LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox dropped the fourth game of the series on Friday 4-3 against Erie on a seventh inning solo homer by Gage Workman. Bowie fell behind early but managed to tie the game on RBI hits from John Rhodes, Anthony Servideo, and a triple by Enrique Bradfield Jr.. Daniel Lloyd pitched four innings and struck out five in his Double-A debut but gave up the solo homer to Workman with two outs to give Erie the lead. Bowie collected only one hit from the sixth inning onward.

START ME UP

In the month of August, the Bowie starting rotation has the third-lowest ERA in Double-A at 2.54. The rotation is also tied for the fourth-lowest WHIP (1.09). Despite throwing the fewest number of innings in Double-A, Baysox starters have recorded the third-best strikeouts per 9 innings at 9.79.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF Dylan Beavers was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday after going 9-for 20 (.450) with four extra base hits, including four consecutive multi-hit games, in Altoona. Beavers has reached base in 82 of 102 games played this season. The Orioles No. 8 prospect is tied for the Eastern League lead in walks (60) and is third in stolen bases (28).

BASALLO BASHES

C/1B Samuel Basallo, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, is tied for the Eastern League lead in hits (111) and is second in total bases (178). The No. 3 O's/ No. 11 MLB prospect is tied for the league lead this month with 26 hits in 73 at-bats (.356). In the second half, Basallo is slashing .297/.384/.459 with 5 HR and 20 RBI with 21 walks over 30 strikeouts.

BRADFIELD TO BOWIE

In his first nine games at the Double-A level, OF Enrique Bradfield Jr. has a .795 OPS with a double and already two triples. The Orioles No. 6 prospect has five stolen bases at Double-A and 64 total on the season, which is the second-most in all of MiLB. Bradfield was drafted with the 17th overall pick by the Orioles last year out of Vanderbilt.

BURNIN' UP

INF Collin Burns has collected a hit in six consecutive games after going 2-for-24 to start the month of August. It's a season-best hit streak for Burns, who is slashing .304/.333/.478 over his last six games. Burns' career-best hit streak is 14 games from June 11-30, 2022 with High-A Aberdeen.

ATTACKING IN AUGUST

After hitting only .207 in the month of July (tied for league-worst), Bowie has turned things around in August with the third-best batting average in the league at .257. The Baysox have scored 101 runs, third-most in the circuit, thanks to a league-best on-base percentage of .350. The Baysox have also stolen the most bases this month (33).

YOU GOOD PHAM

RHP Alex Pham has been one of the best pitchers in the Eastern League in the second half. The Orioles No. 27 prospect has the third-lowest ERA in the league since July 11 (1.87) and the lowest WHIP (0.77). Pham threw a career-long seven innings in his most recent start at Altoona and had a 19-inning scoreless streak from Aug. 1-18.

SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

Entering this week, the Erie SeaWolves are second in the Southwest Division with a record of 25-19. The Double-A affiliate of the Tigers won the first half in the Southwest Division. Four of the Tigers top 30 prospects are on the SeaWolves active roster - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 2), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 8), RHP Troy Melton (No. 12), and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Jackson Jobe makes his 14th start of the season for the SeaWolves. The top pitching prospect in baseball has a 2.13 ERA in the second half after missing all of May and June with an injury. The third overall pick in the 2021 Draft struck out five in three scoreless innings against Bowie on May 1 before leaving the game with an injury.

2024: Threw 19 consecutive scoreless innings from 8/1-8/18, which is longest scoreless streak by a Baysox pitcher this season. Has a 1.23 ERA in August in four starts. Leads 0's system in IP (101.1) and is 2nd in K (118). T-5th in Eastern League and T-8th in Double- A in strikeouts. 5th in all of Double- A in K/9 (10.48). Holds a 2.61 ERA in second half after holding a 5.85 ERA in first half. Named EL Pitcher of Week for 7/9-7/14 for first time in career after dealing 6.0 shutout IP with 6 K on 7/11 @ ALT. Retired 17 of final 18 batters faced. First Baysox player to receive weekly award this season. Baysox have won 13 of last 19 games that Pham has started in. Holds a 5.76 ERA in 11 home starts. Threw first scoreless start of season by matching, at time, career-high 6.0 IP and 0 BB over 6 K to record win on 6/11 @ HBG. Ended month of May with a 5.64 ERA. Allowed just two runs or less in four of his five starts in May. Collected first Double-A win on 5/7 vs AKR after dealing 5.0 IP with 6 K, matching season-high. Named to Bowie Opening Day roster and was named Opening Night starter. Second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen.

2023: Began the season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. 163 opposing average was the lowest in the South Atlantic League at the time of his promotion. Five of 10 starts with Aberdeen were 5+ IP with one run or fewer allowed. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Began Double-A career with nine scoreless frames across two starts. Surrendered fewer than 3 ER in 11 of his 14 Double-A outings, including six outings of 5 IP or more. Had a 1.80 ERA for Bowie in July. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023.

2022: Spent the first portion of 2022 on the injured list, being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Pitched in six games for the Shorebirds, allowing two earned runs through 11.1 innings, before promotion to High-A Aberdeen on May 24. Only allowed a single run through his first three appearances for Aberdeen (8 IP) before allowing six runs across four innings in back-to-back rough outings. Placed on IL for the second time in the season in late June. Spent a brief rehab stint with the FCL Orioles after being activated August 5, before finishing the season with Aberdeen. In total, pitched to a 5.66 ERA with the IronBirds across 20.2 innings in the regular season.

2021: Pitched 6.2 innings for the FCL Orioles in 2021, surrendering six runs before throwing five scoreless innings across three appearances in Delmarva to end the season.

Personal: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

The- "Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake" are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión "M" or "Fun Cup" "M" During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organizations Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain basebal team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia an New Zealand in 2011.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebby joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebby was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles' organization in 2022. Sebby played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
