Including today, the Shuckers will play 7 games over 6 days to finish the 1st Half, including a doubleheader on Thursday... The Shuckers enter today a half-game ahead of the Montgomery Biscuits for 1st place in the South Division.

- Entering **TODAY**, the Shuckers magic number is 7, meaning a combination of Shuckers wins and Biscuits losses that equals 7 will clinch the division.
- The Shuckers will finish the half with 7 games in 6 days against the Clingstones... The Biscuits will face the Trash Pandas for 7 games in 6 days... The Blue Wahoos will face the Barons for 6 games.
- The Shuckers are looking to reach the playoffs in 3 consecutive seasons for the first time in franchise history (since 2015)... The Shuckers would be the 1st Brewers Double-A affiliate to achieve the feat since the El Paso Diablos, who reached the Texas League Playoffs in 5 consecutive seasons between 1990 and 1994.

WELCOME TO THE COAST!

OF JOSH ADAMCZEWSKI (No. 7, No. 76 overall) and **3B ANDREW FISCHER** (No. 12) were promoted from High-A Wisconsin on Monday... The pair are set to make their Double-A debuts **TONIGHT**.

- Adamczewski enters today among the Midwest League leaders in average (2nd, .331), on-base percentage (2nd, .464), OPS (3rd, 1.036) and walks (T-9th, 41)... Adamczewski's 162 wRC+ is also the 5th-highest by a Brewers High-A player since 2006.
- Fischer enters today among the Midwest League leaders in home runs (1st, 20), RBI (2nd, 50), OPS (1st, 1.118), extra-base hits (T-1st, 31), on-base percentage (7th, .443) and walks (8th, 45)... His 20 home runs mark the most in a season by a Brewers High-A player since at least 2006... Fischer is also set to become the 1st member of the Brewers 2025 Draft Class to reach Double-A.

STARTING OFF ON THE RIGHT FOOT

On Saturday, **RHP BISHOP LETSON** recorded the 11th start into the 6th inning by a Shuckers pitcher across the last 16 games (since May 29)... Of the 11 starts, 9 have been at least 6.0 innings and 2 have gone into the 7th.

- Across the last 16 starts, the Shuckers rotation holds a 3.23 ERA, the 3rd-best in Double-A... During that span, the Shuckers rotation is also among the Double-A leaders in innings (1st, 83.2), WHIP (2nd, 0.91), opponents average (1st, .160) and strikeouts (2nd, 85).
- In June, the Shuckers pitching staff holds a 3.27 ERA, the 3rd-best in Double-A and the 10-best in Minor League Baseball.

CRUZ-IN' ALONG

RHP STIVEN CRUZ recorded 3.2 perfect innings on Sunday for his 2nd save of the season... It marked the 2nd-longest save by a Double-A pitcher this season and the longest perfect save at the level.

- Entering today, Cruz is among the Double-A leaders (min. 30.0ip) in flyball rate (2nd, 51.3%), strikeout rate (5th, 31.0%), FIP (5th, 3.19), swinging strike rate (11th, 14.3%) and opponents average (12th, .195).

MILLIONS OF PEACHES, PEACHES FOR ME

Today is the 17th of a Southern League record 23 matchups between the Shuckers and Clingstones in the 1st Half... The Shuckers have won the last 3 meetings between the teams, outscoring Columbus 23-8 (+15).

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO is in his 8th season as Shuckers manager and 10th as manager of a Brewers Double-A affiliate... Guerrero needs 23 wins to reach 1,500... His 1,477 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP TANNER GILLIS (2-2, 3.53) makes his 6th start and 13th appearance of the season... Across his last 2 starts, Gillis owns a 2.25 ERA (3er, 12.0ip) with 2 walks and 11 strikeouts... In 3 appearance against the Clingstones this season, Gillis has allowed 4 runs over 9.0 innings with no walks and 9 strikeouts.
