JUMBO SHRIMP OPEN 2021 SEASON

For the first time since August 31, 2019, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp are in back in action when they open the 2021 season at 7:05 p.m. on Tuesday against the Norfolk Tides from 121 Financial Ballpark. The Jumbo Shrimp open the campaign with a six-game series against the Tides. Jacksonville will then head out for a 12-game road trip to play Durham in a six-game set, followed by six games at Norfolk. The Jumbo Shrimp close the season's first month by hosting Durham from May 25-30. Thanks to a reshuffling of the minor leagues following the cancelation of the 2020 season, the Jumbo Shrimp return as a Triple-A team meaning Jacksonville will field a club at Minor League Baseball's highest level for the first time since 1968.

LONG TIME, NO SEE

When the Jumbo Shrimp take the field Tuesday to kick off the 2021 season, it will mark the end of the longest wait for baseball for Jacksonville since 1970. After the 1968 Jacksonville Suns won the International League title, the club was moved to Norfolk, Va. Following a 1969 season without professional baseball in Northeast Florida, the Jacksonville Suns returned in 1970 as a Double-A team in the Southern League, Tuesday's contest marks 613 days between baseball for the Jumbo Shrimp, who last played on August 31, 2019. Meanwhile, 121 Financial Ballpark has not hosted a game since August 26, 2019, when the park was named the Baseball Grounds of Jacksonville - a span of 618 days. Coincidentally, Jacksonville beat Mobile - a team that no longer exists - in that August 26, 2019 game, which marks the last victory for the Jumbo Shrimp at the Double-A level.

AN ERA OF UNMATCHED SUCCESS

Though the Jumbo Shrimp now play in the Triple-A East League, Jacksonville fielded a Double-A club in the Southern League from 1970-2019, an era of virtually unequaled success in the city's history. During their 50 seasons in the Southern League, Jacksonville made 20 playoff appearances. winning 13 Division Series', both Southern League records. Jacksonville also won six championships, finishing as the runner-up a league-best eight times. The city's clubs played in a Southern League-record 122 playoff games during this span, compiling a 64-58 (.525) record in the Southern League postseason.

PEDRIQUE TO MANAGE JUMBO SHRIMP IN 2021

Boasting 13 years of minor league managing experience and seven seasons on a major league coaching staff, Al Pedrique will manage the Jumbo Shrimp in 2021. Pedrique enters his first year with the Marlins' organization after spending the previous three years on the Oakland A's major league staff as first base coach (2018) and third base coach (2019-20). His major league coaching experience includes a stint in 2004 with the Arizona Diamondbacks as third base coach and interim manager. Pedrique was also the third base coach for Houston in 2009 before serving as the Astros' bench coach from 2010-11. In addition to his wealth of MLB coaching experience, Pedrique has managed 13 seasons in the minor leagues in the Royals, Diamondbacks and Yankees' organizations.

CHARLOTTE'S (AND NORFOLK/DURHAM'S) WEB

Jacksonville's first foray into Triple-A since 1968 will see the club play only within the Southeast Division in the Triple-A East League. Tuesday's season-opener with the Tides marks the first of 36 contests against Norfolk. The Jumbo Shrimp will also play Durham 36 times and Charlotte 30 times during the 2021 campaign. Thus, an extraordinary 102 of the 120 games (85 percent) the Jumbo Shrimp will play this season come against the Triple-A affiliates of the Baltimore Orioles, Tampa Bay Rays and Chicago White Sox, respectively. Jacksonville's schedule rounds out with trips to Gwinnett and Memphis for six-game series' from June 1-6 and June 29-July 4, respectively. The Jumbo Shrimp will also host Nashville in a six-game set from July 20-25.

MEET THE SHRIMP

The Jumbo Shrimp's 2021 Opening Day roster features an eclectic mix of talented prospects, players who possess major league experience and familiar faces for fans in Northeast Florida. Lewin Díaz (No. 5), Jesús Sánchez (No, 6) and Braxton Garrett (No. 7) represent three of the Miami Marlins' top seven prospects according to MLB Pipeline. Jacksonville also has nine different players on its Opening Day roster with major league experience. There are also nine players who have previously logged time in Jacksonville when the club was Miami's Double-A affiliate. Jacksonville and the Marlins boast a long-standing affiliation that dates back to the 2009 season

ABOUT BRAXTON

-The Miami Marlins' first-round pick in 2016, Garrett made his professional debut in 2017 but lasted just four starts until an injured elbow forced him to undergo Tommy John Surgery. Garrett went under the knife on June 20, 2017 and missed the rest of the 2017 campaign, as well as the entirety of the 2018 season. While rehabbing, however, he roomed with fellow Marlins prospect Jordan Holloway, who had underwent Tommy John Surgery just five days

-Garrett began his high school career at Foley High School in Alabama. However, he moved to Florence when his father, Steve, became the Florence Falcons' head baseball coach.

-Under the tutelage of his father, Garrett was named Alabama's Mr. Baseball as a junior and the state's Gatorade Player of the Year and a first team USA Today All-American as a senior, when he posted a 0.53 ERA with 131 strikeouts in 65.1 innings.

2021 SEASON

2020 SEASON

-Garrett made his major league debut for the Marlins in game two of a doubleheader on September 13, 2020 against the Philadelphia Phillies. He ceded just one run on three hits in five innings, striking out six against two walks.

-The southpaw made one additional MLB start one week later, in the backend of a doubleheader against the Washington Nationals. However, Garrett surrendered five runs, four earned, on five hits and three walks in 2.2 frames

2019 SEASON

-Garrett was promoted to Jacksonville on August 28 from High-A Jupiter. At the time of his promotion, the southpaw ranked fourth in the Florida State League in batting average against (.230), fourth in strikeouts (118) and ninth in ERA (3.34).

-Out of the 109 pitchers in the Florida State League with at least 50.0 innings pitched, Garrett was 11th in xFIP (2.72) and 20th in strikeout percentage (26.9 percent). He had posted the circuit's 10th-lowest fly ball rate (27.8 percent) and 15th-highest ground ball rate (52.7 percent).

2018 SEASON

-Garrett did not pitch during the 2018 season, as he was recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2017 SEASON

-The Florence, Ala., native did not allow more than one run in each of his first three professional starts. However, he surrendered four runs on six hits in 1.2 frames on May 25 against Kannapolis, which turned out to be his final outing before he underwent Tommy John Surgery.

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Had he not decided to turn pro, Garrett had signed to pitch at Vanderbilt University.

He began converting to becoming a pitcher with the Dodgers, continuing that metamorphosis in the Texas Rangers' organization in 2018 and the Texas AirHogs and Sugar Land Skeeters in the independent ball ranks in 2019. Eibner resurfaced to pitch in three big league games for the Marlins in 2020.
