have been decided by 3 runs or less.

JUNE BUGS

- Individually, there were many key offensive contributors in the month of June.
- Since rejoining Omaha June 18, **Brandon Drury** has reached base in all 9 games, batting .382 (13-for-34) with 4 doubles, 3 homers and 10 RBI for a 1.227 OPS.
 - Abraham Toro** had hits in 18 of his 23 games in June, batting .326 (29-for-89) with 6 doubles, 3 triples, 6 homers and 24 RBI for a 1.041 OPS ... his 59 total bases last month ranked 4th-most in the International League, while tied 4th in RBI.
 - Matthew Lugo** was acquired by the Royals on June 2 and in his first 21 games with Omaha, hit .325 (26-for-80) with 7 doubles, 7 homers and 21 RBI for a 1.035 OPS in June ... his 54 total bases last month ranked tied 5th-most in the IL.
 - Brett Squires** hit .291 (23-for-79) in the month of June, with an .850 OPS ... he enters today's game on a career-best 13-game hitting streak since June 16, Omaha's longest of the year and tied for the 2nd-longest active in the IL, a stretch where he is batting .373 (19-for-51) with 6 XBH, 10 RBI and a 1.029 OPS.

HONEST ABE

- Abraham Toro** started the season slow, but has been one of the International League's best hitters since mid-May
- Since May 12, Toro has a .331 average (45-for-136) ... he ranks 2nd in the IL in OPS (1.025), 2nd in SLG (.625) and tied 4th in AVG ... his 36 RBI over 37 games since May 12 are the 3rd-most in the league.
 - From March 27 to May 10, Toro hit .189 (21-for-111) with a .650 OPS and hits in 16 of 33 games ... since May 12, Toro has hits in 28 of 37 games, with 4+ hits in 3 games.

CROSS ME UP

- Gavin Cross** had one of the league's slowest start to the season, but has heated up with the weather as the season has gone on.
- Over his first 36 games (March 27 to May 15), Cross hit just .128 (15-for-117) with 3 XBH and 6 RBI, with 1 multi-hit game ... but in his last 35 games (since May 16), he's hitting .285 (35-for-123), with 9 XBH and 13 RBI, with 10 multi-hit games.

BARLOW'S BACK

- Since 2021, **Scott Barlow** is the 7th player to play for Omaha, leave the organization and return to appear in a game for the Storm Chasers.
- Barlow joins a group that includes **Zack Greinke** (2004 & 2022), **Taylor Clarke** (2022 & 2026 Omaha), **Jose Cuas** (2022-23, 2026), **Jonathan Heasley** (2022-23 2025), **Dan Altavilla** (2024, 2026) and **Rudy Martin Jr.** (2019, 2021 & 2025-26).
 - Barlow teams up with **Henry Williams**, who he was traded to the Padres for in August 2023 ... this is the 3rd instance since the 2025 season of Storm Chaser players being teammates after being traded for each other, joining **Taylor Clarke** in 2025 (traded from Kansas City to Milwaukee for **Cam Devanney** and **Ryan Brady** in December 2023) and **John Gant** in 2025 (traded from St. Louis to Minnesota for **Evan Sisk** in July 2021).

- ❑ Mitch Spence is making his **12th start with the Storm Chasers** this year and his **15th overall appearance** of the season.
- ❑ Playing his **7th professional season** this year ... the Royals are his 3rd Major League organization, after being drafted by the Yankees and spending the last two years with the Athletics.
- ❑ This is Spence's 2nd career appearance against Indianapolis ... it is his 8th appearance against the Pirates and their affiliates, having pitched against every level of their system, from High-A to the Majors.

A NEW SPENCE OF PURPOSE

- 🚩 **QUALITY CONTROL:** Spence threw consecutive quality starts in May, accounting for 2 of Omaha's 6 this season ... his outing on May 7 @ Indianapolis (PIT) was the team's first quality start of the season ... has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 6 of 11 Triple-A starts with a 3.41 ERA (13 ER in 34.1 IP) in those 6 outings.
- 🚩 **START ME UP:** Spence spent **2021-2023** almost exclusively as a starter in the Yankees' Minor League system before bouncing between roles in the A's organization ... he began both **2024** and **2025** in Oakland's bullpen before transitioning to the rotation each June.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, JUNE 26 @ CHICAGO (AL)

- ♣ Made his 3rd appearance for the Royals, his 2nd out of the bullpen ... took over for Steven Cruz with one on and one out in the bottom of the 2nd inning ... put away both batters he faced to finish the 2nd inning ... returned for the 3rd inning and allowed 10 runs on a 3-run home run, RBI single, 2-run single, 3-run home run and RBI double ... Beck Way relieved him with two outs and a runner on 2nd.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✦ Was designated for assignment by the Athletics on February 10 and traded to Kansas City on February 12 in exchange for RHP A.J. Causey.
- ✦ Worked back-to-back quality starts for the Storm Chasers on May 7 and May 15, allowing 6 hits and 4 walks over 12.2 innings (0.79 WHIP) between the two games.
- ✦ Has made 3 MLB appearances over 3 stints with Kansas City: April 9 to 19, June 15 to 16 and June 26 to 27.

CAREER NOTES

2025

- Spent much of the year in the Major Leagues with the Athletics, splitting time as a starter and reliever ... made the A's Opening Day roster for the second straight year and opened the season as a reliever, making 22 relief appearances with a 4.38 ERA (19 ER in 39.0 IP) and 37 strikeouts before June 2.
- Made his first relief start of the year June 5 and worked a 1.20 ERA (2 ER in 15.0 IP) in his first three games as a starter ... optioned to Triple-A Las Vegas on July 10 and pitched in 8 games (7 starts) before the Athletics recalled him on September 10 for the remainder of the season.

CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Was the 1st overall pick by the Athletics in the Rule 5 Draft on December 6, **2023**, spent all of **2024** in the Major Leagues with Oakland and posted a 4.58 ERA (77 ER in 151.1 IP) with an 8-10 record and 126 strikeouts to 44 walks (2.86 K/BB) across 35 games (24 starts).
- Pitched part of **2022** and all **2023** in with the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders (AAA) in the Yankees organization, producing an 11-10 record with a 4.33 ERA (103 ER in 214.1 IP) and 201 strikeouts to 69 walks (2.91 K/BB) across 39 Triple-A starts.
- In **2023**, led the minors with 163.0 innings ... also ranked 3rd in MiLB in pitches (2,564) and tied for 3rd in starts (29) ... led the International League in innings and starts and ranked 2nd in strikeouts (153).
- Opened **2022** with the Somerset Patriots (AA) and pitched in 17 games (15 starts) before his promotion to Triple-A on August 2 ... spent all of **2021** with the Hudson Valley Renegades (A+) and put up a 3.94 ERA (46 ER in 105.0 IP) with 118 strikeouts to 37 walks (3.19 K/BB) in 23 games (20 starts) at High-A.
- Made his professional debut in **2019** with the Pulaski Yankees (R) after New York drafted him in the 10th round of the 2019 MLB Draft ... pitched exclusively out of the bullpen and earned 4 saves.

-  Pitched 3 seasons (**2017-19**) for the University of South Carolina-Aiken (Peach Belt Conference, D2) ... worked a career 17-10 record with a 3.83 ERA (86 ER in 202.0 IP) and 243 strikeouts (10.8 K/9) for the Pacers ... in **2018**, struck out 117 batters in 92.0 innings (11.4 K/9) with a 3.03 ERA (31 ER in 92.0 IP).
-  Is the all-time saves and career ERA leader at Green Hope High School (NC).
