**PORTLAND SWEEP:** Division-leading Portland scored late twice to sweep the Fisher Cats 6-4 and 1-0 in a doubleheader yesterday at Hadlock Field. Samad Taylor homered in the top of the seventh inning after Portland had plated four in the bottom of the sixth. But Victor Santos, making his first start for the Sea Dogs since being acquired in a deal with the Phillies, went the distance for the win. Casey Lawrence worked into the sixth inning and left with the game tied, but Portland rallied against Kyle Johnston. In the nightcap, the game's only run came across in the bottom of the fifth inning on a wild pitch and error. New Hampshire outhit Portland in both games, but couldn't extend a four-game win streak.

**JULY:** The Fisher Cats finished the month 12-13, spending all but one day in July in third place behind Somerset and Portland. New Hampshire hit .257 for the month with 16 homers and 112 runs scored. The team ERA was 4.20 with 109 runs allowed.

**TRADE DEADLINE:** Two Fisher Cats were involved in a deadline deal between the Blue Jays and Twins. The Blue Jays traded 2020 overall #5 pick Austin Martin and RHP Simeon Woods Richardson for Jose Berrios. Martin slashed .281/.424/.383 in 55 games for the Fisher Cats. Woods Richardson, who Toronto had acquired from the Mets in the Marcus Stroman deal, is currently with the US Olympic team in Tokyo. He went 2-4 with a 5.76 ERA in 11 starts for New Hampshire. Woods Richardson impressed with 67 strikeouts in just 45.1 IP. The pair have been added to the roster of Double-A Wichita Wind Surge.

**UP NEXT:** The Fisher Cats will return to Delta Dental Stadium for a six-game set against the Hartford Yard Goats (Colorado Rockies) starting Tuesday. New Hampshire won the last series between the teams July 13-18 at Dunkin Donuts Park. A pair of fireworks shows are planned Thursday and Saturday nights.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** August 1, 2010—The Fisher Cats handled Trenton 10-4 in New Jersey to win the series 3-1. Kyle Drabek allowed one earned run in six innings for his eleventh win. Although there were no home runs, seven different Fisher Cats drove in runs, including two each for Darin Mastroianni and David Cooper.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays blanked Kansas City 4-0 and will play for the sweep today. Alek Manoah allowed two hits over seven innings in a strong effort for the Jays...Triple-A Buffalo lost to Chris Sale and the Woo Sox 4-2 at Polar Park...Spokane 4 Vancouver 0, Bradenton won 13-10 over Dunedin, and FCL Jays won 8-3 over the Tigers...and the Dominican Jays were edged 9-8 by the Tigers.

## STARTERS:

Maximo Castillo can become the second pitcher in Double-A Northeast with eight wins if he can pick up a victory today in his sixth start against Portland. Three of his wins have come against the Sea Dogs, including July 3 in a 3-0 win in the first game of a doubleheader at Delta Dental Stadium.

Enmanuel DeJesus makes his 13<sup>th</sup> appearance and eighth start for Portland. In his previous two starts against the Fisher Cats he's had no decision. 24-year old rejoins Portland after making one start July 25 for Triple-A Worcester against Lehigh Valley. Allowed two runs in five innings in a 3-0 loss.
