TODAY'S HEADLINES

Under Gardenhire (since '21)... 277-254 LAST TIME OUT: The lowa Cubs scored five runs in the first innings against Zebby Matthews, beating the Saints 5-1 on Friday. After allowing a five hits, including a grand slam, in the first inning, Matthews settled in by scattering five more hits across 5.0 innings, allowing only two more to reach base. The Saints were no-hit into the sixth inning until Dalton Shuffield singled into right field to break up the no-hitter. DaShawn Keirsey Jr. followed with a double and Edouard Julien singled Shuffield home to break up the shutout. Justin Topa allowed a hit and a walk in his inning of Major League rehab. Jeff Brigham and Nick Wittgren worked clean innings to finish the game clean innings to finish the game.

INTO THE CUBS DEN: Louie Varland will make his fifth career start against lowa tonight, going 3-0 in his previous four. Varland has allowed just two earned runs over 21.0 innings. In his four career outings against lowa, Varland has walked just six and struck out 31 for a 5.17 K/BB ratio, his best against any opponent he has made at least three appearances

September 0-0 franchise history. The Saints are one of three IL teams to turn four double plays in multiple games this season (Jacksonville, 3x and Memphis, 2x).

> ON THE RUN: The Saints have stolen a base in their last 11 games dating back to July 21, their second-longest streak of the season and the second-longest streak in franchise history. In that stretch, the Saints have gone 19-for-22 in stolen base attempts. Their longest streak of the season is a franchise-record 13 games, from May 12-26. The Saints have been successful in 83.5% of their attempts this season, the third-highest mark in Triple-A and the 14th-best among full-season minor league teams.

JULIEN JUMPING ON BASE: Edouard Julien has reached base in 29 consecutive games, riding the Saints' longest on-base streak this season. It is the second-longest franchise history trailing only Jake Cave's 49-game streak in 2022. It is the fourth-longest streak in the International League this season and the second-longest active streak (Buddy Kennedy - 45G). During Julien's 29-game streak, he is hitting .272/.457/.417 (.874 OPS).

WILLIAMS RECORD WATCH: Chris Williams hit his 12th home run of the season on July 21 and the 43rd of his Saints career. He has tied Mark Contreras for the career franchise lead at 43 long balls. His 43 home runs since his Triple-A debut on July 17, 2022 are tied for the 10th-most in the International League.

\$ Since the start of July, Williams has clubbed seven home runs, tied for the fourth-most in the International League. He also ranks among league leaders in that time with his 19 runs (T-2nd), 12 extra-base hits (T-6th) and his .630 slugging percentage (6th)

ELECTRIC EELES: Since joining the Saints on July 4, he has constantly found ways to get on base, sporting a .395 on-base percentage in Triple-A. He's reached base in 18 of the 21 games he's played in, drawing 13 walks and been hit by a pitch four times. He is sixth among full-season

LAST APPEARANCE: 7/28 v OMA...made 14th start of the season and second of the series against Omaha...allowed three runs on four hits, two home runs, walking four and striking out six over 5.0 innings...retired eight of the first nine batters faced, allowing a solo home run to Tyler Gentry to lead off the second inning...allowed a two-out double in the third and a leadoff single in the fourth inning...issued three walks in the fifth inning and a two-run homer to Nate Eaton...took eighth loss in 9-1 Saints defeat.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 7/23 v OMA...made 13th start of the season with St. Paul, throwing 6.0 shutout innings, allowing two hits, walking one and striking out seven...retired first seven batters of the game...allowed a single in the fourth and fifth innings...first single allowed was an infield single up the middle...extends scoreless streak to 11.2 innings...primarily threw four-seam fastball, using it 46% of the time...got nine whiffs...left the game with a 1-0 lead, which the Saints carried into the eighth...did not factor into the decision in a 3-1 Saints loss

SOMEONE IS FLIPPING OVER A CHECKERS BOARD: During the 2023 offseason, Louie got engaged to Maddie Hentges, a former lacrosse player at Concordia-St. Paul (2017-20), the same school as Varland. Maddies brother, Sam, was a star forward on the Totino-Grace HS hockey team, played at St. Cloud State, and was a Minnesota Wild draft pick. Maddies Dad, Mark, was a Hobie Baker Award finalist in 1980 at St. Thomas, a 2x All-American (1980 & 81) and played in the Montreal Canadiens organization.

NOTHING TO RANT(Z) ABOUT X 2: Make it back-to-back years in which Varland was honored with the Jim Rantz Minnesota Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year Award. In 2021 he received it after going 10-4 with a 2.10 ERAin 20 games (18 starts) between Low-A Fort Myers and High-A Cedar Rapids. In 103.0 innings pitched he fanned 142 while opponents hit .214 against him. In 2022, between Double-A Wichita and Triple-A St. Paul, he went 8-5, 3.06 (126.1 IP, 43 ER) with 42 walks and 146 strikeouts as opponents hit .242 against him across 24 games (23) starts. He also went 1-2, 3.81 ERA (26.0 IP, 11 ER) with six walks, 21 strikeouts, and a .261 opponents batting average in five starts.

WHO SAYS YOU CAN'T GO HOME: With the transfer from Double-A to Triple-A, on August 8, 2022, Variand returned home. He became the first player from St. Paul to play for the Saints since the team became a Triple-Afranchise. Some of the players from the Independent days that were from St. Paul that played for the Saints include Jack Morris, Ryan Schlosser, Tim Thomas (1995), Chris Schwab, Steve Butler, Adam Larson, Brian Whinnery, Zach Peterson, Reid Mahon, Matt Schuld, Joe Bonfe, Jack Goihl, and Jake Esch.

HULKAMANIA: While in high school at North St. Paul High School, Varland was on the wrestling team. He was a two-time MSHSL State Tournament wrestler, two-time MVP, Most Improved, Rookie of the Year, two-time section runner up and four-time captain of the wrestling team.

GET ON THE BUS, GUS: Louie's brother, Gus, is 13 months older than him. They played together at North St. Paul High School and Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was selected in the 14th round by the Oakland Athletics in 2018 out of Concordia, St. Paul. Gus was then traded to the Dodgers along with 3B Sheldon Neuse in exchange for LHP Adam Kolarek and RF Cody Thomas on February 12, 2021. He was claimed in the Minor League phase of the Rule 5 draft by the Milwaukee Brewers from the L.A. Dodgers on December 7, 2022

NOT MY BROTHERS KEEPER: - Louie faced off against his brother Gus in 2022 as the Wind Surge took on the Tulsa Drillers on May 6, 2022 in Wichita. It's the first time brothers started against each other in the Minors since at least the 2000s. Louie went 5.0 IP allowed two runs on four hits while walking two and striking out six. His brother went 3.0 IP allowing six runs on eight hits while walking two and striking out two in a 7-2 Wichita victory in game one of a doubleheader.

BROTHERLY LOVE: On June 15, 2022 the Wind Surge and Drillers met again in a doubleheader in Wichita. This time, the brothers pitched opposite ends of the doubleheader and each got a victory. Louie won Game 1 allowing two runs across 6.0 innings while walking one and striking out four in a 7-4 Wind Surge win. In the second game, Gus pitched 2.0 shutout innings of relief allowing one hit and striking out four in a 4-3 Drillers victory.

RUNS IN THE FAMILY: While Louie has more than made a name for himself, he might not even be the most athletic person in his family. His Aunt's Denise and Sue were legendary softball pitchers at North St. Paul High School.
