The Round Rock Express and Albuquerque Isotopes are ready to tee up the series finale at Dell Diamond on Sunday afternon. Round Rock RHP Robert Dugger is scheduled to make the start against Isotopes RHP Peter Lambert. First pitch is scheduled for 1:05 p.m.

WIN NUMBER ONE

The Express bounced back following their Opening Night loss and took home a 6-1 win over the Albuquerque Isotopes on Saturday evening. In the first frame, C Sandy León grounded into a double play, but he scored SS Jonathan Ornelas from third base in the process and Round Rock led 1-0. The E-Train hung three runs on the Isotopes in the fourth inning. 3B Dio Arias delivered with a single to left that scored one run. With the bases juiced, CF J.P Martinez was hit by a pitch to score another run and a fielder's choice for Ornelas brought the lead to 4-0. Albuquerque's lone run came in the seventh when a single from SS Connor Kaiser scored DH Jimmy Herron and the Isotopes trailed 4-1. In the eighth, with LF Clint Frazier and 1B Yoshi Tsutsugo aboard, Martinez singled to add two more RBI and push the Express advantage to 6-1. RHP Yerry Rodriguez slammed the door with a scoreless ninth inning.

TEACH ME HOW TO DUGGER

RHP Robert Duggger gets the baseball for Round Rock on Sunday night in his Express debut. The righty has appeared in 27 Major League games for the Miami Marlins, Seattle Mariners, Tampa Bay Rays and Cincinnati Reds.

BRADFORD BRINGS IT

Express LHP Cody Bradford put together a 5.2-inning performance and allowed only two hits with six strikeouts on his way to a win in his first Triple-A start yesterday. Despite allowing two men to reach base in both the first and second inning, the southpaw worked out of trouble and kept Albuquerque off the board. Bradford uncharacteristically issued two walks. The last time the lefty issued more than two walks came in a start on July 26, 2022 for Double-A Frisco.

BULLPEN SHUTS IT DOWN

The combination of RHP Chase Lee, LHP Jake Latz and RHP Yerry Rodriguez brought home Round Rock's first win of the season yesterday. Lee tossed 1.1 innings and allowed one run on two hits with two strikeouts. LHP Jake Latz threw a scoreless eighth inning as he struck out the side and RHP Yerry Rodriguez allowed a hit in the ninth inning but struck out two to close out the game. The previous night, Round Rock's bullpen allowed six runs over 5.1 frames.

J.P. JUST DRIVES IN RUNS

CF J.P. Martinez drove home three runs in a 1-for-3 night. After spending the final 41 games of 2022 with Round Rock, the lefty batted .199 (28-141) with 53 strikeouts. So far in 2023, Martinez is 3-for-7 with four RBI and a stolen base.

IT'S CROWDED AND WE LIKE IT

For the second consecutive night, Dell Diamond held over 10,000 fans. After Friday's monster crowd of 11,217, Saturday didn't disapoint with 10,047 fans in attendance. It was the first time the Express have had back-to-back crowds of more than 10,000 since August 16-17, 2019. Round Rock currently leads all Triple-A clubs in attendance to open the season (21,264).

UPDATE FROM ARLINGTON

The Texas Rangers are 2-0 to open the season and former Round Rock Express star OF Josh Smith has been the starting left fielder both nights. Smith is 1-for-4 with two walks and three runs scored.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
