SIX-RUN SIXTH POWERS JACKSONVILLE TO 7-2 WIN

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp rode a six-run, seven hit seventh inning to a 7-2 win over the Memphis Redbirds Wednesday night . Trailing 2-1, Jacksonville (56-58, 21-18) blew the game open in the sixth, sending 10 men to the plate and scoring six runs on seven hits. Memphis (57-59, 19-22) took the initial lead in the top of the third before the Jumbo Shrimp evened the game with a run in the bottom of the fourth. Nick Gordon walked and Will Banfield singled. With two outs, Javier Sanoja doubled home Gordon. The Redbirds took their last lead with a run in the top of the fifth inning.

AGUSTÍN THE GREAT

Agustín Ramírez had a slow start to 2024 in the New York Yankees organization. In 29 games with Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, he slashed (.224/.328/.364/.692) with 23 strikeouts. Since joining the Marlins organization on July 26, he's 14-for-46 (.304/.396/.522/.918) with two home runs, eight RBIs and four multi-hit games. Despite his short time with Jacksonville, Ramírez has one of the lower swinging strike rates on the team at 7.7% while logging one of the higher walk rates (11.3%).

AIN'T NO SUNSHINE

With last night's 7-2 win over Memphis, Jacksonville has won their 31st game in their last 54 contests. In that time span, the Jumbo Shrimp have struggled, posting the eighth-lowest OPS in Triple-A (.747) while drawing the second-fewest walks (177). Of those 54 contests, 37 have been within three runs or fewer with Jacksonville winning 22 (.595). Despite outscoring opponents, 165-142 during this run, the Jumbo Shrimp are only scoring 3.1 runs/G, while allowing 2.6 runs/G.

WHAT IS (G)LOVE?

Last week, Jacksonville committed seven errors in their six-game set against Toledo, including back-to-back contests with three errors. In 2024, the Jumbo Shrimp have been pretty handy with the glove, committing 75 errors (T-sixth fewest) in Triple-A. However, since 8/1, they have seen their fielding percentage drop to the worst in Triple-A (.964) while committing 13 errors in their last 11 games, tied for the fourth-most errors in both the IL and PCL. After committing just 5 errors in their previous 10 games.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 26-32 (.448) record. Jacksonville has scored only 247 runs at home (4.3 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring more than a half-run more per game on the road, totaling 273 (4.9 per game). Meanwhile, on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered only 251 runs (4.5 per game), the third-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the 12th-fewest runs of any team at home (4.8 per game). On the year, the Jumbo Shrimp are 31-26 on the road. Jacksonville hasn't had a winning record at 121 Financial Ballpark since 2021 & 2022 where they went (36-29) & (38-37) respectively.

SWIPER NO SWIPING!

Through the first 97 games of the 2024 season, Jacksonville mustered just 49 stolen bases (second-fewest in Triple-A). Since the trade deadline on July 26, the Jumbo Shrimp still haven't logged a ton of stolen bases, just nine. (T-fifth fewest in Triple-A). However, their percentage on attempts has jumped astronomically. During this 17-game stretch, Jacksonville has only been nabbed stealing a base once in 10 attempts (90.0%) vs. 73.1% through the first 97 games of the season.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 70 of his last 81 games, notching 30 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 105-for-322 (.326/.390/.491/.881) with 25 doubles, five triples, six home runs, 49 RBIs, 35 walks and 44 runs scored. On the season, Sanoja ranks third in batting average (.307), third in doubles (27), T-1stin triples (6), T-15th in XBH (39), T-16th in total bases (168) and fifth in hits (111).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville has had great success against Memphis in 2024, posting a slash line of .280/.346/.453/.799. Their .799 OPS is the fourth-best among opponents this season (.819 vs. NSH, .806 vs. TOL, .805 vs. NOR)...Jumbo Shrimp pitchers have posted a 3.53 ERA vs. Redbirds hitters (2nd-lowest ERA vs. OPP)

ABOUT ADAM

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

2023 SEASON

-In 174 plate appearances, Mazur held right-handed hitters to a .208/.236/.286/.522 line compared to a .298/.332/.418/.750 batting line in 220 plate appearances for left-handed hitters.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-As a senior at Woodbury High School, Mazur compiled a 0.58 ERA with 112 strikeouts and only 12 walks in 72.1 innings. He also played shortstop, batting .377 with five doubles, one home run and 40 RBIs.
