Born in Bakersfield, Calif., Phil Pohl's family moved to Cooperstown when he was nine years old. He starred at Cooperstown Central High School, where he was honored as the 2008 Gatorade New York High School Baseball Player of the Year.

Pohl was drafted by Tampa Bay in the 44th round, becoming Cooperstown Central's first ever draft pick, but decided to attend Clemson University. He served as a two-time team captain for the Tigers, was honored three times as a member of the ACC Academic Honor Roll, and was selected Second Team All-ACC.

Pohl signed as a 28th-round pick of the Athletics in 2012 and played four seasons of Minor League Baseball, rising as high as Triple-A Sacramento. Upon retiring from playing, he rejoined the organization as the A's MLB bullpen catcher, a position he held through the end of the 2021 season. This is his first season managing.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Lake County SS Francisco Lindor enjoyed his finest game against the Lugnuts, going 3-for-5 with a caught stealing in the Nuts' 4-1 victory in Lansing. The future MLB star finished the season hitting .266 (17-for-64) with only two extra-base hits, both doubles, against the Lugnuts, and was just 1-for-4 stealing bases.

2019: The Lugnuts tied a Midwest League record (set by Peoria in Lansing on May 3, 2017), plunking six Lake County Captains – three apiece by Josh Hiatt and Mike Pascoe – in a 10-4 loss at Classic Park.

Personal: Criswell played the trombone, cello and guitar while growing up "but I didn't have any serious musical talent, that's probably why I took the career path I did"... his father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

Hail to the Victors: Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017 while at Portage Central, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt... in all, went 10-4, 2.88, 50 G, 162 1/3 IP, 174 K at Michigan.

The Run to Omaha: A look at how important Jeff was to the Wolverines in their 2019 path to the College World Series National Championship:

NCAA Regional: Struck out nine in 7 2/3 innings in a 10-4 comeback victory over Cincinnati. Michigan went on to eliminate No. 22 Creighton to advance.

NCAA Super Regional: Facing No. 1 UCLA, relieved Karl Kauffman with the potential tying and game-winning runs aboard in the bottom of the ninth and dispatched Jake Pries with a pop-up and Jack Stronach with a strikeout to secure a thrilling 3-2 win. Started the very next day and allowed one earned run in 5 1/3 innings, departing with a 3-2 lead, only to see the Bruins win 5-4 in 12 innings. Michigan went on to eliminate UCLA in Game 3, advancing.

College World Series: Pitched the final two innings scorelessly, earning the save, in a 5-3 CWS-opening win over No. 8 Texas Tech, striking out Brian Klein with the tying runs aboard to end the game. Earned another save in a rematch with Texas Tech six days later, firing the final three innings scorelessly with six strikeouts to complete a 15-3 romp, sending the Wolverines into the CWS Finals against No. 2 Vanderbilt. Secured the final two outs in Game 1 against the Commodores, a 7-4 UM win. Worked the final five innings in relief, striking out seven, in Michigan's Game 3 series-clinching 8-2 loss to Vandy.

National Pride: Following the 2019 college baseball season, Jeff was invited to pitch for the Team USA Collegiate National Team... recorded yet another crucial save, firing the final three innings against Taiwan in Game 2 of their three-game series... limited opposing batters to a .120 average, best of all pitchers on the team.

Prospecting: Criswell is currently Keith Law's No. 12 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 7 A's pitching prospect and No. 18 overall prospect, and Fangraphs' No. 15 A's prospect... MLB Pipeline's grades: Fastball 60, Curve 50, Slider 55, Change 55, Control 45, writing about him, "Criswell's success as both a starter and reliever at the University of Michigan led to him landing a \$1 million signing bonus from the A's as a second-round pick in the 2020 Draft. After injuries limited him to just 12 innings pitched at High-A in what would have been his first full season with the organization, he did manage to end his year on a high note by returning in time to play in the Arizona Fall League and ranking among the league's top strikeout leaders.... He's been described as Bassitt-ish in reference to Chris Bassitt for similarities in their athletic builds."

