LAST OUTING: Junk appeared in relief in the series finale at Memphis on April 14. He went 3.0 scoreless innings, walking three with a pair of strikeouts in innings six through eight.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Junk's lone outing against Omaha came on April 27 last season. He took the loss, allowing a pair of runs (both earned) in 5.0 innings. Junk allowed a solo homer in the second inning to Nate Eaton as the Sounds fell 2-1 just under a year ago.
