LAST TIME OUT

After walking 14 times, the Pelicans took down the Fayetteville Woodpeckers 9-7 on Friday night for their second win in a row. The 14 walks drawn were the most in a game for the Pelicans since September 1st, 2015 against Potomac when they walked 16 times. SS Cristian Hernandez walked twice and added an RBI single. RF Andy Garriola continued his hot week with an RBI single, his seventh single of the series. RHP Nico Zeglin got the win with two unearned runs and four strikeouts in his three innings. Starter RHP Nazier Mule stretched four innings with five strikeouts for his longest outing of his career.

THE SILVER SEASON

The Pelicans will be celebrating their 25th season in 2024. After the departure of the Myrtle Beach Hurricanes in 1992, the Pelicans were established in 1999 following the relocation of the Durham Bulls to Myrtle Beach. During their 25 seasons, the Pelicans have won four Carolina League titles in 1999, 2000, 2015, and 2016. Myrtle Beach has been affiliated with three teams in their 25 seasons, including the Atlanta Braves (1999-2010), Texas Rangers (2011-2014), and the Chicago Cubs (2015-pres-

PELICANS POWER

After pacing the league last year with 104 home runs, the Pelicans are once again leading the league this year with 56 on the season. After hitting 12 home runs last year to place second on the team, **OF Andy Garriola** currently leads the league with 14, and is fourth in Pelicans' franchise history with 26 career home runs. In his first year in Myrtle Beach, **OF Alfonsin Rosario** ranks second with nine homers, six of those being hit on the road. Just 21 of the 56 home runs hit by the Pelicans have been hit in Myrtle Beach, with 35 being hit in road ballparks. The 56 home runs have been hit by 16 different players.

Currently, the Pelicans roster features three of the Cubs' top 30 prospects by MLB Pipeline. Interestingly, the top two prospects are brothers as INF Cristian Hernandez and his younger brother INF Alexis Hernandez stand as the No. 17 and No. 18 Cubs prospects, respectively. 20-year-old Cristian led the Pelicans in games played last year with 106, hitting .223 with four home runs while splitting time between shortstop and second base. 19-year-old Alexis hit .315 across 37 games in the Arizona Complex League last season while playing second, third, and shortstop. No. 28 Cubs prospect RHP Nazier Mulé was added to the Pelicans' roster in late May after

missing all of 2023 with Tommy John surgery. He was the Cubs' fourth-round pick in 2022 out of high school.

A familar face will be leading the Pelicans in 2024 as Buddy Bailey returns to manage the club for his seventh year in Myrtle Beach. Bailey previously led the Pelicans from 2016-18 and 2021-23, and will be coaching his 18th season in the Cubs organization. During his Pelicans tenure, Bailey has recorded 460 wins, the most in franchise history. He has also guided the Birds to four half-season Southern Division Championship titles, one Southern Division Championship title, and the Carolina League Championship in 2016. In 2017, Bailey became just the 11th minor league manager to reach the 2,000 win plateau- he currently sits with 2,387. Bailey currently trails Mike Kelley (managed from 1901-1931) by 3 for third-place all time on the MiLB managers wins list. 2024 will be his 36th season as a minor league manager.

PELICAN POINTS

The Pelicans will play nine home games in nine days against two different teams, the first being a six-game set against the Fayetteville Woodpeckers. The Birds began the season with a three-game weekend series against Fayetteville, dropping two of the three games.

Through the first 73 games, the Pelicans lead all of Minor League Baseball with 124 wild pitches

Pelicans' INF Cristian Hernandez is currently fifth in the Carolina League with 67 hits and seventh in batting average

Pelicans' OF Andy Garriola is currently the Carolina League leader with 14 HR and is second with 48 RBI. He is currently the leader with 27 extra-base hits.

OF Jacob Wetzel set the franchise RBI record on June 1st with a two-run triple, he currently stands at 123. He set the franchise record with his 128th career walk on 6/6 at Augusta. The third-year Pelican also holds the franchise record in runs scored at 149.

The Pelicans have won four Carolina League championships in team history, with the last one coming in 2016. The Birds have also won in 1999, 2000, and 2015.