2021 Pro Debut: Began 2021 as the highest ranked prospect on the Lugnuts' Opening Day roster: Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 3 A's pitching prospect and No. 14 overall prospect, and Baseball America's No. 14 A's prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too." ... started the fifth game of the Lugnuts season, May 8 vs. Lake County, and tossed two easy scoreless innings, but then spent May 12-August 27 on the Injured List, limiting season... made six appearances, three starts, for Arizona Fall League champion Mesa: 2-1, 6.75 ERA, 22 2/3 IP, 26 H, 17 R/ER, 5 HR, 12 BB, 32 K, 3 HBP, 1 balk, 1.68 WHIP... 12.7 K/9 IP.

2022: Debuted as Lugnuts starter in the third game of the year, April 10 vs. Lake County... departed with the Nuts leading, 3-2... Lansing went on to win, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep.

- April 16 at West Michigan: gave up 1st-inning (two-run) and 3rd-inning (solo) home runs to West Michigan's Jake Holton in suffering his first professional defeat.

Midwest League Pitcher of the Week: started Game 2 of a doubleheader April 30 at Lake County, taking a no-hitter into the 7th inning before allowing a Petey Halpin single; finished with a one-hit shutout in 8-0 Lugnuts win: 68 pitches, 1 H, 1 BB, 6 K.

- May 7 vs. West Michigan: appeared to be on his way to finishing five scoreless innings with a 4-0 lead to his back before serving up a three-run HR to Corey Joyce; that spelled the end, with final line 4 2/3 IP, 6 H, 3 R, 1 BB, 7 K... Lugnuts ran out of pitching after nine innings, using Joshwan Wright on the mound in a 7-7 game in the 10th; West Michigan scored four runs and hung on for an 11-10 win.

- May 12 vs. Dayton: allowed a double to Jose Torres on his first pitch of the game, then walked the third and fourth batters of the game to load the bases, but recovered to strand the bases loaded, setting down the final 14 hitters he faced to complete five scoreless one-hit innings with eight strikeouts... departed with a 2-0 lead, only to see Daniel Martinez blow the lead in a three-batter span in the 6th, allowing home runs to Elly De La Cruz and Alex McGarry... Lugnuts recovered to walk off on Tyler Soderstrom's one-out grand slam in the 9th, 7-3.

- May 18 at Great Lakes: allowed Jorbit Vivas two-run HR in 1st and Eddys Lawrence sac fly in 2nd before blanking Loons in 3rd and 4th... departed after allowing one-out single to Vivas in 5th... issued season high five walks... leading 4-3 in the 7th, bullpen allowed four runs in Lugnuts' 7-6 loss.

- May 24 at Beloit: allowed solo tallies in the 4th (unearned) and 6th, finishing with 5 2/3 IP with 6 K's... outpitched by M.D. Johnson (7 IP, 1 R, 9 K) in 2-1 loss.

- May 31 vs. Cedar Rapids: **struck out 11 Kernels in 5 1/3 innings**, allowing three hits and one run (Anthony Prato solo HR)... 99 pitches, 60 strikes... Lugnuts beat the Kernels, 6-1.

Draft Day: Selected 157th overall in the 5th round, 2020 from the University of Washington (the "Huskies")... scout: Jim Coffman, who also signed Joe DeMers, Jared McDonald and current Oakland A's outfielder Seth Brown... signed for \$400,000... drafted three picks before the end of the draft... one of three of Oakland's five 2020 draft picks on the Lugnugs (1st round - Tyler Soderstrom; 2nd round - Jeff Criswell).

Personal: Born in Seattle... played three years in Little League for, coincidentally, the A's, and still has his old A's baseball cap... younger brother, Josh, is currently a pitcher at Washington, standing 6'3"... uncle, Jake, also played baseball for Washington.

Hometown: Bellevue is the third largest city in the Seattle metropolitan area... "belle vue" in French means "beautiful view"; it's situated across Lake Washington from Seattle... Amazon was founded in Bellevue in Jeff Bezos's garage on July 5, 1994... many companies are headquartered in Bellevue, notably T-Mobile USA, the North American headquarters for Pokémon, QFC, Expedia Group, Coinstar and Eddie Bauer... Russell Wilson and Ciara are currently seeking to sell their house in Bellevue (with amazing tree house) for \$36 million.

Glory Days: Attended Interlake High School... rated by Baseball Northwest as Washington's No. 1 baseball recruit in the Class of 2017... rated by Perfect Game as Washington's No. 4 right-handed pitcher... Interlake's alumni includes John Olerud, Larry Andersen, Jim Mora Jr., and actor Timothy Omundson.

