Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,045-1,926. The 2,045 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.

The second half of the current 12-game, 13-day road trip continues tonight as the Sounds visit Charlotte. The team does not return to First Horizon Park until Tuesday, June 8 when the Indianapolis Indians come to town for a six-game series. Tuesday, June 8 is the first Tito's Tail Waggin' Tuesday of the season and it's Peanut Free Night presented by Allergy, Asthma and Sinus Center.
