#### LATE RALLY FALLS SHORT IN LOSS TO GWINNETT

Despite a strong outing from **Braxton Garrett**, the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp fell 4-3 to the Gwinnett Stripers Tuesday. A **J.P. Martinez** RBI single and an **Ozzie Albies** (1) three-run home run gave Gwinnett a four-run lead. Trailing 4-0 in the eighth, **Jakob Marsee** smacked a leadoff double. Following a walk, **Troy Johnston** lined a an RBI double, cutting the deficit to three. With two runners on, **Deyvison De Los Santos** cracked a two-run double to bring the score to 4-3.

#### SLIP 'N SLIDE

Despite owning a 5.89 ERA through the first 15 games in August (third-worst in the International League), Jacksonville balanced that with the second-best batting average (.283) while going 8-7. On Monday, August 19, the Jumbo Shrimp were just 5.5 games behind first-place Columbus for the top spot in the IL. Since then, the Jumbo Shrimp have been free falling in the standings, falling to 10th in the International League. In their last 26 games, the Jumbo Shrimp are slashing .234/.297/.334/.631, which ranks 17th, 19th, 19th and 19th respectively. On the flip side, despite posting a 11-15 record, the pitching staff's ERA ranks 11th (4.51) and they're holding opponents to the 11th-highest batting average against (.248).

#### ONE RUN TO RULE THEM ALL

After last night's 4-3 loss, Jacksonville has now played in 52 one-run contests in 2024 and their 14th in their last 33 games. The Jumbo Shrimp are 8-6 in one-run games during this stretch. Jacksonville is being outscored by their opponents 160-126 since beating Toledo 7-6 on August 11.

#### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS

The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled this season at 121 Financial Ballpark, mustering a meager 31-38 (.449) record. Jacksonville has scored only 284 runs at home (4.1 per game), the fewest in Triple-A. The Jumbo Shrimp are scoring over half-run more per game on the road, totaling 344 (4.6 per game). Meanwhile, also on the road, Jacksonville has surrendered 346 runs (4.6 per game), the ninth-fewest in Triple-A. They've yielded the sixth-fewest runs of any team at home (335, 4.9 per game). Thus, their run differential is -2 on the road, but -49 at home.

#### STRAIGHT AND NARROW

Of Jacksonville's 12 wins during the month of August, nine came by three runs or fewer, including six by just one run. The Jumbo Shrimp have played in 52 games this season decided by one run (24-28) the most in the International League. Jacksonville registered 85 contests (57.0 percent of total games, 39-46, .459) contests decided by three runs or fewer during the 2023 season. In 2024, their 93 games this season determined by these narrow margins represents 64.6 percent of the club's 144 games played thus far in 2024. The Jumbo Shrimp are 48-44 (.522) in those tightly-decided contests.

#### LADIES FIRST

When Gwinnett scored the game's first run on Tuesday against Jacksonville, it marked the 18th consecutive home game for the Jumbo Shrimp in which the visiting team scored first. This streak, which dates back to July 30, has surprisingly seen Jacksonville go .473 in its contests at 121 Financial Ballpark, with a 9-10 record. Over the Jumbo Shrimp's 69 home games thus far in 2024, their opponent has scored first in 47 contests (68.1 percent). Jacksonville is 16-31 (.340) in those affairs.

#### IT GETS LATE EARLY OUT HERE

Over the last 26 games, Jacksonville's offense has really struggled against opposing bullpens. The relief corps of Nashville, Norfolk, Louisville, Charlotte and Gwinnett have combined to surrender only 35 runs, 29 earned, on 77 hits (6.1 H/9) in 113.0 innings (2.31 ERA, 114 K, 40 BB) against the Jumbo Shrimp over this 26-game run. From the sixth inning on during this stretch, Jacksonville is a woeful 65-for-333 (.195) at the plate, scratching across only 27 runs in 86 innings.

#### SHRIMP BITES

With Gwinnett scoring first in game one on Tuesday, opponents have opened the scoring against Jacksonville in 14 of the last 22 games. In 10 of those contests, opponents have scored in the first inning...Jacksonville has had 86 different players take the field in 2024, setting a new club record from (2022, 79)...After Collin Lowe's start in game one on Saturday, the Jumbo Shrimp have had 27 different starting pitchers, a club record. With Dane Myers returning to the Jacksonville lineup last night, his 1-for-3 game extended his on-base streak to 23 games.

#### **ABOUT ADAM**

-Mazur was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the second round of the 2022 draft out of the University of Iowa. He made his major league debut for the Padres on June 4, 2024, tossing 6.0 innings of one-run ball at the Los Angeles Angels. Mazur was later included in the July 30 trade along with left-hander Robby Snelling and infielders Graham Pauley and Jay Beshears in exchange for left-hander Tanner Scott and right-hander Bryan Hoeing.

-Mazur began his collegiate career at South Dakota State University before transferring to Iowa. He made 15 starts for the Hawkeyes in 2022, going 7-3 with a 3.07 ERA. Over 93.2 innings, he yielded only 60 hits and 30 walks while striking out 98 to earn Big Ten Pitcher of the Year honors. His 98 strikeouts ranks as the fourthmost in a single-season in program history, and he ranked eighth nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (5.8).

-When he made his MLB debut on June 4, 2024, Mazur became the fourth former Hawkeye to pitch in a big league game since 2000, joining Wes Obermueller (2002), Matt Dermody (2016) and Nick Allgeyer (2021).

-As a second-round pick (53rd overall), Mazur was the highest-drafted Hawkeye since Tim Costo was picked eighth overall by Cleveland in 1990.

-Mazur is an alumnus of Woodbury High School in Woodbury, Minn, where he was a finalist for the Minnesota Mr. Baseball Award. He was high school teammates with former Jacksonville and current Miami Marlins right-hander Max Meyer.

In addition to his baseball prowess growing up, Mazur earned four letters in basketball and two in football.

-The youngest of three boys, Adam's older brother Brandon played college baseball at Grand View.

#### 2024 SEASON

-Mazur began the season with Double-A San Antonio before earning a promotion to Triple-A El Paso. He had his contract selected by San Diego on June 4 and made his major league debut that night against the Angels.

-Mazur was named the International League Pitcher of the Week for August 20-25 after tossing 6.0 scoreless innings with one hit and one walk against four strikeouts in a 5-0 victory over Nashville on August 21.