Life as a Huskie: Ascended from setup man to closer to ace starting pitcher from freshman to junior year at Washington... broke the Washington freshman record with 34 relief appearances, tied for second most in school history for a single season; led all freshmen in the Pac-12 in appearances... also led Washington as a freshman in wins (8-2, 4.37, 45 1/3 IP, 2 HR, 28 BB, 32 K)... followed up a sophomore in 2019 with 31 appearances (2.35 ERA, 6 saves, 53 2/3, 3 HR, 22 BB, 65 K)... made four starts as a junior, including 13-K, 6-IP gem vs. Fresno State, before season was shut down (0.79, 22 2/3 IP, 2 ER, 0 HR, 9 BB, Pac-12 leading 38 K)... 15.1 K/9.0-IP ranked 16th in the country... named a 2020 3rd Team All-American by The Collegiate Baseball.

UW in The Show: Notable Huskies in MLB history include Tim Lincecum, Mike Blowers, Jim Colborn, Fred Hutchinson, Jeff Heath, Jake Lamb, Andrew Kittredge, Adam Cimber, Austin Voth, Braden Bishop, Jeff Bringham, Kevin Stocker, and the unforgettable Hunky Shaw.

2021 Professional Debut: Opened season as the Lugnugs' Sunday starter... excelled in pro debut, May 9 vs. Lake County: 4 1/3 IP, 2 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 5 K... followed up five two-hit scoreless innings at Dayton, May 16... season curtailed due to injury, however, after four starts in May and three appearances in June... set Lugnugs franchise single-game record in last appearance, June 20 vs. Great Lakes, allowing four home runs: two apiece by Andy Pages and Deacon Liput in back-to-back innings... made one scoreless appearance in Arizona Complex League before season's end.

2022 - Back in Lansing:

- Piggybacked Jeff Criswell in season debut, Sunday, **April 10 vs. Lake County**, striking out six Captains in three innings... earned win as Lugnugs topped Caps, 6-5, avoiding a three-game sweep... made first start of the year **April 15 at West Michigan**, pitched scoreless 1st and 2nd inning and recorded two outs into the 4th, but in between, gave up five runs on six hits in the 3rd inning, including doubles by Parker Meadows, Colt Keith and Jake Holton and a triple by Andrew Navigato... that supplied the lion's share of the White-caps' offense in a 6-3 victory over Lansing... **April 23 vs. Fort Wayne, Game 2:** tied his own franchise single-game record, giving up four home runs to the TinCaps (Corey Rosier leading off the game, Robert Hassell III hit two, Ripken Reyes hit one) in six innings in Lugnugs' 6-2 defeat... **May 11 vs. Dayton:** dominated the Dayton Dragons with five scoreless innings... four of the five were perfect, with a double (Justice Thompson) and two walks allowed in the third inning before he bore down and stranded the bases loaded... tied career high with seven strikeouts... Lugnugs won comfortably against the first-place Dragons, 6-1... **May 17 at Great Lakes:** started the first game of the series against the Loons, allowing six hits and four runs (three earned) in 3 2/3 IP... gave up one run in the 1st, one in the 2nd and two in the 3rd... allowed four extra-base hits, including a pair of triples to Jorbit Vivas and a triple to Jose Ramos... trailing 4-1 when he exited, Lugnugs came back to beat the Loons, 7-4... **May 22 vs. Great Lakes:** relieved Hogan Harris with two outs in the 2nd, recording the final out, and then proceeded to pitch four more scoreless innings, striking out six while allowing two hits and one walk... after departing, however, Lugnugs bullpen allowed three runs in 7th and four in the 8th in an 8-3 loss... **May 27 at Beloit, Game 1:** Allowed one run in the 3rd and four runs in 4th, departing after 3 2/3 IP in a 5-1 loss to the Sky Carp... Beloit southpaw Dax Fulton limited Lugnugs to one run while striking out seven in five innings... departed trailing 3-0, watching reliever Diego Granado allow a two-run double to Victor Mesa, Jr. to allow final two runs to score... **June 3 vs. Cedar Rapids:** relieved Hogan Harris and tossed 4 2/3 innings, allowing four runs (three earned).
